PM hails EU “reset”

■ EU President promises deal will open a
“new chapter in our unique relationship”

Keir Starmer has vowed to deliver cheaper food and energy for the British nation, heralding a “win-win” as he unveiled an EU “reset” deal this week.

“Britain is back on the world stage,” the prime minister said after shaking hands on the deal with the EU’s Ursula von der Leyen in London. “It gives us unprecedented access to the EU market, the best of any country ... all while sticking to the red lines in our manifesto.”

Von der Leyen described it as “a historic moment ... opening a new chapter in our unique relationship”. But attacks came immediately from rightwing parties, which said the deal would make the UK a “rule taker” from Brussels.

Starmer emphasised the tangible benefits the deal would do for Britons, including cheaper food in supermarkets and an end to passport queues at European airports with a deal for travellers to use European e-gates. No 10 hopes both can be clinched within a year.

Flanked by von der Leyen and European Council President Antonio Costa at London’s Lancaster House, Starmer said the deal

marked “a new era in our relationship”.

Von der Leyen said it sent a message: “At a time of global instability, and when our continent faces the greatest threat it has for generations, we in Europe stick together.”

economic boost

Britain said the reset with its biggest trading partner would reduce red tape for agricultural producers - making food cheaper - improve energy security and, by 2040, add nearly £9 billion (\$12.1 billion) to the economy, which is about £2.6 trillion in size.

It is the third deal Britain has struck this month, after agreements with India and the U.S., and while it is unlikely to lead to an immediate economic boost, it could lift business confidence, drawing much-needed investment.

At the heart of the reset is a defence and security pact that will let Britain be part of any joint procurement and pave the way for British companies including

BAE, Rolls-Royce and Babcock to take part in a 150 billion euro (\$167 billion) programme to rearm Europe.

The deal also paves the way for the UK’s return to the Erasmus university exchange programme, and the creation of a youth mobility scheme that would allow young people access to the EU through work, study, au pair or travel.

The impetus to reset defence and trade ties with the EU has dramatically grown since President Donald Trump’s upending of the global order, which pushed the two sides to move on from their acrimonious Brexit divorce.

bitterly divided

Trump’s tariffs, alongside warnings that Europe should do more to protect itself, forced governments around the world to rethink trade, defence and security ties, bringing British Prime Minister Keir Starmer closer to European leaders.

But the UK remains bitterly divided over

Brexit, and some aspects of the deal, especially those which allow continued access for European fishermen to UK waters, prompted uproar from some quarters.

Nigel Farage, head of the pro-Brexit Reform UK party, called the deal an “abject surrender - the end of the fishing industry”. The Scottish Fishermen’s Federation called it a “horror show”.

Chris Curtis, a Labour member of parliament, said the deal would correct some of the problems created by the Conservatives’ original deal agreed after Brex-

it and said he believed most people wanted improved relations.

“It is very easy to pretend that there are no tradeoffs, that you can get everything you want, and you don’t have to give anything away, but that is clearly baloney,” he told re-

porters.

Polls show a majority of Britons now regret the vote although they do not want to re-join. Farage, who campaigned for Brexit for decades, now leads in opinion polls in Britain, giving Starmer limited room for manoeuvre.

UK finally agrees deal on Chagos Islands

■ Mauritius gets the territory but will lease back strategically vital base for 99 years

Sir Keir Starmer has signed a deal to hand the Chagos Islands to Mauritius and lease back a key military base for £101m a year.

The prime minister said the deal was the only way to maintain the base's long-term future and strengthened the UK's national security.

Under the terms of the agreement Mauritius would gain sovereignty of the islands from the UK, but allow the US and UK to continue operating a military base

on Diego Garcia for an initial period of 99 years. The Conservatives described the deal as "an act of national self-harm", which left the UK "more exposed to China" because of its ties with Mauritius.

The UK signed the agreement after overcoming a last-minute legal challenge brought by two Chagossians.

The government said it would pay Mauritius an average of £101m a year for 99 years, which Sir Keir said amounted

to a "net cost" of £3.4bn after adjusting for factors including inflation.

The prime minister told a news conference the UK had to "act now" or face Mauritian legal action that could interfere with the Diego Garcia base.

