Britain 'must be ready' to fight a war'

■ Defence chiefs deliver chilling warning to nation as RAF nuclear capacity is restored

Britain must be ready to fight a war at home as our enemies prepare the ground for future clashes, security chiefs have warned.

The chilling message, in the Government's national security strategy published this week, said: "We are in an era in which we face confrontation with those who are threatening our security."

It pointed to Vladimir Putin's invasion of Ukraine as the most urgent example, but said Russian cyber attacks and sabotage and Iranian "hostile activity" in the UK were also rising.

And it added: "Meanwhile, some adversaries are laying the foundations for future conflict, positioning themselves to move quickly to cause major disruption to our energy and or supply chains, to deter us from standing up to their aggression."

"For the first time in many years, we have to actively prepare for the possibility of the UK homeland coming under direct threat, potentially

in a wartime scenario."

The document was released as Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer arrived in the Netherlands for the two-day NATO summit.

Britain will purchase 12 new fighter jets and join NATO's airborne nuclear mission in what No10 called "the biggest strengthening of the UK's nuclear posture in a generation".

'radical uncertainty'

The F35A jets can carry conventional weapons and also be equipped with nuclear bombs.

Sir Keir said: "In an era of radical uncertainty, we can no longer take peace for granted, which is why my Government is investing in our national security, ensuring our armed forces have the equipment they need and communities up and down the country reap the benefits from

our defence dividend." The move sees the return of the RAF's nuclear capabilities.

The last British air-dropped atomic weapon was withdrawn from service following the end of the Cold War.

Since then, our nuclear deterrent has been carried exclusively by Royal Navy submarines.

Sir Keir added: "Supporting 100 businesses

across the country and more than 20,000 jobs, these F35 dual-capable aircraft will herald a new era for our world-leading Royal Air Force and deter hostile threats that threaten the UK and our allies. The UK's commitment to NATO is unquestionable, as is the alliance's contribution to keeping the UK safe and secure - but we must all step up to protect the Eu-

ro-Atlantic area for generations to come."

Defence Secretary John Healey said it followed the strategic defence review this month, which "confirmed we face new nuclear risks, with other states increasing, modernising and diversifying their nuclear arsenals".

NATO's secretary-general, Mark Rutte, called the an-

nouncement "yet another robust British contribution" to the alliance. NATO's nuclear mission involves allied aircraft being equipped with American B61 bombs stockpiled in Europe. Seven nations - Belgium, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands, the United States, Turkey and Greece - are currently contributing. The use of

Sword rampage man found guilty of murder

■ Amazon driver launched series of attacks while suffering from cannabis-induced psychosis, court told

A sword attacker has been found guilty of murder after virtually decapitating a schoolboy during a rampage he compared to scenes from film *The Hunger Games*.

Marcus Arduini Monzo, 37, had gone into a cannabis-induced psychosis when he killed 14-year-old Daniel Anjorin with a samurai sword, the Old Bailey heard.

Witnesses described the former Amazon delivery driver screaming "in delight" after lethally wounding Daniel, who had been walking to school in his PE kit. Five more people were injured during the rampage.

Prosecutor Tom Little KC told jurors it was "miraculous" that more people weren't killed as Monzo slashed and chopped at whoever he came across for 20 minutes.

He had killed and skinned his pet cat Wizard before running riot in Hainault, North East London, on April 30 last year.

As well as killing Daniel, Monzo also attacked a pedestrian, two police officers and a couple in their own home before he was

arrested.

Afterwards, he likened his actions to the Hollywood film *The Hunger Games* and claimed to have an alternative persona of a "professional assassin".

Giving evidence at his trial, he said he had no memory of what happened and claimed his mental state had diminished his responsibility for the crimes. However, the prosecution argued that psychosis brought on by self-induced intoxication was no defence for murder.

Even though Monzo admitted he had drunk a hallucinogenic tea called ayahuasca, no trace of DMT – the class-A drug in the brew – was detected in his system.

The jury found Monzo guilty of Daniel's murder, three charges of attempted murder, aggravated burglary and possession of a bladed article relating to a kitchen knife.

He was cleared of one count of attempted murder in relation to victim Henry De Los Rios Polania, but found guilty of the lesser offence of

wounding with intent to cause grievous bodily harm.

