Own goal for Lineker

■ MOTD host issues swift apology for “offensive” post about Zionism

Gary Lineker has “apologized unreservedly” for reposting an Instagram story about Zionism which featured a picture of a rat.

In a statement Wednesday, Lineker, 64, said he reposted material which he has since subsequently learned contained “offensive references,” adding that he withdrew the post as soon as he became aware of the issue.

“I take full responsibility for this mistake,” said Lineker. “I would never knowingly share anything antisemitic. It goes against everything I believe in.”

controversy

Lineker, who starred for England, Leicester City, Tottenham and Barcelona during his playing days, has enjoyed a glittering second career as the anchor on the BBC’s flagship football program, Match of The Day. But his career has been dogged by controversy in recent years due to several controversial social media posts, and he was notably temporarily suspended from

the BBC in March 2023 after an impartiality row over comments he made criticizing the then Conservative government’s new asylum policy.

He came under criticism on Tuesday after he shared a post from the group, Palestine Lobby, illustrated with a picture of a rat, titled: “Zionism explained in two minutes.”

Rats, linked to disease and dirt, have been used to represent Jews in antisemitic propaganda throughout history, including by the Nazis in 1930s Germany.

highest paid

He was among 500 other high-profile figures who signed an open letter in February urging the BBC to re-broadcast a documentary, “Gaza: How to Survive a War Zone,” to its streaming service, BBC iPlayer. The documentary was pulled after it emerged its 13-year-

old narrator was the son of a Hamas official.

“Whilst I strongly believe in the importance of speaking out on humanitarian issues, including the tragedy unfolding in Gaza, I also know that how we do so matters,” he said in his apology Wednesday.

Though Lineker is leaving his role at Match of the Day, he has signed a contract extension that will

see him host the national broadcaster’s coverage of the FA Cup through to 2026 as well as next year’s World Cup tournament in North America. He has for years been the BBC’s highest paid star.

Prior to Lineker’s apology, the BBC’s director-general Tim Davie said the broadcaster’s reputation is “held by everyone and when someone makes a mistake, it costs us.”

He added: “And I think we absolutely need people to be the exemplars of BBC values and follow our social media policies, simple as that.”

‘he must go’

The Campaign Against Antisemitism has urged Davie to sack Lineker, who is also the co-founder of the hugely successful “Goalhanger” podcasts, makers of the popular “The Rest is History” series

and its spin-offs about politics, football, entertainment and money.

“As the BBC’s highest-paid presenter and owner of a major media enterprise, maybe he knows exactly what he’s doing,” a spokesperson for the organization said. “Having looked the other way until now, at this point, it is clear that Mr. Lineker’s continued association with the BBC is untenable. He must go.”

PM rules out quitting ECHR

■ European Court of Human Rights remains controversial for many, but Starmer insists leaving would jeopardize deportation deals

SIR KEIR Starmer has ruled out quitting the European Court of Human Rights because he says it would jeopardise deportation deals and hinder the fight to restore control of our borders.

The Prime Minister said countries would refuse to sign agreements with the UK "if in the next breath, you'll say you don't believe in international law".

But the Home Office has confirmed it will overhaul how Article 8 of the European Convention on Human Rights is used in immigration cases.

'basis for deals'

This year ministers will bring forward legislation so that fewer cases are treated as "exceptional".

Asked if going further on immigration would require "disentangling ourselves" from the ECHR, Sir Keir said: "No, I don't think that is necessary."

"I also remind myself the international agreements we've signed have given us the basis for deals we've struck on ille-

gal migration.

"So the Home Secretary has moved fast, working with other countries to put in place materially improved deals with other countries in relation to migration that would not have been possible if we had been saying at the same time we're about to withdraw from our international obligations.

'right balance'

"You can't strike those deals with other countries to work more closely together on law enforcement, to smash the gangs and to work on returns agreements – which is what we want to do – if in the next breath, you'll say you don't believe in international law."

But he admitted "the right balance" needed to be made between individual rights and "the national interest" and pledged adjustments.

The Home Office this week confirmed it will introduce new legislation to limit how Article 8 is being used in immigration cases.

The "public interest test" will be strengthened to "make it clear Parliament needs to be able to control our borders".