Speaking from the UK's Northwood military headquarters, Sir Keir said: "President Trump has welcomed the deal along with other allies, because they see the strategic importance of this base and that we

cannot cede the ground to others who would seek to do us harm."

He added: "If we did not agree this deal the legal situation would mean that we would not be able to prevent China or any other nation setting up their own bases on the outer islands or carrying out joint exercises near our base."

"No responsible government could let that happen."

The deal sets a 24-mile buffer around Diego Garcia, where nothing

can be built without UK consent.

Foreign military and civilian forces will also be barred from other islands in the archipelago, with the UK retaining a power to veto any access to the islands.

There is also an option to extend the lease by 40 further years, if agreed by both sides.

The treaty comes into effect only after it is approved by both the UK and Mauritian parliaments.

Net migration drops by almost half

■ Reduction provides welcome relief for government, who have been haemorrhaging votes to Reform over the issue

Net migration to the UK has nearly halved over the year to 431,000, the Office for National Statistics (ONS) has said, publishing figures that will bring some relief to Keir Starmer.

The drop from 860,000 in the year to December 2024 follows a series of policies implemented by the last Conservative government that have been continued by the present Labour government.

It is the biggest calendar-year drop since the early stages of the Covid pandemic, when net migration fell from 184,000

in the year ending December 2019 to 93,000 in the year ending December 2020.

It is also the largest numerical drop for any 12-month period. The ONS said the sharp decline was caused by reduced immigration from non-EU countries for work and study visas and by an increase in emigration from the UK.

A large number of international students who originally came before the Covid-19 travel restrictions to the UK were eased had also left, the ONS said.

In June 2023, net migration hit a record high of 906,000 and it stood at 728,000 in the year to June 2024, shortly before Labour took over from the previous Conservative government.

The issue of net migration has become a key electoral battleground, with deepening concern among voters about the NHS, housing and the small boats crisis in the Channel.

With the challenge from Nigel Farage's Reform UK focused on immigration, the figures will be claimed as a boost to

Starmer, who has pledged to reduce them before the next election.

The fall in numbers has also been caused by a series of restrictions introduced by the Conservative government in the year before July's general election.

These included a ban on foreign students and care workers bringing dependants with them to the UK, a doubling in the minimum salary threshold needed for work visas to £38,700 and the minimum income needed for British residents to bring family members to join

them to £29,000.

The figure for 2024 was calculated by taking the number of people immigrating, and subtracting the number of people emigrating. Data shows that 948,000 people came to Britain in 2024, and 517,000 left.

Immigration was down by almost a third, from 1,326,000 in the previous 12 months, and below 1 million for the first time since the 12 months to March 2022. Emigration was up by about 11%, from 466,000 in the previous year.

The number of people

leaving the UK has returned to a similar level as in the year ending June 2017.

After Reform UK's success in May's local elections, Labour has hardened its position on immigration.

Starmer was criticized last week when he said the UK risked becoming an "island of strangers" without tough new policies. Some politicians said his words echoed Powell's notorious "rivers of blood" speech, which imagined a future multicultural Britain where the white population "found



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Diplomatic spat erupts following arrest of three Iranian nationals

BRITAIN and Iran summoned each other's diplomats this week after the UK charged three Iranians under a national security law following a major counter-terrorism investigation.

The Government said it had demanded that Iranian ambassador Seyed Ali Mousavi appear at the Foreign Office to be grilled over Iran's activity in the UK.

And Iran summoned the British charge d'affaires in Tehran over the arrests of its nationals, calling the accusations "false claims".

It came as the Government vowed to proscribe Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps as a terrorist organization after foiling a suspected atrocity.

Enemy spy agencies will face terrorism-style crackdowns to prevent them plotting assassinations, kidnapping and sabotage, Home Secretary Yvette Cooper vowed.

surveillance

In what is a separate case, the three men have been charged with spying on behalf of Iran. Mostafa Sepahvand, 39, Farhad Javadi Manesh, 44, and Shapoor Qalehali Khani Noori, 55, were remanded in custody at Westminster Magistrates' Court on Saturday charged with offences under the National Security Act.

