# VICTORY FOR THE LADIES?

■ UK Supreme Court rules that biology, not identification, determines gender

The UK Supreme Court has unanimously and unambiguously backed the argument that only biological and not trans women meet the definition of a woman under equality laws, a landmark decision greeted with concern by trans supporters but welcomed by the government as bringing clarity.

The much anticipated ruling centred on whether a trans woman with a gender recognition certificate (GRC), a formal document giving legal recognition of someone's new gender, is protected from discrimination as a woman under Britain's Equality Act.

The decision confirms that single-sex services for women such as refuges, hospital wards and sports can exclude trans women, clearing up legal ambiguity. Transgender campaigners said the decision could lead to discrimination, especially over employment issues.

## highly political

"The unanimous decision of this court is that the terms 'women' and 'sex' in the Equality Act 2010 refer to a biological woman and biological sex," Deputy President of the Supreme Court Patrick Hodge said.

"But we counsel against reading this judgment as a triumph for one or more groups in our society at the expense of another - it is not."

Transgender rights have become a highly political issue in Britain and other parts of the world. Some critics say the conservative right has weaponised identity politics to attack minority groups, while others argue that liberal support for transgender people has infringed on the rights of biological women.

In the United States, legal challenges are underway after President Donald Trump issued executive orders that include barring transgender people from military service.

Wednesday's judgment followed legal action by a campaign group, For Women Scotland (FWS), against guidance issued by the devolved Scottish government that accompanied a 2018 law designed to increase the proportion of women on public sector boards.

The guidance said a trans woman with a gender recognition certificate was legally a woman. FWS, which was backed by lesbian rights groups, lost its case in the Scottish

courts, but the Supreme Court ruled in its favour.

"Today the judges have said what we always believed to be the case: that women are protected by their biological sex, that sex is real and that women can now feel safe that services and spaces designated for women are for women," Susan Smith, co-director of FWS, told cheering supporters outside court.

## potential impact

The Labour government said the Supreme Court's decision would bring clarity for hospitals, refuges and sports clubs.

"Single-sex spaces are protected in law and will always be protected by this government," a gov-

ernment spokesperson said.

In an example of the ruling's potential impact, a Scottish health organisation that is being sued by a nurse it suspended over her response to a trans woman using a female changing room said it had noted the judgment.

"We will now take time to carefully consider the judgment and its implications," a spokesperson for NHS Fife said.

Harry Potter author J.K. Rowling, who has been vocally gender critical, was among those who welcomed the decision.

"It took three extraordinary, tenacious Scottish women with an army behind them to get this case heard by the Supreme

Court and, in winning, they've protected the rights of women and girls across the UK," Rowling said on X.

## "challenging day"

The Supreme Court said trans people - whether trans women or men - would not be disadvantaged by its decision as the Equality Act afforded them protection against discrimination or harassment.

But trans rights campaigners said the ruling had worrying implications.

"Today is a challenging day, and we are deeply concerned at the widespread, harmful implications of today's Supreme Court ruling," a consor-

tium of LGBT+ organisations, including prominent group Stonewall, said in a statement.

"We need to take the time to digest the full implications of the ruling and to understand what this will mean on both legal and practical levels ... it is important to be reminded that the Supreme Court reaffirmed that the Equality Act protects trans people against discrimination."

## Palace setting September date for state visit, claims Trump

US President Donald Trump has suggested Buckingham Palace is "setting a date for September" for his second state visit to the UK.

The president told reporters in the White House on Thursday evening: "I was invited by the King and the country - great country."

It comes after Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer handed Trump an invitation letter from King Charles in February during his visit to Washington. Buckingham Palace is yet to confirm a date for the state visit.

Trump was hosted by the late Queen Elizabeth II during his previous three-day state visit in 2019,

which took place during his first term in office.

Traditionally second-term US presidents are not offered a state visit and have instead been invited for tea or lunch with the monarch at Windsor Castle.

King Charles' letter proposed a meeting to discuss details of the state visit at either Dumfries House or Balmoral, both in Scotland, a country to which Trump has connections.