And migrants trying to "get round the rules", for example by using Article 8 to apply to stay after travelling to the UK on a short-term visa, will likely lose their cases, under the new rules.

The Home Office believes the legislation will "limit successful claims" from individuals who "frustrate and delay removal with spurious claims in an attempt to stretch out their stay in the UK, and thereby increase the eventual likelihood of having an Article 8 claim upheld".

'even more people'

The majority of Channel migrants who make "immediate" claims for "wider family members" will also lose their cases.

The Home Office said in its long-awaited White Paper: "There have long been family rules and entitlements within the UK system for close family

members to reunite across borders.

"There have also long been provisions which allow for exceptional circumstances which draw on Article 8 of the Human Rights Act and ECHR, which expresses the right to a family and private life.

"However, in recent years, the number of cases decided by the Home Office and the courts on the basis of exceptional circumstances has substan-

tially increased."

Reform UK leader Nigel Farage warned bilateral migrant deals with France and Germany could lead to "even more people" coming to the UK.

He said: "How ironic that he's giving this statement today, he's boasting about trade deals with India, with America, all Brexit freedoms, and next week he's off to Brussels to potentially sign us up to freedom of movement

for under 30s."

Home Office sources have warned of a surge in "quasi-protection" claims using both Article 8 – right to a family life – and Article 3 – right to freedom from persecution – to stay.

Amid claims migrants could use Article 3 to avoid deportation, a Home Office source said: "We want to take all action necessary to remove those with no right to be in the UK."

Man charged over Starmer arson

A 21-year-old man has been charged after fires at two properties and a car linked to Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer, the Metropolitan Police has said.

Roman Lavrynovych, a Ukrainian national, was charged with three counts of arson with intent to endanger life on Thursday.

He was arrested at an address in Sydenham, south-east London, in the early hours of Tuesday. He was due to appear at Westminster Magistrates' Court on Friday.

The charges relate to three incidents – a vehicle fire in Kentish Town, north London, a fire at the prime minister's private home on the same street and a fire at an address

that he previously lived at in north-west London.

The investigation has been led by the Met's Counter Terrorism Command due to its links to a high-profile figure.

In the early hours of Monday 12 May, emergency services responded to a fire at the Kentish Town home where Sir Keir Starmer lived before becoming prime minister and moving into 10 Downing Street.

Police were alerted by the London Fire Brigade (LFB) to reports of a fire at the residential address at 01:35 BST.

Damage was caused to the property's entrance but nobody was hurt.

According to reports, the property was being

rented out to the prime minister's sister-in-law.

A car that Sir Keir had sold to a neighbour last year was set alight four days earlier on Thursday May 8 on the same street.

Just after 03:00 on Sunday 11 May, firefighters dealt with a small fire at the front door of a house converted into flats in nearby Islington.

One person was helped to safety by firefighters wearing breathing apparatus, LFB said.

It is understood that the prime minister lived there in the 1990s.

The incidents led to demands that the PM and other public figures be "properly Protected" from Shadow Justice

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UK to double the approval time for migrants to get legal

■ Critics dub decision 'a betrayal'

New rules making migrants wait longer to qualify for permanent settlement in the UK will apply to people already in the country, under government plans.

On Monday the government announced immigrants would now typically have to live in the UK for 10 years before applying for the right to stay here indefinitely - double the current five-year period.

It was previously unclear whether this would apply to the approximately 1.5 million foreign workers who have moved to the UK since 2020.

A document published in the coming weeks will make clear the government is preparing to apply the 10-year qualifying period to those who are already in the UK as well as to new visa applicants.

immigration surge

A government source said Home Secretary Yvette Cooper had for some time been concerned that under the current five-year process there is set to be a significant increase in settlement and citizenship applications in the next few years, reflecting the surge in immigration in the early years of this decade.

A policy document published on Monday said there would continue to be a five-year qualification period for non-UK dependents of British citizens.

There will also be shorter qualification periods for people who can show they have contributed to the UK's "economy and society".

The announcement was part a wider package of measures set out

on Monday to cut legal migration.

Net migration - the number of people coming to the UK minus the number leaving - climbed to a record 906,000 in June 2023, and last year it stood at 728,000.