They are all charged with engaging in conduct likely to assist the Iranian foreign intelligence service between August 14, 2024 and February 16, 2025. The three arrived by irregular means, including by small boats and a lorry, between 2016 and 2022, magistrates

heard. Sepahvand is also charged with engaging in surveillance, reconnaissance and open-source research, intending to commit acts, namely serious violence, against a person in the UK.

Manesh and Noori are further charged with engaging in surveillance and reconnaissance, with the intention that acts, namely serious violence against a person in the UK, would be committed by others. The trio will appear at the Old Bailey on June 6.

Speaking in the Commons, the Home Secretary said groups such as the IRGC would be "named and shamed", and proscribed as state-based threats, under proposed powers.

Police will also be allowed to seize foreign agents' passports and use stop and search powers in target locations.

It follows a review by the terrorism watchdog head, Jonathan Hall KC, who warned terrorism legislation was not suitable to counter threats by Russia, Iran and China.

Ms Cooper told MPs: "We will not stand for foreign state organisations seeking to escalate threats on UK soil.

"The Iranian regime poses an unacceptable threat to our domestic security which cannot continue.

"Malign activities against us by or on behalf of foreign states have grown.

"We have seen malign foreign state organisations seek to exploit any vulnerability, from criminal networks to our cyber security to our borders, to do us harm."

BBC gives Lineker early red card over pro-Palestine social media post

GARY Lineker will leave the BBC with no pay-off after hosting his final Match of the Day on Sunday, ending a 26-year run.

Lineker, 64, was set to lead coverage of next season's FA Cup before the 2026 World Cup in the United States, Canada and Mexico.

But BBC bosses have ripped up his contract in the wake of his latest social media controversy, which sparked angry calls for the football presenter to leave.

The Beeb veteran has faced intense scrutiny after sharing a pro-Palestine video criticising Zionism, which included an image of a rat.

Lineker later removed the post and apologized, stressing he was unaware that rats were used to represent Jews in antisemitic propaganda throughout history.

But a backlash has prompted BBC bosses to agree that his position has become untenable. Lineker said in a statement: "Football has been at the heart of my life for as long as I can remember, both on the

pitch and in the studio.

"I care deeply about the game and about the work I've done with the BBC over many years. As I've said, I would never consciously repost anything antisemitic. It goes against everything I stand for.

"However, I recognize the error and upset that I caused, and reiterate how sorry I am. Stepping back now feels like the responsible course of action."

BBC director-general Tim Davie had been under pressure to axe Lineker for days, with

Jewish staff expressing "disgust" over the star's actions.

Mr Davie said: "Gary has acknowledged the mistake he made. Accordingly, we have agreed he will step back from further presenting after this season. We want to thank him for the contribution he has made."

Lineker has been the BBC's highest-paid presenter for seven consecutive years, pocketing around £1.35million last year. His 2023-24 payday was 42% larger than that of the organization's

next highest-earning star, Zoe Ball. But this is not the first time the former England striker has landed himself in hot water over his outspoken views on world issues.

In March 2023, Lineker was suspended and forced off air after comparing the Conservative government's immigration policy with 1930s Germany.

His Match of the Day absence was short-lived though after pundits refused to appear on the show in a display of solidarity.

'Morally unjustifiable' Gaza escalation prompts government to suspend trade talks

The UK has suspended talks on a trade deal with Israel, summoned the country's ambassador and imposed fresh sanctions on West Bank settlers, as Foreign Secretary David Lammy called the military escalation in Gaza "morally unjustifiable".

The move follows warnings of starvation in Gaza after Israel launched a new military operation over the weekend.

There were fiery exchanges in Parliament with Conservative shadow foreign secretary

Dame Priti Patel, who suggested the actions would be welcomed by

Hamas, but also angry calls for the government to go further.

In response, Israel's foreign spokesman said external pressure would "not divert Israel from its path in defending its existence".

Global experts have warned of a looming famine because the Israeli government has blockaded supplies of food, fuel and medicine to Gaza for the last 11 weeks.

Officials say the sheer scale of the humanitarian crisis after two months of blockade played a part in the latest announcements, as did growing pressure from MPs and the public.