Trump's mother was born and brought up on the Hebridean island of Lewis. This year he is planning to open a new golf course in Aberdeenshire, to be named after his mother.

Speaking on Thursday, Trump said: "They're going to do a second, as you know, a second fest... that's what it is: a fest, and it's beautiful, and it's the first time it's ever happened to one person."

"And the reason is we have two separate terms, and it's an honour... I'm a friend of Charles, I have great respect for King Charles and the family, William, we have really just a great respect for the family."

"And I think they're setting a date for September."

Starmer previously said the invite for the second visit was "truly historic" and "unprecedented".

During the UK prime minister's visit to the White House in February, Trump showed cameras the contents of the King's letter.

It read: "Quite apart from this presenting an opportunity to discuss a wide range of issues of

mutual interest, it would also offer a valuable chance to plan a historic second state visit to the United Kingdom."

"As you will know this is unprecedented by a US president. That is why I would find it helpful for us to be able to discuss,

together, a range of options for location and programme content."

"In so doing, working together, I know we will further enhance the special relationship between our two countries of which we are both so proud."

## Uproar in Manchester as bomber's brother injures three prison officers

■ Victims' families incensed as it emerges Hashem Abedi took advantage of kitchen privileges at County Durham prison

Greater Manchester mayor Andy Burnham has said the families of the Manchester Arena attack victims must be given answers after the brother of the suicide bomber put three prison guards in hospital at the weekend.

On Saturday, Hashem Abedi threw hot cooking oil and stabbed three prison officers with blades

at high security HMP Frankland in County Durham.

Mr Burnham said he was "surprised" that the convicted killer had access to cooking oil and that he would do all he could to ensure there was accountability.

He said: "Abedi cannot be at liberty to carry on causing harm to other people. That's the thing I

can't get my head around. But I'm glad there has been the ordering of an inquiry."

Now aged 28, Abedi was jailed in 2020 for a minimum of 55 years after helping bomber Salman Abedi kill 22 people at the end of an Ariana Grand.

Two prison officers remain in hospital with serious injuries from Saturday's attack, while a third

has been discharged.

Earlier this week, a letter to Justice Secretary Shabana Mahmood from the families of five victims outlined their "absolute disbelief".

In a separate letter, Martin Hibbert, who was paralysed by the attack, described the incident as "a catastrophic failure of

your duty to protect prison staff and the public from an unrepentant terrorist".

He added: "I was led to believe that people like him - mass murderers, terrorists - would face a regime of strict control and zero comfort. I was told justice would be served."

Mr Burnham said he

would "always support the families in raising their concerns with the authorities" and "they shouldn't have been in this position".

Prisons Minister Lord James Timpson has said the terms of reference and scope of the review would be set out in the coming days.

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## Jean Marsh dead at 90

ACTRESS Jean Marsh, who co-created and starred in the iconic period drama *Upstairs, Downstairs*, has died at the age of 90.

The Emmy winner passed away peacefully at her London home on Sunday, her close friend, filmmaker Michael Lindsay-Hogg, said.

The cause of death was reported as complications from dementia.

She became a household name in the 1970s after starring in the ITV Edwardian drama as Rose Buck, the no-nonsense but warm-hearted head parlour maid.

The series she co-created alongside friend and fellow actress Eileen Atkins, was watched by millions in the UK and the US.

It ran for five series from 1971 to 1975 and featured the lives of the wealthy Bellamy family and their loyal domestic staff living under one roof in a Belgravia townhouse.

Her performance as Rose earned her a 1975 Emmy Award for Outstanding Lead Actress in a Drama Series.

Jean reprised the role of Rose who was now the housekeeper in the BBC's 2010 revival of *Upstairs, Downstairs*.

She had a brief marriage to actor Jon Pertwee, the Third Doctor in *Doctor Who*, in the 1950s. The pair divorced in 1960 but remained friends.

She had a starring role in the 1980s US sitcom *9 to 5*, and appeared in films such as *Return to Oz* in 1985 and *Willow* in 1988.

The actress also co-created another successful series, *The House of Eliott* from 1991 to 1994.