'not a right'

In a speech on Monday, Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer said the measures would mean "settlement becomes a privilege that is earned, not a right, easier if you make a contribution, if you work, pay in, and help rebuild our country."

Some Labour MPs have raised concerns about the possibility longer qualifying periods for settlement could apply to people already in the UK.

In response, Cooper told MPs the government would set out further details later this year, with a consultation to follow.

An Iranian man named Isa, who came to the UK from Iran three years ago with his computer scientist wife, said the change felt like "fraud" and "a betrayal".

"We had other options as well - we came here with the promise of settlement status here," he said.

"We need to stay two more years under current rules [to be eligible for permanent settlement]."

"This was our plan for life here. And now everything has changed."

"I'm now thinking about moving to the US. Don't get me wrong, I absolutely love living here. I was feeling welcome when I came here at first and it's the first moment that I feel like I'm completely unwelcome."

'I'm not angry or bitter' says man wrongly imprisoned for 38 years

■ Peter Sullivan freed after DNA advances prove him innocent in 1986 murder of Liverpool barmaid

A man who spent 38 years in prison for murder has insisted he is "not angry or bitter" after his conviction was quashed.

Peter Sullivan, 68, was branded the "Beast of Birkenhead" after being found guilty of the murder of barmaid Diane Sindall in 1986.

His case was referred to the Court of Appeal after freshly recovered DNA evidence cast doubt on his involvement.

And on Monday his conviction was quashed after 38 years, marking what is believed to be Britain's longest miscarriage of justice affecting a living prisoner.

But, in a statement read outside court on his behalf by lawyer Sarah Myatt, Sullivan refused to express anger.

He said: "What happened to me was very wrong, but it does not detract or minimize that all of this happened off the back of a heinous and most terrible loss of life."

'such a shame'

"I am not angry, I am not bitter. I am simply anxious to return to my loved ones and family as I've got to make the most of what is left of the existence I am granted in this world."

Urging police to find the real killer, he added: "I would like to say how sorry I am to the family of Diane Sindall, who have now got to come to terms with the death of their daughter being down to someone else."

"And I long to see the right thing done for this horrible crime, so that they will find peace."

Speaking to reporters outside the court in London, Mr Sullivan's sister, Kim Smith, said: "We lost Peter for 39 years. Peter hasn't won and neither

has the Sindall family. They've lost their daughter, they are not going to get her back.

'we've done it'

"We've got Peter back, and now we've got to try and build a life around him again. We feel sorry for the Sindalls, and it's such a shame this had to happen in the first place."

Mr Sullivan's family members, sitting in the public gallery of the court, were emotional as the decision was given, with Kim tearfully declaring: "We've done it."

Mr Sullivan watched proceedings at the Court of Appeal via video link from HMP Wakefield.

As the judgment was handed down by Mr Justice Holroyde and his conviction was formally quashed, the prisoner broke down sobbing as he held his hand to his mouth.

Ms Sindall, a 21-year-old bride-to-be from the Wirral, Merseyside, had run out of petrol while driving home from work on August 1, 1986, and decided to walk to the nearest garage to fill up a jerry can.

her before beating her to death.

Mr Sullivan was later dubbed the "Beast of Birkenhead" and "the wolfman" because bite marks had been found on the victim's body. On the night of the murder, Mr Sullivan, an unemployed labourer from nearby Birkenhead, had been playing darts at a local pub and drinking.

The "quiet loner" was subsequently arrested and repeatedly interviewed without having a solicitor present. He initially made a confession but later retracted it, prompting questions of whether detectives adhered to the Police and Criminal Evidence Act.

The bite marks found on Ms Sindall's body were, in the initial trial,

said to match Mr Sullivan's dental records.

He was ordered to serve a minimum of 16 years before being eligible for parole, but because he always maintained his innocence he was never approved for release on licence.

His legal team first raised his case with the Criminal Cases Review Commission in 2008, but was rejected.

He applied again in 2021 after new forensic work discovered the DNA of an unknown man that had been recovered from the crime scene and stored. Cops reopened the case but the sample did not match any stored on the database used by police, and the killer remains unfound.

Secretary Robert Jenrick, who came close to winning the leadership of the Conservatives last year.

Mr Jenrick said: "It's important that the Prime Minister and anyone in public life has their family, their homes, protected."