PM forced into U-turn over OAP winter fuel payments

Keir Starmer has been forced into an embarrassing U-turn over his decision to axe winter fuel payments from 10 million pensioners.

The prime minister on Wednesday signalled that his government had revisited the issue and the planned 'to make more pensioners eligible for the payment.'

It follows a furious backlash from voters and Labour MPs to the deeply unpopular policy.

His comments at prime minister's questions suggest that the income threshold for qualifying for the annual payment, which is currently £11,500, will be increased so that more pensioners are eligible for it.

Starmer told the Commons: "I recognise that people are still feeling the pressure of the cost-of-living crisis including pensioners.

"As the economy improves, we want to make sure people feel those improvements in their days as their lives go forward. That is why we want to ensure that as we go forward more pensioners are eligible for winter fuel payments."

Reports began to emerge last month that the chancellor was holding talks in Downing Street on changing the winter fuel policy, which she announced shortly after Labour won the election last July.

Downing Street had initially denied it had any plans to water down the policy, despite it being partly blamed for Labour's disastrous result at this month's local elections.

25-year term for Egyptian fisherman who netted £12m in migrant smuggling scheme

An Egyptian fisherman who helped organize the movement of more than 3,000 migrants as part of a £12 million illegal boat crossing operation has been jailed for 25 years.

UK-based Ahmed Ebid, 42, was involved in smuggling nearly 3,800 people from North Africa to Italy between October 2022 and June 2023, with some making their way to Britain, the National Crime Agency (NCA) said.

Ebid is the first person in the UK to be convicted of being involved in people smuggling across the Mediterranean Sea from Africa to Italy.

He arrived in the UK on a small boat in 2022 after spending five years in jail in Italy for attempted drug smuggling. He applied for asylum in the UK but never received a decision.

'managerial role'

That meant he had been in legal limbo, neither facing removal nor being granted permission to stay. His sentence means he will almost certainly be deported once it has been

served.

Ebid, whose wife and sons are in the UK, had been living in Home Office-funded accommodation in south-west London at the time of his arrest.

At his sentencing hearing at Southwark Crown Court on Tuesday, the judge said Ebid ruthlessly exploited desperate individuals and his "primary motivation was to make money out of human trafficking".

"The treatment of migrants was horrifying," Judge Adam Hiddleston said.

"This was a commercial enterprise, pure and simple. The risk of loss of life was considerable. These were fishing boats, not ferries".

Ebid "exercised a managerial role at a very high level", the court heard, bribing officials and ordering threats of violence towards the migrants.

After he was sentenced, Ebid was heard in the dock shouting that it was "unfair" and that he was "saving money to bring my family over".

While this was happen-

ing, a female member of Ebid's family cried in the public gallery.

He was arrested in 2023 after Italian security services looked into satellite phones being used by migrants on Mediterranean crossings from Libya to Europe, in particular Italy.

'cruel nature'

They found that some handsets which were being used to call the country's coastguard had also been connecting during the journey to a British mobile number.

The NCA linked that mobile phone to Ebid and then bugged his home to record evidence.

The agency found he was involved in a number of smuggling operations, transporting thousands of men, women and children, often in dangerously overcrowded fishing vessels.

Ebid even told an associate to kill and throw any migrants caught with their phones into the sea, in a bid to avoid law enforcement, the NCA said.

The smuggler had described himself on

Facebook as "Captain Ahmed" and notebooks in his home included Mediterranean Sea navigational details and lists of payments related to crossings.

Ebid had admitted facilitating illegal immigration to the EU - a crime under UK law - but disputed the importance of his role.

The NCA's investigation revealed he had a management role in the smuggling network.

Jacque Beer, regional head of investigation at the NCA, said: "Ebid was part of a crime network who preyed upon the desperation of migrants to ship them across the Mediterranean in death trap boats.

"The cruel nature of his business was demonstrated by the callous way he spoke of throwing migrants into the sea if they didn't follow his rules. To him they were just a source of profit."

West Nile virus found in UK for first time

West Nile virus has been detected in UK mosquitoes for the first time, UK health officials say.

Although the virus, which mainly spreads between birds but can also infect people if they're bitten by an infected mosquito, can sometimes make people seriously ill, there is no evidence it is spreading in the UK and the risk to the general public is "very low", the UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) said.