# "Never, ever give up on your dreams"

■ As he joins the immortals, Rory says Masters victory is perfect life lesson for daughter Poppy

RORY McIlroy's Masters victory at the 17th time of asking has elevated him to golf immortality but the example to his young daughter is the much bigger prize.

His nail-biting win at Augusta National on Sunday realized a lifelong ambition and finally saw him complete the game's grand slam of major championships.

And with glory came the chance to look four-year-old Poppy in the eye and a father to pass on an invaluable lesson in life.

Choking back tears on the 18th green after his play-off heroics, he knelt down to tightly cradle his daughter before scooping her into his arms as his tears flowed.

And, after composing himself, he said: "The one thing I would say to my daughter Poppy is never, ever give up on your dreams."

He added: "What came out of me on the last green there in the play-off was at least 11 years, if not 14 years, of pent-up emotion.

"I've made my dreams come true and I would say to every boy and girl,

believe in your dreams, and if you work hard enough and if you put the effort in, you can achieve anything you want."

Until Sunday, and despite all his glittering golfing achievements elsewhere during a stellar 20-year career, victory at Augusta eluded the Northern Irishman, 35.

His best finish had come in 2022, finishing three strokes behind winner Scottie Scheffler. Pundits – and even McIlroy – were starting to think he would never beat his demons which had haunted him since 2011 when he carried a four-stroke lead into the final round but carded an eight-over-par 80, dropping him into a tie for 15th place.

But McIlroy is now a five-time major champ, winning the 2011 US Open, 2012 and 2014 PGA Championship, 2014 Open Championship, and this year's Masters – one of six golfers to achieve a modern career grand slam, and the only European to do so.

His stunning victory over Englishman and European Ryder Cup

team-mate Justin Rose put a huge smile on McIlroy's face.

And what a turnaround it has been. Last year he filed for divorce from Erica Stoll, 37, his wife of eight years, only to withdraw it months later.

As the sun set on a remarkable week he gestured to his wife and daughter, who had joined him on the 18th green, and said: "My family, my team.

"They've been on this journey with me the

whole way through.

"They know the burden I've carried to come here every year and to try and try and try again."

For British fans the delight at Rory's win was tempered at the sight of Justin Rose losing his second Masters in a playoff.

The Englishman also lost the same way in 2017 to Sergio Garcia, and has now been the runner up in the last two Majors.

But Rose was all class following what must have been a hugely dis-

appointing finale after he had closed a remarkable final round by closing an eight stroke gap on the leader. When asked how he felt, Rose said:

"Tormented, probably, by the thought of what might have been. I felt so good with my game, good with my emotions, and I'm super proud of that.

"To lose in a playoff for the second time kind of punctuates both of them and makes you realize just how close you've been."

## Rory's former teacher reveals plan in case golf didn't work out

A confidential memo from Rory McIlroy's time at school shows how plans were in place in case his golf career did not work out.

Sullivan Upper School in Holywood, County Down, went to extraordinary lengths to ensure the golf-mad teenager kept studying.

McIlroy, now 35, completed the Grand Slam in golf on Sunday, winning the Masters in dramatic fashion in a play-off at Augusta.

Twenty years ago, McIlroy was often on a golf course somewhere in the world when he should

have been in the classroom.

His then principal, John Stevenson, told reporters "sometimes you've got to break a few rules".

Speaking to the Belfast Telegraph, he also talked about what kind of student Rory was.

Young McIlroy was driving and putting at times when he should have been studying.

Indeed, there was an old joke in his home town when he was growing up - what have Sullivan Upper school and a bunker at Holywood golf club got in common?

The answer was - Rory

was never in either of them.

Back in September 2004, a seven-point plan was agreed with his par-

ents, Gerry and Rosie, as 15-year-old McIlroy prepared to take his GCSEs.

It was decided that he should reduce his num-

ber of subjects from nine to five.

In the memo sent to two Year 12 teachers, Mr Stevenson wrote: "I expect Rory will be away from school rather more than we think wise, but rather less than he would want."

It was arranged that teaching staff and classmates would help him catch up on work that he missed.