"We have robust disagreements in politics but I want to ensure anyone who chooses to go into public life feels that they'll be properly protected and that we have civility in our debate."

"It is absolutely wrong, disgraceful, for any individual to take the kind of action that we saw against the Prime Minister's home."

14 years for gummy maker after lab explosion kills child

A DRUG dealer who killed a boy of seven in an explosion while making cannabis gummies at home has been jailed for 14 years.

Reece Galbraith, 33, and his accomplice Jason Laws were using a Newcastle flat as a drugs lab when the blast ripped through the building in the early hours of October 16. Archie York, who was fast asleep in the flat above the den, died, as did Laws, 35.

Galbraith, of Gateshead, Tyne and Wear, admitted two counts of manslaughter as well as possessing and supplying cannabis, at a hearing last month.

On Monday he was jailed for 14 years at Newcastle Crown Court. Archie's mother Katherine Errington screamed: "You killed my son" at Galbraith as she read an emotional victim impact statement to the court. Sobbing, she told the defendant: "You brought gas canisters into a building where families lived. You ran a drugs operation under the floor where my children slept.

"You took risks for profit and didn't care who got hurt. You killed my son."

The strength of the blast destroyed the Benwell street and left a number of families homeless, as six out of the 12 flats in the block had to be demolished.

More than 100 people were also shunted to temporary accommodation and 53 of the 80 residents will not be returning.

The financial impact is said to be about £3.7million. The flat operated by Galbraith and Laws was used to produce cannabis concentrates, known as "shatter" or "butane honey oil", in a highly dangerous process involving 100 butane canisters.

Six Bulgarians jailed in Russian spy plot

■ Ringleader ran his 'minions' from former Norfolk guesthouse

SIX Bulgarians have been jailed after being convicted of spying for Russia in one of the "largest and most complex" enemy operations uncovered on British soil.

Ringleader Orlin Roussev, 47, who dubbed his underlings "Minions", led the spy ring from a rundown former guesthouse in Great Yarmouth, Norfolk. He was sentenced to 10 years and eight months on Tuesday.

The court had heard the network was directed by alleged Russian agent Jan Marsalek, 44, an Austrian businessman wanted by Interpol.

Marsalek acted as a go-between for Russian intelligence and Roussev, who led the operation in the UK.

Roussev had admitted his role along with his second-in-command, Biser Dzhambazov, 44, who was jailed for 10 years and two months and Ivan Stoyanov, 33, who got five years and

three weeks in prison.

Female "honeytrap" agents Katrin Ivanova, 33, and Vanya Gaberova, 30, and competitive swimmer Tihomir Ivanov Ivanchev, 39, were found guilty at the Old Bailey in March of activities which police have said put lives and national security at risk.

Mr Justice Hilliard jailed Ivanova, of Harrow, North West London, for nine years and eight months, saying she had "thrown in" her lot with her partner Dzhambazov.

'naive' beautician

Gaberova, of Euston, North London, was jailed for six years, eight months, having found spying for Russia to be "exciting and glamorous", the judge said.

Her ex-boyfriend Ivanchev, of Acton, West London, was sentenced to eight years.

Earlier in mitigation for "naive" beautician Gaberova, Anthony Metzer KC said her

case was "tragic" as she would never have got involved but for her infatuation with Dzhambazov, who had falsely claimed to have cancer and be working for Interpol while retaining his relationship with Ivanova.

Mr Justice Hilliard commended officers for their "extremely thorough and determined investigative work".

He said the defendants were "motivated by money" and lived "very comfortably" on their substantial pay. He made a confiscation order for Roussev to pay £180,768.

Victims targeted by the spy ring had been left "deeply concerned" and been forced to enhance their security, the judge said.

He said Roussev would have been aware of the "extreme actions" Russia had taken against those it regarded as an "enemy" of the state.

Police pieced together six operations dating back to August 2020 from more than 100,000 Telegram messages on Roussev's phone.

The spy ring operated over at least three years and engaged in surveil-

lance and intelligence operations in the UK, Austria, Spain, Germany and Montenegro. They also kidnapped a man in Britain. Spyware was recovered including audio-visual devices hidden in a rock, ties, a coke bottle and a Minions toy.