The virus is found in many parts of the world, including Africa, South

America and mainland Europe.

Climate change and other factors have been pushing mosquitoes - and the diseases they carry - further north in recent years.

West Nile virus causes either very minor symptoms or none at all - but around 20% of infected people can experience headaches, high fever and skin issues. In rare cases, it can kill through serious brain illnesses, including encephalitis or meningitis.

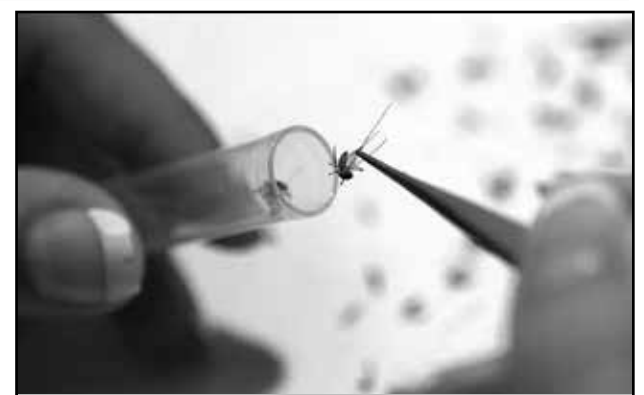
No specific treatment or

vaccines exist for humans.

To date, there have been no human cases of West Nile virus acquired in the UK - although, since 2000, there have been seven cases of the disease linked to travel to other countries.

West Nile virus is usually present in several regions across the world, including parts of Africa, Asia, South America and Europe, and has expanded in recent years.

Research by the UKHSA and the Animal and Plant Health Agency (APHA) found fragments of the virus in mosquitoes

collected at ponds near Retford, Nottinghamshire in 2023.

"While this is the first detection of West Nile Virus in mosquitoes in the UK so far, it is not unexpected as the virus is already widespread in Europe," said Dr Meera Chand, a deputy director

for travel health and infections at UKHSA.

Dr Arran Folly, who led the project which found the virus, said its detection is part of a "wider changing landscape, where, in the wake of climate change mosquito-borne diseases are expanding to new areas".

Sir Elton brands Labour “absolute losers” over AI plans

■ Superstar ‘incredibly betrayed’ over plans to exempt technology firms from copyright laws

Sir Elton John this week branded Labour ministers “absolute losers” over plans to exempt technology firms from copyright laws.

The legendary singer, 78, said he felt “incredibly betrayed” after proposals to force AI companies to disclose what material they were using to develop their programs were rejected in Parliament.

The House of Lords wanted to amend the Data (Use and Access) Bill to include stronger protections against AI. But last week MPs voted 297 to 168 to oppose the change.

Sir Elton’s songwriting partnership with Bernie Taupin is one of the most successful in pop history, and he is just one of hundreds of creative workers who have urged the Government to protect copyright law.

Speaking on Sunday he said: “It’s criminal, in that I feel incredibly betrayed.

“The House of Lords did a vote, and it was more than two to one in our favour.

“The Government just looked at it as if to say, ‘Hmm, well, the old people, like me, can afford it’. Some people aren’t like me – they don’t earn as much as I do.

‘theft and thievery’

“But when they’re creative and it comes from the human soul and not a machine – because a machine isn’t capable of writing anything with any soul in it...if you’re going to rob young people of their legacy and their income, it’s a criminal offence, I think.”

He added: “The Government are just being absolute losers, and I’m very angry about it.”

Sir Elton said that his supporters were prepared to take ministers to court over the issue, adding: “We’ll fight it all the way.”

He insisted if ministers did go ahead with the plans to allow AI firms to use artists’ content without paying, they would be “committing theft and thievery on a high scale”.

The Government has said “no changes” to copyright laws would be considered “unless we are completely satisfied they work for creators”.

A spokesman for the Department for Science, Innovation and Technology added: “We want our creative industries and AI companies to flourish, which is why we have been separately consulting on measures we hope will work for both sectors.

“We have always been clear we will not rush into any decisions or bring forward legislation until we are confident we have a practical

plan which delivers on each of our objectives.”