Monzo, who showed no emotion as the verdicts were read out, previously admitted having the samurai sword used to kill Daniel and a katana sword, found in his van. Daniel's parents had sat in court throughout the trial when harrowing CCTV and police body-worn camera footage had been played.

The jury heard how Monzo launched the series of attacks by driving his van into Donato Iwule, who was "catapulted" into a nearby garden. He went on to hit Mr Iwule in the neck with his sword before running away, the court was told.

He then virtually decapitated Daniel, who was wearing headphones, jurors heard. Witness Maria Olmos said Monzo dropped to his knees and held his hands up after mortally wounding the schoolboy.

She said: "He let out an extremely loud scream. It wasn't a scream of pain, it was a scream of delight. My interpretation was he

was celebrating."

PC Yasmin Mechem-Whitfield was hit three times with the 24in-long blade with "extreme force" as she chased Monzo.

Next, he entered a property and attacked a couple, including Mr De Los Rios Polania, who were sleeping in an upstairs bedroom with their young daughter nearby.

Inspector Molloy Campbell tried to detain Monzo in a car park and received a slash wound to his hand.

Monzo was sentenced on Friday after press time.

Starmer facing tough battle with party rebels over welfare reform

KIER STARMER is facing one of the most significant internal challenges to his leadership since taking office, as he faces an escalating rebellion within Labour Party over his controversial welfare reform legislation.

The proposed bill, aimed at tightening eligibility for Personal Independence Payment (PIP) and certain Universal Credit entitlements, has not only stirred political opposition across party lines but also sparked a serious internal crisis that threatens Starmer's grip on the parliamentary party.

The Welfare Reform Bill, introduced in Parliament last week, seeks to overhaul the criteria used to assess disability benefit eligibility. The government argues that the reforms are a necessary response to rising welfare costs and aim to shift the system's focus from long-term support to active rehabilitation and employment. Under the proposal, individuals with certain "non-physical" conditions - such as depression or anxiety -

may face stricter criteria to qualify for state support.

Chancellor Rachel Reeves and Welfare Secretary Alison McGovern have both described the bill as part of Labour's broader economic plan to "deliver growth and fiscal responsibility." However, the social and ethical implications of the bill have sparked discontent among a broad swathe of Labour backbenchers.

Revolt

More than 120 Labour MPs - over one-third of the parliamentary party - have expressed deep concerns over the bill, with many signing an amendment calling for a delay and a review of the proposed eligibility changes. Backbenchers argue that the measures could lead to tens of thousands of disabled individuals being stripped of vital financial support, particularly those with mental health conditions. The rebellion has been spearheaded by a coalition of left-leaning MPs, disability rights advocates,

and even some centrist figures who believe the bill was rushed through without adequate consultation.

Veteran MP Jess Phillips described the proposed cuts as "a betrayal of Labour values," while newly elected MP Amina Ahmed, representing a key Midlands swing seat, warned that her constituents were "terrified" of losing vital support.

Under Fire

While Starmer has publicly downplayed the dissent - referring to it as "noises off" - the scale of the backlash has stunned senior aides. According to sources close to Downing Street, Starmer initially believed the party would fall in line, given Labour's large majority and strong message discipline during the general election. That calculation now appears flawed.

But it is now clear that Starmer's chief of staff Morgan McSweeney has severely underestimated the level of opposition. Aides reportedly failed

to hold preliminary consultations with key parliamentary groups, leading to a breakdown in communication between the leadership and the wider parliamentary party.

Senior Labour figures are increasingly voicing concerns that Starmer's top-down approach is alienating MPs and activists alike. "There's a difference between discipline and deafness," one former shadow minister noted.

Dilemma

Faced with growing unrest, Starmer is now walking a political tight-rope. On the one hand, the welfare bill is seen as a linchpin in his effort to establish Labour's economic credibility and appeal to middle-class voters concerned with benefit fraud and fiscal discipline. On the other, the rebellion threatens to fracture party unity and erode Labour's electoral base among progressive voters and those with lived experience of the welfare system.

In response, Starmer has reportedly authorized a series of quiet concessions behind the scenes. These may include delaying some of the more controversial assessment criteria, extending transitional protections for existing claimants, and adding provisions to strengthen employment support services. However, whether these concessions will be enough to stave off a full-scale revolt remains unclear.