Commander Dominic Murphy, head of Scotland Yard's Counter Terrorism Command, said: "The investigation team worked incredibly hard to piece together a complex and wide-ranging conspiracy that I would describe as espionage on an industrial scale."

Drought likely after UK sees driest spring for 70 years

Exceptionally low river flows are predicted across the UK this summer as a drought becomes more likely, scientists have said.

An update from the UK Centre for Ecology and Hydrology (UKCEH) says dry, warm weather is expected over the next three months, putting pressure on water resources.

Hosepipe bans and other forms of water rationing are more likely the longer the country goes without significant rainfall. On Tuesday the Thames Water chief executive, Chris Weston, said he was not ruling out restrictions.

James Wallace, the chief executive of River Action, said: "This crisis was avoidable. But thanks to corporate greed and reg-

ulatory complacency, our reservoirs are running dry and our rivers are polluted with sewage."

The UKCEH hydrological outlook reads: "Over the period May-July, river flows in most areas are likely to continue to be below normal, with the potential for current low to exceptionally low flows to persist in some catchments."

Dwindling reservoir levels put waterways at risk as farmers and water companies abstract from rivers when other water sources run low.

River flows are already far below average for the time of year, with almost every catchment in the UK below normal. UKCEH records show that some areas

have had the lowest October to March flows since records for those places be-

gan in 1958.

No reservoirs have been built in England for more

than 30 years, which leaves the country particularly vulnerable to drought.

BBC boss outlines measures to tackle ‘crisis of trust’

■ “The future of our civilized, cohesive, democratic society is, for the first time in my life, at risk.”

The BBC can help tackle a “crisis of trust” in UK society, the broadcaster’s director general has said.

Tim Davie has used a landmark speech this week to set out measures he says will allow the broadcaster to play a leading role in reversing a breakdown in trust in information and institutions, as well as combating division and disconnection between people.

They include expanding fact-checking service BBC Verify, giving children lessons about disinformation, and doing more to scrutinize local politicians.

He also said the system of funding the BBC “should be reformed and should be modernized” - but didn’t say whether the licence fee should survive or what should replace it.

Mr Davie used the speech to civic and com-

munity leaders in Salford to set out his vision for the corporation’s future, and the role it can play in the UK.

“The BBC is ready to play its full part – not simply defending tradition, but shaping the future,” he said.

“A future where trusted information strengthens democracy, where every child has a fair start, where creativity fuels growth and social capital, and where no-one is left behind in the digital age.”

Mr Davie added: “The future of our civilized, cohesive, democratic society is, for the first time in my life, at risk.”

‘must reform faster’

The BBC’s current royal charter, which sets out the terms and purposes of its existence, expires in 2027, and negotiations with the

government about its renewal are ramping up.

The BBC must “reform faster and get more support to avoid decline”, he said.

He said he was not asking for the “status quo” in funding, and said he would “keep an open mind” about the future of the licence fee or what could replace it.

Any future method of funding must ensure the BBC remains a universal service, he stressed.

Asked whether the days of the TV licence are over, he replied: “I think a universal payment is not over. What it’s called, I think, is slightly secondary.

“The thing is, do we want a universal fee? The current licence fee works and I think is a very good system, but we are saying that based on changing

audience behaviour and these huge changes in the world, the system should be reformed and should be modernised.

“But what we do want is a way in which everyone pays for the BBC fairly, and that is absolutely what we’re hunting for.”

Funding the BBC from advertising or subscription would not “pass the test of building a universal trusted public service”, he said.

He also called for “more help” from the government to fund the World Service, calling it a “priceless national asset”, and saying “the government should invest for significant growth, not survival”.

In his speech, Mr Davie argued that the BBC could play a key part in making the UK a “global leader in trusted information”,

support democracy, boost education and economic growth, and improve digital access.

The BBC’s future would involve “doubling down on impartiality, championing free, fair reporting alongside landmark investigative journalism, investing in BBC Verify and InDepth as well as increasing transparency and holding our nerve amidst culture wars”, he said.

The BBC can “help turn the tide” and improve trust by “dramatically increasing” the amount of news coverage on platforms like YouTube and Tik Tok have a stronger presence amid the online noise.