It comes after Sir Paul McCartney said

he feared that AI was bringing in “rip-off” technology, making it impossible for musicians to make a living.

Self taught pianist invited to Royal Academy of Music - after just five months of playing

An 11-year-old boy who taught himself to play the piano in five months by watching YouTube videos has been invited to Britain’s most prestigious music school.

Harvey Goodbody, from Stoke Ferry, near Downham Market, Norfolk, only started playing at the end of last year, but has already reached the advanced grade eight standard, according to his teacher.

Videos of Harvey (pictured, right with his mother Jen) playing have been posted online and have gained thousands of views.

The Royal Academy of Music has invited him in for an induction day, to spend time with professionals to explore what he can do with his talent.

Harvey said he started to play the pi-



ano because he found learning the music “satisfying”.

He has performed at the care home where his mother works and on public pianos at railway stations.

“It is really nice when you get applause from people. It makes you feel like your performance has been accepted,” he said.

Jen said he had not inherited his ability from her, joking that while she could play “Chopsticks”, she would not describe

herself as musical.

“He’s taught himself off YouTube,” she said.

“[He has] just decided ‘Yes, that’s what I want to play’ and since then, he’s on there for hours a day”.

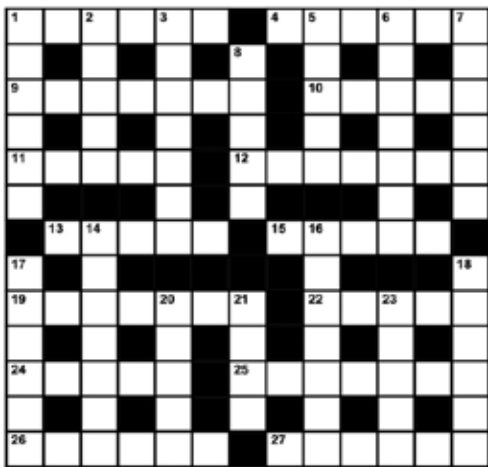
Jen said she was very proud of Harvey and keen to explore what his musical talent might mean for his future.

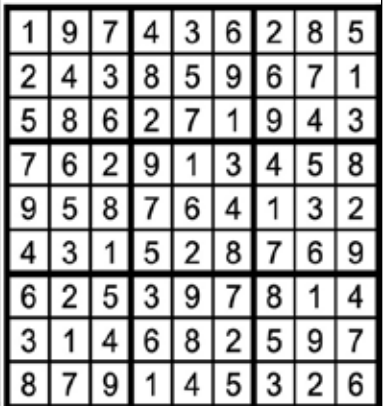

On yer bike: McGregor and Boorman saddle up one last (?) time for The Long Way Home

Roaring back onto the small screen this month are Ewan McGregor and Charley Boorman, the likely lads-turned-slightly geezerish best pals who have returned to Apple TV for their fourth motorcycle travel series, the Long Way Home.

Following on from the three previous entries in the series (Long Way Round, Long Way Down, and Long Way Up), this time the duo seek to recapture the charm and relatability of their original adventures, scaling back from the more polished, corporate-backed feel of Long Way Up, which involved electric Harley-Davidsons and a heavily supported journey from the southern tip of South America to Los Angeles.

shift in pace

Now aiming for a "back to basics" approach, Long Way Home presents a more personal and intimate journey. The new route begins in the UK - McGregor in Perthshire and Boorman in Suffolk - and spans roughly 10,000 miles through 17 countries. It takes them up to the Arctic Circle and back through the Baltics and western Europe, in the gentler summer months. This shift in pace and scale, coupled with vintage motorbikes (McGregor on a 1974 Moto Guzzi and Boorman on a BMW R75/5), signals a more nostalgic, relaxed road trip - reflective of both men's aging bodies and evolving priorities. Boorman, who has endured multiple serious motorbike accidents, rides with more caution now, understandably so, as noted by his wife Olly.

The production of

the show reflects this scaled-down ethos. Gone are the sleek offices and sprawling logistics crews; instead, viewers see a map pinned in McGregor's garage, a small, familiar crew, and more time spent with their families. The show is designed to feel spontaneous and grounded, even if some of that may be deliberate staging.