Mr Stevenson said at the time they could "look forward in anticipation to his future sporting success and recognise that we will have played some part in that".

## Flintoff reveals crash agony

Andrew 'Freddie' Flintoff has said he did not leave the house for six months after a crash in the TV show *Top Gear*, which left him with both physical and mental scars.

The cricket-turned-TV presenter sustained serious facial and rib injuries in a crash while filming the BBC motoring programme in 2022.

Speaking about the incident on ITV's *The Jonathan Ross Show*, Flintoff said he had struggled with "crippling anxiety" in the wake of the crash and has suffered from flashbacks and nightmares.

The interview, to be broadcast on Saturday, comes ahead of a Disney+ documentary which promises an "intimate and unprecedented look" at Flintoff's sporting career and his return to the public eye after the crash.

"Afterwards, obviously there's the physical scars that I've got. But then the mental side of it," he told Jonathan Ross.

"I didn't leave the house for probably six or eight months. The only times I was leaving the house was for medical appointments and surgeries," he said.

The former England all-rounder also revealed he had to have "about five or six goes at leaving the room" and "have a chat with myself in the mirror" to help overcome his anxiety before returning to the world of cricket as a coach.

"I'd not shown myself without a face mask to anyone. It was like starting again."

In a trailer released on Thursday for the 90-minute Disney+ documentary, Flintoff describes his "vivid" memories of the crash and says he can remember "everything about it".

# Four women bring novel legal case against Tate in UK Courts

A civil case brought by four women against Andrew Tate is believed to be a legal first, a barrister for his accusers has said.

The women accuse Tate of rape, assault and coercive control between 2013 and 2015. One claims he threatened to kill her, another says he made clear he would kill anyone who spoke to her, and a third claims he convinced her he had killed others.

In written submissions, Anne Studd KC said she believed this was the first case of its kind in which it is argued that coercive control amounted to "intentional infliction of harm" - a legal concept similar to emotional distress.

Tate denies the claims, saying they are a "pack of lies" and "gross fabrications".

The women are seeking damages "arising from the assaults, batteries, and infliction of

intentional harm", their civil claim states.

A case management hearing was held in London on Tuesday, which deals with preliminary matters and logistics.

The court heard that a trial could be held in early 2027, and that it could last three weeks.

Judge Richard Armstrong told the court the four women were "seeking damages likely to reach six figures".

### 'vehemently denied'

Proving the intentional infliction of harm would mean the claimants could be awarded additional damages.

Coercive control, Ms Studd said, was "a form of grooming and manipulation where the victim becomes less and less able to respond in what might be perceived as a normal way".

She added that a victim "may not leave even if the door is open".

acting for Tate, told the court that they "accept in this day and age that coercive and controlling behaviour does exist", but that it was "really not the issue in this case".

The case concerns incidents the four women allege took place in Luton and Hitchin.

Two of the claimants worked for Tate's webcam business in 2015, while the other two were in relationships with him

in 2013 and 2014.

Three of the women previously reported Tate to the police, but in 2019 the Crown Prosecution Service (CPS) decided not to bring criminal charges.

Tate denies all the allegations, and argues that the women cannot now take legal action against him because too much time has passed, and emails, texts, and other potential evidence

would have been lost.

His solicitor Andrew Ford previously said in a statement that the women's allegations "are vehemently denied and will be fully contested in court".

"When the matter was referred to the CPS, they concluded there was insufficient prospect of conviction and chose not to charge Mr Tate with any offence," Mr Ford added.

## Uproar as Toby carves up 500 year old heritage oak

A North London branch of Toby Carvery is facing an outcry after it cut down an oak tree thought to be around 500 years old.

With a girth of 20ft, it was on the Woodland Trust's national ancient tree inventory and much loved by users of Whitewebbs Park in Enfield, North London.

But it was felled on April 3 after experts for Mitchells & Butlers, the owner of the nearby carvery, said it was dying and that it posed a "serious health and safety risk".

Enfield Council said it was treating it as criminal damage and had reported the felling to the Met Po-

lice.