Starmer now faces an unenviable choice: dig in and risk alienating his base, or soften the bill and risk losing his economic reform narrative. In either case, this rebellion marks a pivotal test of his leadership - both in terms of policy and political management.

Harry 'full of regrets' claims royal biographer

■ As rift continues to widen, exiled Prince 'wishes he'd done things differently'

The rift between Prince Harry and the rest of the royal family has once again made headlines this week, amid fresh claims that the Duke of Sussex is privately consumed by regret over his role in the widening gulf between himself and his relatives.

According to royal author Duncan Larcombe, Harry now wishes he had acted differently during the tumultuous period that saw him and his wife, Meghan Markle, exit royal life and start anew in the United States.

Speaking to *OK! Magazine*, Larcombe claimed: "Harry is a sensitive soul and always wore his heart on his sleeve, so whether he'd admit it publicly or not, I'm sure he's full of regrets and wishes he'd done things differently."

The Duke, who turns 41 later this year, has remained largely estranged from his father, King Charles III, and his brother,

the Prince of Wales, since his departure from royal duties in early 2020. The Sussexes, who now reside in the affluent enclave of Montecito, California, have made only sporadic visits to Britain in the years since, underscoring the emotional and geographical distance that now separates them from the rest of the royal family.

Larcombe, author of *Prince Harry: The Inside Story*, suggested that the recent convergence of Trooping the Colour and Father's Day would have stirred poignant memories for Harry. "It was bound to make him look back at the happy relationships he once had with his brother and dad, and I'm sure he'd love to be able to rebuild those," he said.

Yet such reconciliation may remain elusive. A significant stumbling block remains Harry's security concerns. Since relinquishing royal status,

the duke has lost access to publicly funded protection while in the UK. Earlier this year, he lost a legal battle to have this reinstated. In a statement following the court's decision, Harry said he "couldn't see a world" in which he and Meghan would bring their children—Prince Archie, 6, and Princess Lilibet, 4—

back to Britain under the current conditions. Larcombe believes the ruling has only cemented the Sussexes' estrangement. "By saying he can't bring them here because of the court ruling, Harry has nailed his colours to the mast," he told *OK!*. "Meghan is probably quite reluctant to come to the UK anyway be-

cause they'd have to be deaf, dumb and blind not to realise just how much criticism they've had for their betrayals and truth bombs."

Whether this latest introspection marks the beginning of reconciliation or simply another chapter in a saga that shows little sign of resolution remains to be seen.

'Scottish tea' grifter bags a hefty helping of porridge

■ Conman brewed up six figure profits from 'genetically modified' leaves

A Scottish conman has been sent to prison for three-and-a-half years after he scammed buyers in including Fortnum & Mason in a £550,000 fraudulent tea-growing scheme.

Thomas Robinson falsely claimed that he grew thousands of tea plants - many of which later died - on a Perthshire farm in an act of deceit which allowed him to sell them at a high price to prestigious buyers due to their "Scottish-grown" label.

But the plants were actually sourced from Europe for cheap before being sold on at a significant mark-up to unsuspecting customers.

Robinson - who also went by Thomas O'Brien or 'Tam O'Braan' - made £550,000 from the scam

over a five-year period.

The Dorchester Hotel in London and the Balmoral Hotel in Edinburgh were among the high-profile clients defrauded by Robinson via his Wee Tea Plantation business, and the conman even claimed he sold tea to Kensington Palace.

'sleepless nights'

The 55-year-old was said to have the "CV of a fantasist", which included faking academic qualifications and agricultural expertise to back up his claims to have developed new genetic splicing techniques for growing tea in the Scottish climate.

Robinson was sentenced to three-and-a-half years in prison at Stirling Sheriff Court

on Wednesday. A jury previously found him guilty of two counts of fraud following a three-week trial at Falkirk Sheriff Court.

He was ultimately brought to trial following a "highly complex and protracted investigation" by Food Standards Scotland, after Perth and Kinross Council checked whether the fraudster had a food processing licence in 2017.

Robinson's sentencing was delayed after his lawyer withdrew from the case on Wednesday and Robinson instead represented himself. Appearing via videolink from HMP Low Moss, Robinson asked for the court to show "compassion".