It will also combine AI agent technology with BBC journalism to create “a new gold standard fact checking tool”, he said, but without relinquishing

editorial oversight.

“Our aim is to work globally with other public service broadcasters to ensure a healthy core of fact-based news.”

The BBC will also:

- Expand its expand Local Democracy Reporting Service from focusing on local councils to scrutinise health authorities, police and crime commissioners, and regional mayors

- Create specialist BBC Insight teams across the UK to do more investigative reporting, and expand local BBC Verify and InDepth work

- Launch new political debate radio shows for different areas, modelled on Radio 4’s Any Questions

- Give every child “proper training on disinformation” and potentially develop qualifications in disinformation studies.

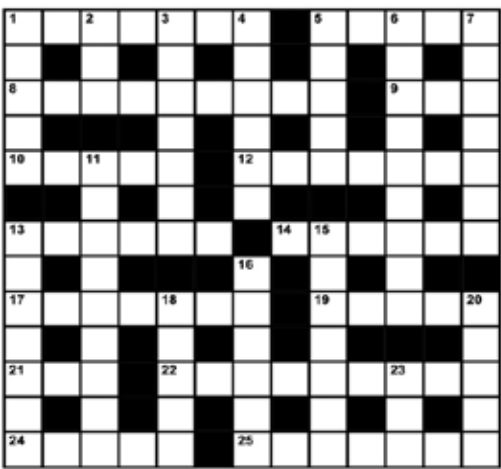

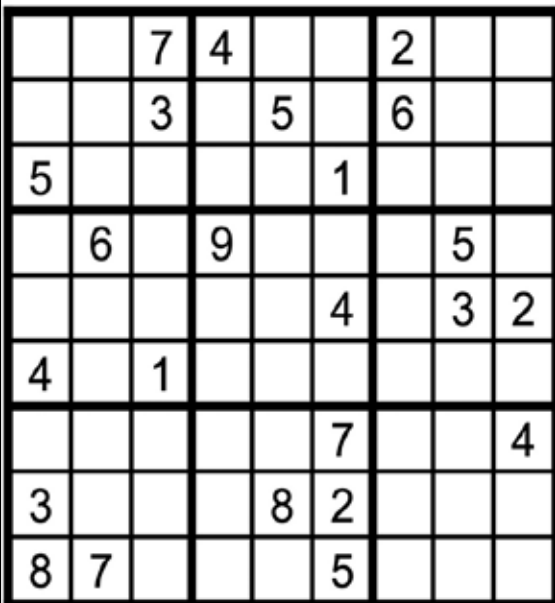

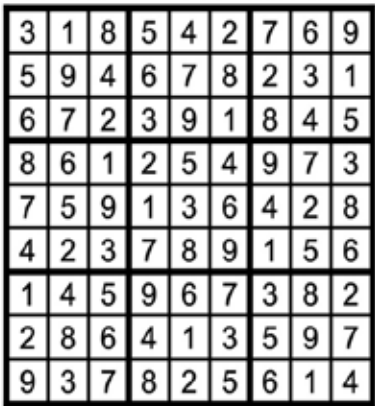

"This season has been tough," he said on Thursday. "It is not nice to lose so many games. It is boring and not fun. That's why we need to finish well and get a trophy.

"It is a good habit to reach Wembley and always important to win trophies. We have the FA Cup final to play for and in a horrific season we still managed to do this."

Pep Guardiola's side, who are 18 points behind Premier League champions Liverpool, had been English champions in each of the past four seasons and conquered Europe in 2023.

They are fourth in the Premier League, their Champions League hopes were ended by Real Madrid in the

knockout play-offs and they lost to Tottenham in the fourth round of the Carabao Cup.

"When you have won four league titles in a row, if you don't win five it's not going to be a successful season," said Haaland.

"Those are the standards we have set. We haven't done good enough in the league but still hoping for Champions League qualification.

"Crystal Palace are a really difficult club to play against. At Selhurst Park we drew (2-2 in December) and they started really well at the Etihad (in City's 5-2 win last month).

"They are an amazing team with quality players."

Haaland joined City in a £51.2m deal from Borussia Dortmund in June 2022, with his goals helping Guardiola's side to win two Premier

Leagues, the Champions League, an FA Cup and a Uefa Super Cup.