It has also put an emergency preservation order in place on the stump.

Environmental campaigners and locals decried the felling as "devastating" and compared it with the toppling of the Sycamore Gap tree in 2023.

The oak was in the carvery's car park, and the M&B pub chain said: "This was an essential action to protect our employees and guests, to whom we have a duty of care.

"We took every necessary measure to ensure all legal requirements were met. We are grateful to our expert contractors for

warning us of this hazard so swiftly, allowing us to act before anyone was harmed."

The Woodland Trust has argued that the old tree was still an important habitat, with ancient oaks supporting biodiversity, such as endangered dead wood beetles.

Trust expert Ed Pyne

said: "This is the most shocking fell I think I've ever seen in more than a decade working with ancient trees.

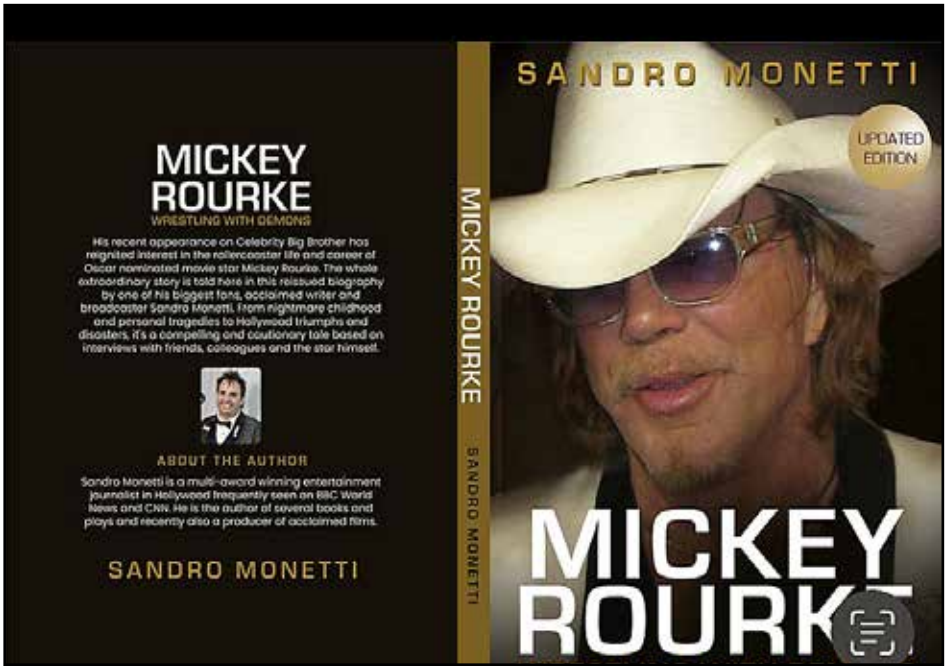
"This is ecologically much more significant than the Sycamore Gap - and certainly a more irreplaceable tree.

"Ancient oaks are particularly rich in bio-di-

versity with habitats that take centuries to develop. They can't be replaced quickly."

Ed Allnut, secretary of the Guardians of Whitewebbs group, said locals wanted justice. He said: "The tree belonged to Enfield and to our national heritage. I am personally devastated."

# Fancy a bit of Brontë?

■ A daring new adaptation of *Jane Eyre* is now playing at Pasadena's *A Noise Within*, writes Craig Young

*A Noise Within's* adaptation of *Jane Eyre*, written by Elizabeth Williamson and directed by Geoff Elliott, arrives at the Noise Within theatre in Pasadena with lofty ambitions but uneven results.

While Brontë devotees and period-drama loyalists may find moments to savor, the production struggles to reconcile its grand scale with the intimacy its story demands. Still, it offers enough intrigue - and a few standout performances - to warrant a visit for those curious to judge it firsthand.