A bid to defer sen-

tence was rejected by the court.

Robinson told the court he had "sleepless nights" over his crimes and had come to realise "how wrong and stupid" he had been.

He admitted he had been responsible for the reputational damage of tea growing in Scotland. The convictions were

described as "significant", requiring "significant planning", by Sheriff Keith O'Mahony.

Ron McNaughton, head of the Scottish Food Crime and Incidents Unit, welcomed the sentencing as a "clear signal that food fraud is a serious crime with serious consequences".

58 years later, DNA leads to arrest of 92-year-old rapist

A STAINED SKIRT from 1967 has provided vital DNA evidence leading to the arrest of a 92-year-old convicted rapist for the murder of a pensioner.

The skirt was shown to the jury in the trial of Ryland Headley, over the murder of Louisa Dunne, 75 this week.

The victim was wearing the skirt when an intruder broke into her house in Bristol in June 1967 before raping and strangling her.

Her body was found by neighbours but in the decades that followed no one was brought to justice over her death, Bristol Crown Court heard.

oldest cold case

The defendant was jailed for the rape of two elderly women in 1977.

Mrs Dunne's skirt, along with other items from the scene, were kept in storage and were recently re-examined.

Jurors have now been told there is "extremely strong" scientific evidence to suggest semen samples found on the skirt in Britain's oldest cold case review came from her alleged murderer.

A forensic scientist told the court that recent direct DNA matches linking samples from Mrs Dunne's pubic hair and the skirt suggested they were "one billion

times" more likely to have come from Headley than from anyone else.

'one in a billion'

Andrew Parry had worked on head hair samples from the victim, as well as the skirt and the scarf she was wearing when she died.

He told the trial: "The chance of observing this matching profile is normally in the order of one in one billion. That's the stat we use for a direct match." Mr Parry explained he cut sections from the front and back of Mrs Dunne's skirt. He said: "In the area from the back, I found numerous semen cells in the sample," with what he called the "highest level" of cells on the scale used to measure them.

He said the DNA found matched Headley's taken via a mouth swab, saying: "I subjected the semen component to DNA profiling tests and obtained a full DNA profile.

"We had two profiles, one from the skirt and one from the cheek swab.

"It's estimated as one billion times more likely that they originated from Mr Headley than from an unknown, unrelated person."

Headley, of Ipswich, denies raping and murdering Ms Dunne in June 1967.

The trial continues.

■ Beamer, Playpiece and Shugly among the new entries in Oxford English Dictionary

The Oxford English Dictionary is 'hoaching' with new Scottish words - with beamer, bummer and tattie scone among 13 new entries.

There is also a listing for Scotland's shoogly subway trains - not the kind of place where passengers would want to risk using skooshy cream.

Many of the new additions have a food theme, with Lorne sausage, morning rolls and playpiece also making the grade.

Oxford English Dictionary (OED) editors say they will consider a new word for inclusion when they have gathered enough independent examples of its usage "from a good variety of sources".

They said there also has to be evidence that a word has been in use for a "reasonable amount of time".

Some of the words date back to the 1700s and already feature in Scots language dictionaries.

They are among nearly 600 new words and phrases adopted into the OED.

Here's a selection of the best from north of the border:

Aye, right - A sarcastic phrase - used ironically to express contempt or incredulity. Similar to "yeah, right".

Beamer - A term for a flushed or blushing face, especially one resulting from embarrassment. Extended to mean a humiliating or shameful situation.

Bummer - A person in a position of authority. Normally used in the expression "heid (head) bummer". It sometimes has a humorous suggestion of pomposity or officiousness.

Chum - To join some-

one as a companion, as in "I'll chum you along".

Tate go on trial sooner after hearing date moved up by 'very keen' judge

The civil case against Andrew Tate will take place months earlier than planned after a High Court judge said she was "very keen to get on" with the case.

A 16-day trial had been listed to start on 22 February 2027, but

the case has now been moved forward to 22 June next year.

Four women are suing Tate over allegations of sexual violence, including that he grabbed one of the women by the throat on several occasions in 2015, pointed a

gun in her face and assaulted her with a belt.

The controversial social media influencer has previously denied the claims in a written defence submitted to the High Court, calling them a "pack of lies" and "gross fabrications".