The first episode is a slow burner. Rather than launching straight into the trip, it lingers on minor moments like McGregor searching for a dropped phone. Still, these scenes help build a tone of quiet domesticity and thoughtful preparation. When the journey finally begins in episode two, the series finds its rhythm. They depart McGregor's house with a marching band and head to Newcastle, then ferry to the Netherlands. From there, they explore Amsterdam, sample local food, and take in regional customs - including fierljeppen, a Dutch pole-vaulting tradition.

As the episodes progress, the charm of Long Way Home lies in the duo's interactions with local cultures, minor mishaps, and moments of levity. They visit Boorman's ancestral hometown in Germany, encounter a festive gun club marching band, and stop by a quirky Danish bar frequented by horses. McGregor, enthusiastic as ever, engages in local traditions and cuisines with genuine curiosity.

strong bond

Still, the show is not without its faults. The two overgrown lads, despite both approaching 60, still prefer to avoid on-screen emotional introspection, and the

show is the poorer for it. While Boorman has said nothing is off-limits, the show misses opportunities to explore themes like aging, fatherhood, or personal loss with greater emotional depth. For instance, on Father's Day, the duo mention missing their kids, but the moment passes without further reflection. A few scenes do offer poignancy - McGregor's musings on nature in Norway, or Boorman recalling his sister's death during a church visit - but such moments are rare.

midlife memory

Nevertheless, the bond between McGregor and Boorman remains strong and appealing. The camaraderie built over 20 years of shared adventures is authentic and easy to watch. While they lack the sharp humor of other travel duos, their rapport is genuine, and there are still entertaining anecdotes, like Boorman being left alone with Kylie Minogue after McGregor's hasty introduction.

Visually, the series

shines. The landscapes become increasingly striking as they approach Scandinavia, with Norway offering particularly captivating vistas. While ten episodes may feel excessive given the slow pacing and relative flatness of some early European terrain, the meditative, slow-TV style has its own appeal - especially for fans invested in the friendship or the motorcycling lifestyle.

There is also some light peril along the way, with the usual mechanical hiccups and occasional bike spills, adding an edge of unpredictability. For motorbike enthusiasts, the use of vintage machines offers added interest, though it also slows the pace and adds to the logistical complexity.

Ultimately, Long Way Home may not dramatically innovate on the Long Way formula, but it embraces a slower, more reflective tone befitting its stars' current life stages. For longtime fans, it's a comforting continuation - a mellow meander through scenic roads, old friendships,

and new experiences. For others, particularly those drawn to emotional storytelling or high adventure, it may feel too gentle or lacking in deeper substance.

Given the vintage of our two protagonists, the show raises the question of whether

this might be their final televised ride. Yet, Boorman hints they always start dreaming of the next journey as soon as one ends. For now, Long Way Home is a pleasant, if leisurely, ride through midlife, memory, and motorcycling.

victory.

When Pape Matar Sarr floated over his cross as the first-half ticked to its conclusion, Johnson got ahead of Shaw to get the first touch.

It wasn't a particularly good touch and looked unlikely to trouble Onana. But once the ball hit Shaw at close quarters, the Manchester United goalkeeper was scrambling. Johnson lunged at the ball a second time. Whether he got there was debatable. But the damage was already done. Onana couldn't keep it out.

Up to that point, Tottenham had not had a shot on target. They were not to have another. It didn't matter a jot.

In his 100th game as Spurs boss, Postecoglou got his second season trophy, just as he did with South Melbourne and Brisbane Roar in Australia, Yokohama F Marinos in Japan and Celtic in Scotland. The first English club to win a European competition had become the latest to do so, beating a English opponent for the second time after overcoming Wolves in the 1972 Uefa Cup final.

Postecoglou also won the Asian Cup two years after becoming Australia boss - and the Scottish championship in both seasons with Celtic.

Palace fans in dreamland after historic FA Cup triumph

■ Eagles upset the odds, beating mighty Manchester City to secure first ever major trophy

Crystal Palace fans celebrated late into the night following the club's historic FA Cup win over Manchester City on Saturday.

The south London side won 1-0, marking the club's first major trophy in its history.