Frederick "Freddie" Stewart shines as Mr. Rochester, channeling the charm of a young Rex Harrison on "Dr. Doolittle". His performance is magnetic, balancing brooding intensity with flashes of wit. Opposite him, Jeanne Syquia tackles the titular role with visible dedication, committing fiercely to Jane's dense monologues. While her Yorkshire accent wavers, Syquia's earnestness is undeniable; a touch more youthful vulnerability (or fleeting levity) might have softened her

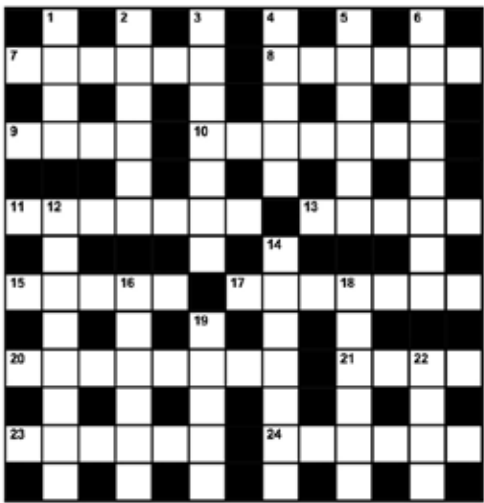
portrayal and offset the play's unrelenting solemnity. The production's brightest spark, however, is Trisha Miller, who deftly juggles three roles: the imperious Blanche Ingram, the nurturing Bessie, and the flirtatious Grace Poole. Miller's chameleonic shifts—from Blanche's haughty

disdain to Grace's eerie stillness—inject much-needed vitality. Her Blanche is a particular triumph, crackling with aristocratic venom, while her Grace Poole lingers in the mind like a shadow. The play's flaws, alas, are merely structural. Geoff Elliott's direction **cont. on page 10, col. 5**

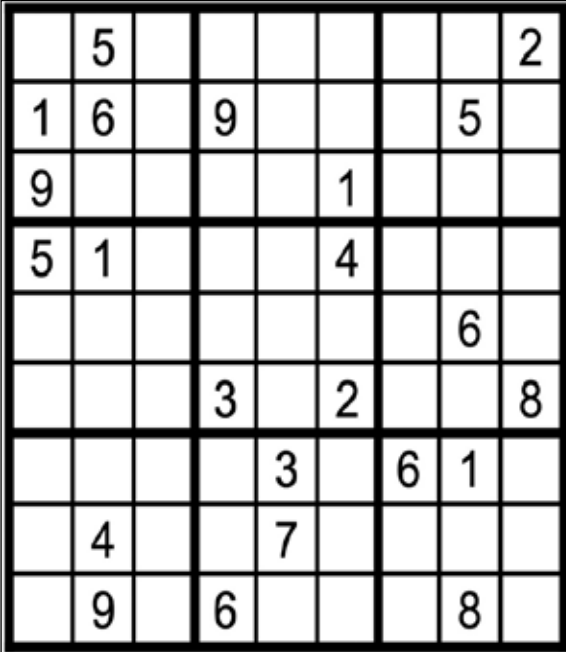

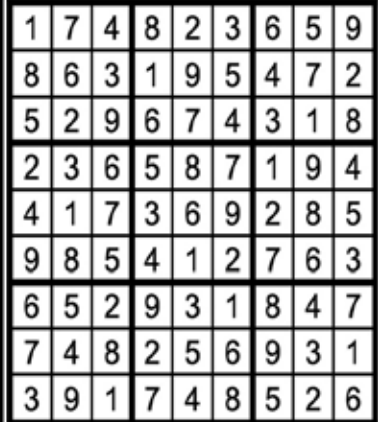

# Black Mirror: through the glass.....even more darkly

■ Despite some missteps, season seven of the British science fiction anthology is still unmissable

After a mixed reception to its last outing, *Black Mirror* Season Seven arrived this week like a chilling gust of dystopian wind - bringing back the series' signature bleakness, moral ambiguity, and technological paranoia.

Creator Charlie Brooker has described this season as a spiritual return to the show's roots, and in many ways, it is: more emotionally potent, more disturbing, and more grounded in psychological horror than its recent predecessors.