■ Ten hour radio broadcast prepared to mark 40th anniversary of charity gig

The 1985 Live Aid broadcast that featured legendary performances from Queen, David Bowie, the Who and Paul McCartney will be recreated on a British radio station to celebrate the event's 40th anniversary.

Greatest Hits Radio, a leading UK-based oldies station will air the 10-hour show on 13 July. It will be available worldwide through internet-based radio streaming apps.

The 10-hour special, hosted by veteran British DJ Simon Mayo, will air from noon on 13 July featuring all of the original live performances from the concert, which took place at Wembley Stadium in London to raise money for the Ethiopian famine.

Performances will be accompanied by commentary from Martin Kemp, who performed at the event with Spandau Bal-

let, plus the cast of the new Live Aid musical Just For One Day.

The show will include Queen's acclaimed 21-minute live performance, which has been hailed one of the greatest of all time, thanks to Freddie Mercury's charismatic stage presence and the band's ability to connect with the audience in sing-alongs.

It will also replay David Bowie's memorable set, including an emotional performance of Heroes, which he dedicated to the children of the world.

The event raised more than £114m for famine relief and brought the world's attention to Ethiopia's devastating food shortages.

However, it has been criticized for perpetuating the idea that Africa is a broken continent that needs to be "saved" by people from

other countries, which has informed subsequent international development approaches. There have also been allegations around where some of the money ended up.

Greatest Hits Radio is partnering with the Band Aid Charitable Trust for the broadcast, named Live Aid Relived.

The Band Aid trust co-founder Bob Geldof said: "Thank you Greatest Hits Radio for hopefully letting people know that they are not powerless in the face of human monstrosity. What better time than now to know and understand the power of music and what it can achieve."

Mayo said: "I was there as a paying customer 40 years ago and I can't wait to relive that extraordinary day. Apart from finding a place to park in Wembley, of course."

Mish eventually made his own way back to the enclosure and Lucy was lured back with a bell and her favourite foods.

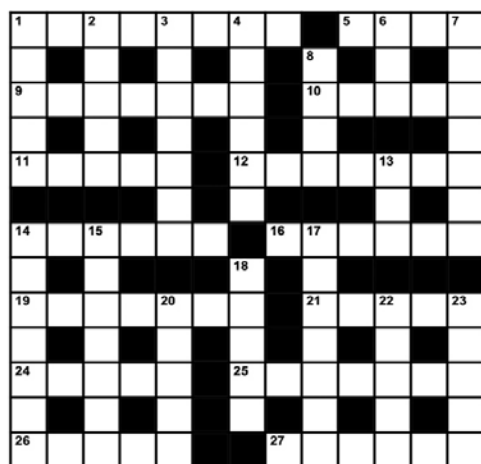

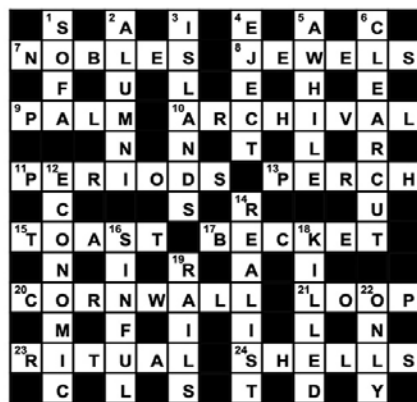

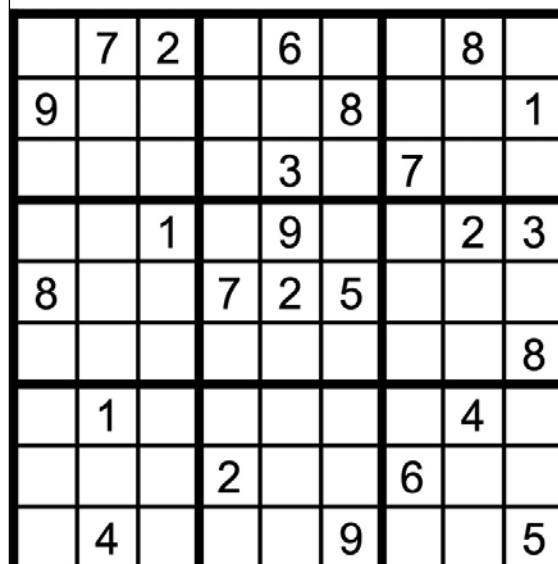

New women's football film is shooting for success

■ Award-winning *Back of the Net* about to kick off in Los Angeles

Kerkez seals Reds switch

Liverpool have taken their summer spending to about £170m with the signing of left-back Milos Kerkez from Bournemouth in a deal worth £40m.