Eberechi Eze's 16th minute goal secured the victory, with scenes of ecstasy breaking out among fans across the capital and beyond when the full-time whistle was blown.

"It's an amazing day," one fan who was at Wembley told reporters. "I've supported Palace for 46 years and I don't know if I ever thought I'd see this.

"Genuinely the best day of my sporting life."

While City dominated possession, Oliver Glasner's side kept the seven-time winners out, with keeper Dean Henderson saving from Erling Haaland, Josko Gvardiol and Jeremy Doku in the first half, then denying Claudio Echeverri after the break.

As the club lifted their first major trophy in their 120-year professional history, there were tears of joy in the stands.

"I absolutely can't believe it. It's incredible, once in a lifetime," a fan

in the crowd said.

"When we got our chance to attack, we made it," added another.

"I can't believe that we just won that - absolutely incredible."

Outside of the stadium, fans following the match on TV and radio went wild as victory was confirmed.

At Croydon's Boxpark, supporters who were watching the game on the big screen launched their drinks into the air when the referee blew the final whistle.

"That was epic. I love this team, I love this town," one supporter, who was from Croydon, said.

"We cried. But hey, I'm 65. If I cry, I cry."

Another added: "Tears that I didn't know I had came out."

"If we never win another match again, I don't care now. I'm so happy," a third said.

"We don't do this, we don't win trophies. This is surreal. Up the Palace," another said.

Yet Palace boss Glasner later said he does not feel he has made a "legacy" at the club yet, despite their victory.

The Austrian has spent the past week playing down his status in the Palace history books.

"It's just two days ago we were winning it and, all of a sudden, a legacy? No, it's a great achievement. But it's still a little bit unreal. It's also enjoying that moment, but on the other side, having a game tomorrow, we're within these feelings," said Glasner.

"I don't know, I don't feel it's a legacy. I'm just part of an amazing group and we achieved everything together, so I don't think that it's a legacy.

"We're all defined by our character - every-

one. The players as well, of course, every one of us has different talents. These people, they have a great talent, they can play football quite well.

"But, we are defined not by what we are doing, we are defined by our character. This is what they are - they are outstanding. I mention it so often and this is

what they showed. The togetherness, always supporting the group, always having the team on the top.

"Everybody puts his ego into the group, into the team, and I think this is what this group is defined by - the great characters of every single player."

Cup glory at last for Spurs

Europa League Final: Ange's boys edge 'El Crapico' to earn £100m Champions League payday

Tottenham ended their 17-year wait for a trophy on Wednesday night as Brennan Johnson's first-half goal was enough to beat Manchester United in the Europa League final.

Victory means under-fire head coach Ange Postecoglou has fulfilled a promise to deliver silverware in his second season at Spurs.

Postecoglou, who said he would "never be a clown" in his pre-match address, brought smiles and unbridled joy to the faces of the 15,000 official, and many unofficial, Tottenham fans in Bilbao's San Mames Stadium.

Victory may not save Postecoglou from a Spurs exit in the coming weeks. But the Australian will leave as a hero after joining Bill Nicholson and Keith Burkinshaw in winning a European trophy with the north London giants.

In addition to following the lead of Newcastle and Crystal Palace in making this a season of glory for clubs who rarely, if ever, win a trophy, Tottenham are also set to benefit from a £100m windfall after qualifying for next season's Champions League.

The prospect of a final

between the two lowest-placed teams ever to contest a European final led to the match being nicknamed 'El Crapico'. And for the losers, there was no silver lining.

Manchester United head coach Ruben Amorim will send his side into the final Premier League game of the season against Aston Villa on Sunday with huge questions over his ability to make them competitive following their worst season since the 1973-74 relegation campaign.

Amorim enjoys the backing of the ownership but his decision to pick Mason Mount ahead of Alejandro Garnacho in an attacking role did not work. And with skipper Bruno Fernandes unusually subdued, United lacked the guile to drag themselves back into the game once they had fallen behind.

They came close to an equaliser with a Rasmus Hojlund header, following Guglielmo Vicario's error, that was acrobatically cleared off the line by Micky van de Ven midway through the second half.

Vicario then made a dramatic late save to keep out Luke Shaw's header.