This season spans six episodes, each exploring different facets of our relationship with technology, memory, and societal structures. While some episodes are instant classics, others stumble in execution or feel like rehashes of past ideas without meaningful evolution. Still, the overall quality is a welcome shift back toward what made *Black Mirror* resonate so deeply in earlier seasons.

## Standout Episodes: The Emotional and The Unnerving

The crown jewel of Season 7 is undoubtedly "Eulogy". This slow-burn episode centers on a grieving man (Paul Giamatti at the peak of his powers) who uses a memory-reconstruction device to revisit the most precious - and eventually, most painful - moments of his late partner's life. What starts as a meditative journey through grief turns into a disturbing revelation about consent, memory manipulation, and whether we ever really know those we love.

The emotional gravity here recalls the likes of "Be Right Back" or "The Entire History of You," and the direction and performances are top-tier. Critics are already calling it one of the most hauntingly human episodes in the series' entire run.

Another standout is "Common People", a return to overt socio-political commentary.

The episode imagines a near-future healthcare system entirely dependent on tiered subscription models. Think Netflix for medical treatment, but with life-or-death consequences. The satire is sharp, cutting into the commodification of human well-being and the ethics of data-driven health plans. It feels uncomfortably close to reality, especially in countries already battling privatized healthcare structures.

Then there's "Bête Noire", a psychological thriller that toys with the Mandela Effect, misinformation, and the fragility of collective memory. The protagonist begins to notice that the world is subtly shifting around her - familiar brands are suddenly different, conversations are missing, and no one remembers key historical events. As she spirals into paranoia, the episode taps into deep existential fears about identity, control, and the digitization of truth. It's eerie and slow-paced but offers a cerebral experience for longtime fans.

## Missed Potential

Unfortunately, not all episodes deliver the same impact. The much-hyped "USS Callister: Into Infinity", a sequel to the Season 4 fan-favorite, feels unnecessary. It picks up the story of the digital crew post-liberation but lacks the tight narrative arc and thematic depth of the original. It's more action-heavy and less philosophical, and while it offers some fun nostalgia, it doesn't justify its own existence.

"Hotel Reverie" aims to recreate the emotional resonance of "San Junipero" but falls short. Set in a dreamlike virtual

resort where guests explore alternate lives, the story explores identity and memory through an interracial queer couple. Unfortunately, the character development is shallow, and the episode's commentary on race and gender feels more performative than profound. Despite gorgeous visuals and a solid premise, it never quite lands emotionally.

The experimental "Plaything", set in the *Bandersnatch* universe, tries to blend interactive elements into a linear narrative. It's an ambitious concept, but one that ends up muddled. It touches on free will, gamification, and psychological conditioning but feels more like a thought experiment than a story with substance.

## Final Verdict: A Mostly Triumphant Return

Despite its unevenness, *Black Mirror* Season 7 is a strong rebound for the series. It gets back to what made the anthology so compelling in the first place: its ability to hold a mirror (a black one, naturally) up to our collective anxieties. The best episodes are as chilling and

thought-provoking as anything the show has ever done. The weaker entries, while flawed, still attempt to grapple with timely, uncomfortable questions.

This season doesn't reinvent *Black Mirror*, but it doesn't have to—it just needed to remember what it does best. And it does, mostly.

rection strains against the cavernous stage, leaving actors adrift in empty space. Nuanced moments drown in the vastness, while the cast's circling and stumbling during melodramatic peaks feel unintentionally awkward. A smaller venue or tighter staging might have harnessed the story's Gothic intimacy.

Technical choices compound the issues: a low hum in the sound design muffles dialogue, and the bleak lighting flattens visual texture. Though the costumes are sumptuously period-appropriate, distractingly artificial wigs undermine the otherwise polished aesthetic.

Jane's frequent fourth-wall-breaking narration - a bold choice by Williamson - often feels more intrusive than immersive, halting momentum rather than

deepening connection. "I wanted to see a play, not be read a book," a fellow audience member muttered on the way out. A sentiment that lingers.

Yet for all its missteps, *Jane Eyre* is not without merit. Stewart and Miller elevate their scenes, and the source material's raw power flickers through in fleeting moments. While the production's scale often overwhelms its players, Brontë purists may still find value in its audacity—or at least in debating its choices.