The 21-year-old Hungarian international has signed a five-year contract with the Reds.

Kerkez is Liverpool's third major signing of the transfer window, following the arrival of attacking midfielder Florian Wirtz and right-back Jeremie Frimpong, both from Bayer Leverkusen.

Liverpool paid a club record £116m, made up of an initial £100m and a further £16m in poten-

tial add-ons, for German international Wirtz and £29.5m for Dutchman Frimpong. Hungary Under-21 keeper Armin Pecsi has also arrived at Anfield for a fee of up to £1.5m.

"It's a real honour for me, a privilege to come to play for one of the biggest clubs in the world, [the] biggest club in England. I'm just really, really happy and excited," said Kerkez.

"After this, I'll go home and in my hometown enjoy a few days, and then I can't really wait to come back and put the training kit on and start to train and prepare for the sea-

son."

Liverpool will also sign Georgia goalkeeper Giorgi Mamardashvili this summer, having agreed a deal to sign him from Valencia for a fee of £25m plus £4m in add-ons last summer.

It is a major step in the career of the left-back, but Kerkez has played for a European 'super club' before.

In early 2021 he received a phone call from AC Milan legend Paolo Maldini, who convinced him to join the Serie A side.

As the 17-year-old Kerkez said at the time, you don't turn down Mal-

dini.

With hindsight, he possibly wishes he had.

The Hungarian never started a competitive match for Milan and a year later was shipped

off to AZ Alkmaar in the Dutch Eredivisie.

Bournemouth saw potential in the market and took a chance on Kerkez by signing him for an undisclosed fee in July 2023.

The gamble paid off.

Kerkez started all 38 of the Cherries' Premier League games in the 2024-25 season, helping them to a club-record total of 56 points in the top flight.

Murray statue set for Wimbledon

Sir Andy Murray says he feels "very proud" after the All England Club confirmed it will recognise his contribution to tennis with a statue of him at Wimbledon.

Murray ended Britain's 77-year wait for a men's singles champion at Wimbledon with a memorable victory over Novak Djokovic in 2013, and triumphed again at SW19 in 2016 when he beat Milos Raonic.

Former Wimbledon chief executive Richard Lewis announced at the time that the club would honour Murray with a statue when he finished playing.

The Scot retired from

professional tennis in August 2024 following an appearance at the Olympic Games in Paris.

Debbie Jevans, chair of the All England Club, said it is now in discussions with 38-year-old Murray to make good on the promise and hoped to have the statue in place by 2027.

"We are looking to have a statue of Andy Murray here [at Wimbledon] and we're working closely with him and his team," Jevans said.

"The ambition is that we would unveil that at the 150th anniversary of our first championship, which was 1877. He's got to rightly be very involved in that and he

and his team will be."

A bronze statue of Fred Perry, the last British men's champion before Murray, was erected at Wimbledon in 1984 to mark the 50th anniversary of his first singles championship.

Murray said of the news: "I would expect that with Wimbledon and their attention to detail that it will be great.

"I'm very proud, there's not many statues around the grounds there, and I always remember seeing the Fred Perry statue when I've walked around the grounds and gone to train and practise there over the years. It will be very special."

Garnacho shirt stunt angers Amorim

Manchester United winger Alejandro Garnacho was in the news for all the wrong reasons this week after posing in a Marcus Rashford Aston Villa shirt on holiday.

The Argentine posted a picture on his social media on Sunday night of himself wearing Villa's claret and blue home kit with 'Rashford 9' on the back.

Rashford, who has two years to run on his United deal, commented: "My brother" on Garnacho's post and accompanied it with a love heart emoji.

The England international joined Villa on a six-month loan deal in January after being fro-

zen out at Old Trafford by manager Ruben Amorim.

But while one source at United claimed the provocative post was just showing Garnacho's support for his former team mate, many United fans were up in arms about it.