On a personal level, he has won the Golden Boot for being the top scorer in the Premier League in both 2022-23 and 2023-24, when he scored 36 and 27 league goals respectively.

Haaland started the season in similar fashion with 10 goals in his first five Premier League matches, but scored 11 in his next 23.

"We haven't been stable enough this season and we haven't won enough games, it is as simple as that," he added.

Palace seek to end final hoodoo

On Saturday, Crystal Palace return to Wembley as they face Manchester City in the FA Cup final.

It will be the club's third FA Cup final in their history, however, they will be hoping this time will be more successful than on previous occasions.

Currently, they are one of just four clubs to have reached two FA Cup finals and never lift the trophy.

They are certainly in a rich vein of form, seeing off a dismal Spurs side on Sunday in match which was a battle between two finalists in two competitions, using very different preparation techniques. Palace manager Oliver Glasner made it clear that he favoured momentum over resting and rotation, and his starters delivered a comfortable win.

The Europa League is an enticing proposition to those in the Premier League mid-table. If two teams with such tepid league performances are in a position to win this trophy, any Premier League entrant has the potential to win it.

Crystal Palace will have to beat City on Saturday to get there.

They start as underdogs facing a club managed by one of the all-time greats, a team with an array of world-class players, whilst backed by vast Abu Dhabi resources.

But Palace are by no means a downtrodden club and fanbase anymore. Success is relative to each club, and they have had over a decade of it, despite the usual jokes about always finishing 10th to 14th in the league.

Crystal Palace deserve to be in big cup matches, they have the right to keep their best talents and battle against the best in the country. Most importantly, this manager has changed the mentality of the squad and fans alike.

Glasner and his team are now just 90 minutes from glory, and unlike nine years ago and Alan Pardew's infamous touchline jig after Palace took a brief lead against Manchester United before suffering late heartbreak, there won't be any danc-ing until the job is done.

I'm not quitting, vows Amorim

■ Under fire United manager insists he has the solutions and insists losing Europa League final would be 'a waste of time'

Manchester United manager Ruben Amorim says he has no intention of walking out on the club.

In the immediate aftermath of Sunday's Premier League defeat by West Ham, Amorim said if he could not sort the club's problems out heading into next season United should find someone who could.

That has been interpreted as the former Sporting boss beginning to realize he has taken on a job that might be beyond him.

However, in a Uefa briefing at Old Trafford arranged to preview the Europa League final against Tottenham on 21 May, he said that was not the case.

"I'm far from quitting," he said.

"I have a clear idea of what to do and I understand the problems of

the team.

"Since I arrived here, I'm always talking about standards. I cannot see the team having these results, especially in the Premier League, and not say anything or take the responsibility.

"What I'm saying is that we need to perform or else they [the club's hierarchy] will change us. That is normal."

While Amorim has guided United to a European final for only the third time since 2011, his side have been terrible in the Premier League.

They go into the penultimate round of fixtures in 16th place and are heading for their worst finish since the 1973-74 relegation campaign.

United have won four league games in 2025, three of which were against the teams who got relegated. Their only

league victories since winning at Fulham on 26 January were against Ipswich and Leicester.

It could be argued a failure to beat Tottenham would at least provide more clear midweeks for Amorim to work with his squad next season.

The coach does not view it that way at all.

"I am not going to use that as an excuse," he said. "That would be really bad.

"If we don't win it is going to be really tough, and the patience of the fans and you guys [the media] next year is going to be on the limit.

"We would have to be perfect to continue with everything - I know that. So it's not going to be better in that way."

The aftermath of the West Ham defeat has been filled with stories about the plans United's hierarchy have put in

place around the final.

There will be no parade in the event of a win against Tottenham. Instead celebrations will be restricted to a low-key barbeque at the club's Carrington training ground when Amorim's squad return on Thursday.

Amorim has his own experience of a Europa League final, as a player in the Benfica side beaten on penalties by Sevilla in Turin in 2014.

Aside from the £100m financial windfall that qualification for the Champions League would bring, as a

straightforward football match Amorim knows next week is not a game to lose.

"I will never say I was a finalist," he said. "The feeling has to be 'what a waste of time'.

"My message to the players is we have to win or it doesn't matter."