For Gothic romance diehards, this production might prove a curious experiment to far. For others? Manage expectations - but don't dismiss it outright.

Villa Park is a stadium built for the Champions League - although there was a mis-step before kick-off when the Europa League theme was played.

It is something they will not want to hear next season.

The task now is for Villa and Emery to ensure they are back on the Champions League stage next season because nights like this - and triumphs such as those against Bayern

Emery will also store away the knowledge and experience of this season, making it instantly clear he wants more, saying: "It is now most important to get Europe again. The most important competition is the Champions League.

"The challenge we have for the last six matches in the Premier League is to try and get Europe and the Champions League."

He added: "To get this level is the next step forward that I want to try to build with Aston Villa."

Emery's standards are sky high, saying: "We are in a process. This is a higher level we have achieved. We want to test ourselves and how we respond. I am so proud, happy, confident in our standards. Hopefully we can come back quickly.

"Our squad showed it can respond at this level. We competed. They deserve to be here. We are ambitious. It is a big challenge and we want the

Manchester United dragged their season out of the ashes in quite extraordinary fashion Thursday night as they scored twice in the final minute of extra time to complete a staggering comeback from 4-2 down against 10-man Lyon at Old Trafford.

United appeared to be heading out of the competition in the worst possible manner as they tossed away a two-goal lead in the space of seven minutes before conceding twice in extra time.

Supporters were streaming for the exits in their droves but Bruno Fernandes breathed new life into United when he converted a penalty six minutes from time after a video assistant referee intervention for a foul on Casemiro that had initially gone unpunished.

With Old Trafford a

cauldron of noise, Kobbie Mainoo somehow kept his cool to curl an equaliser into the corner of the Lyon goal as the tie entered its final minute.

That was extraordinary. But there was no inclination to settle for penalties from the hosts.

In front of legendary former manager Sir Alex Ferguson, who was watching on from the stands, United produced an ending right out of his 1999 Champions League-winning play-book as Casemiro lifted the ball into the penalty area and makeshift centre-forward Harry Maguire rose to send it arcing into the corner.

Cue pandemonium as substitutes, the substituted and anyone else who could get there joined in the celebrations.

It was up there with the most famous games this

stadium has ever seen and means Ruben Amorim's side now face a semi-final with Athletic Bilbao.

Ferguson's famous 'Football, Bloody Hell' comment after the 1999 Champions League final victory over Bayern Munich, which featured two injury-time goals to win it, sprang to mind as Maguire headed off down the tunnel at the end of the game.

Amorim responded to his goal by chasing off down the touchline, just as Jose Mourinho famously did when Porto won in this stadium in 2004. Rio Ferdinand, commenting for TNT Sport, was shown jumping up and down with delight.

Most United fans would have felt the same.

In the cold light of day, United still have a semi-final to play - and, possibly, an all-English final with

Tottenham - before they can claim a Champions League place by winning the Europa League and grabbing some silverware to at least make this desperate campaign a success.

But it will be a while before

the memories of what happened fade.

The plans are to replace this stadium, that is over 100 years old and has played host to the Busby Babes - the only other United side to win a game by a 5-4 scoreline when

they beat Arsenal in the match before the Munich tragedy - the Holy Trinity of George Best, Denis Law and Bobby Charlton, double and Treble winners, Cristiano Ronaldo and Wayne Rooney.

## Arsenal make Real statement

ON A NIGHT Arsenal fans will never forget, their heroes silenced a hostile crowd at the Bernebeu to clinch a dramatic 2-1 win and secure just a third Champions League semi-final - and a first since 2009 - after an impressive first-leg 3-0

win.

Bukayo Saka's saved early Panenka penalty and Kylian Mbappe's overruled spot-kick ensured the Gunners' progress wasn't without incident - but it was ultimately a win that will send a message to the rest

of Europe.

Saka made up for his indiscretion with a second-half opener and, despite William Saliba gifting Vinicius Junior an equaliser soon after, the Gunners never looked in trouble as Paris St-Ger-