And manager Ruben Amorim is reportedly even more determined to offload the 20-year-old, after telling him in May to find a new club.

The winger angered Amorim with his comments in the aftermath of United's 1-0 Europa League final defeat to Tottenham, which he started on the bench.

Speaking after the match, the attacker said: "Up until the final I

played every round helping the team, and today I play 20 minutes, I don't know.

"The final will influence [my decision] but the whole season, the situation of the club. I'm going to try to enjoy the summer and see what happens afterwards."

The club had initially sought £60m for the young star, but a more realistic fee for United to accept would be around £40m, which would count as pure profit against the backdrop of profit and sustainability rules, given his status as an academy graduate, having joined the club's youth system from Atletico Madrid in 2020 as a 15-year-old.

FIRST TEST: England batsman's mighty knock delivers thrilling victory in another Headingley classic

ENGLAND got their Test summer off to the best possible start in another Headingley classic this week, as Ben Duckett's astonishing 149 led them to a target of 371 - one of the all-time great run chases - to beat India on a nerve-shredding final day of the first Test.

Duckett played one of the finest innings by an England batter as the home side pulled off their second-highest successful pursuit, beaten only by the 378 to defeat the same opponents at Edgbaston three years ago.

In doing so, Duckett added his to the list of names etched into Headingley folklore: Ian Botham in 1981, Mark Butcher in 2001, Shai Hope in 2017 and, perhaps most famously, Ben Stokes in 2019.

Duckett shared 188 for the first wicket with Zak Crawley, who made a measured 65. Crawley was dropped on 42 and Duckett on 97.

While Duckett was at the crease, England were strolling, but the opener and Harry Brook were

Stokes joined Joe Root in England's fight against the surging Indians and threatening clouds. Another 49 precious runs were added until Stokes' fortune against left-arm spinner Ravindra Jadeja ended with a reverse-sweep to short third man.

Jamie Smith arrived with 69 required and possessed the composure the situation demanded. Runs ticked down, anticipation grew.

The second new ball became available when

only 22 were needed - too late. England completed a five-wicket victory with 14 overs of the match remaining after scoring at a rate of 4.55.

Root was unbeaten on 53, Smith 44. The teams have a precious few days to regroup before the second Test begins at Edgbaston on 2 July.

Yorkshire cricket have plenty of glorious memories to savor, but this will surely one of the best, a Test that fizzed and fluctuated deep into the final day.

England were 21-0 overnight, 350 runs adrift. All four results were possible. Supporters of both sides traded chants, rode the emotions and suffered the tension. Somehow, the rain only intervened on two occasions.

By the end, England had pulled off another of the run chases that have become their trademark under Stokes, vindicating the captain's decision to field first despite perfect first-day batting conditions.

They completed the second-highest chase

on this ground, bettered only by the 404 of Donald Bradman's Australia in 1948. This was a larger pursuit than Stokes' Ashes heroics of six years ago and the 10th-highest

successful fourth innings chase ever.

It was also an incredible escape for the home side after India reached 430-3 in their first innings and 333-4 in their second.

India made a total of 835 runs in the match - only three other teams have made more in a Test and gone on to lose, and two of those were also beaten by Stokes' England.

Elliott double fires England U-21s into another final

England Under-21s are one match away from winning back-to-back Euros after Harvey Elliott's brilliant double on Wednesday night sent them into the final.

The defending champions set up a showdown against Germany on Saturday in Bratislava by overcoming the Netherlands.

England won the tournament for the first time in 39 years in 2023, and Lee Carsley's side could

now match the feat of successive triumphs in 1982 and 1984.

Elliott was twice denied by Dutch goalkeeper Robin Roefs in the first half, but the Young Lions struggled to maintain their tempo in the blistering heat of Slovakia.

They remained comfortable during a low-key opening period, but the Netherlands grew in confidence, with left-back Ian Maatsen denied by James Beadle before Elliott's

62nd-minute opener.

The Liverpool attacker rifled in right-footed for his third goal of the tournament after being slipped in by Elliot Anderson's pass.

Noah Ohio levelled 10 minutes later for the Dutch, capitalising on defender Charlie Cresswell's error and catching Beadle out with a superb curling low finish from 30 yards - the former Hull City loanee's first touch **cont. on page 19, col. 1**
