## ■ Damp display from Chancellor as Starmer forced into another damaging U-turn

**SIR KEIR STARMER** was left struggling to contain a growing crisis in his administration this week after yet another policy setback left Chancellor Rachel Reeves in tears at Prime Minister's Questions (PMQ).

The PM's huge parliamentary majority has looked alarmingly fragile in recent weeks, as he was forced into an embarrassing climb-down just last month on winter fuel payments for pensioners.

This week brought further embarrassment as Reeves was forced to amend her landmark welfare reform bill amid a party-wide revolt, with many accusing her of betraying the party's core values of helping the weakest and poorest in society.

It all culminated in a harrowing PMQ's on Wednesday with the Opposition Conservatives ruthlessly attacking both Reeves and Starmer, with Tory leader Kemi Badenoch declaring gleefully that "Reeves is toast and we all know it".

Rachel Reeves later told reporters she had had "a tough day" and had been "clearly upset", but blamed her tears on a 'personal matter'.

The chancellor was speaking after making

a surprise appearance alongside Sir Keir Starmer to unveil the government's 10-year plan for the NHS on Thursday.

But the markets delivered their own verdict, with Government borrowing costs rising following Reeves' watery performance, when Sir Keir initially failed to guarantee that the chancellor would keep her job.

### 'tough days'

The fall was partially reversed just 24 hours later, when Sir Keir insisted he was "in lockstep" with his chancellor, who he said would be in her job "for a very long time to come".

As she addressed staff at an NHS facility in London's East End, Reeves was smiling broadly and later shared a hug with the prime minister.

Speaking to broadcasters after the event, Reeves was asked about her tears in Parliament. She said: "My job as chancellor at 12 o'clock on a Wednesday is to be at PMQs next to the prime minister, sup-

porting the government and that's what I tried to do."

"I think all your viewers have had tough days, for personal reasons, for whatever reasons. I happened to be on the camera when I had a tough day."

She said she was "totally" up for the job of chancellor and asked if she was surprised the prime minister had not unequivocally backed her in Parliament replied: "People can see that Keir and me are a team."

"We fought the election together, we changed the Labour Party together so that we could be in the position to return to power and over the past year we've worked in lockstep together."

### 'fiscal discipline'

During the event, Sir Keir praised his chancellor telling the audience: "I think it's just fantastic that she is here."

He said decisions made by Reeves had allowed the government to "invest record

amounts in the NHS".

Asked if he had been aware that his chancellor had been crying next to him in the House of Commons, Sir Keir said he "hadn't appreciated what was happening" as he was "literally up and down" answering questions.

"No prime minister ever has had side conversations in PMQs. It does happen in other debates when there is a bit more time, but in PMQs it is bang, bang, bang, bang."

"I was probably the last to appreciate anything else going on in the chamber."

He said the incident

was due to "a personal issue and I am certainly not going to say anything more about that".

Speculation about Reeves' future had been growing after Labour rebels forced the government to give up some of its benefits changes and in so doing put a £5bn hole in the chancellor's spending plans.

In order to meet her self-imposed borrowing rules, she is now likely to have to consider cutting public spending or raising taxes at the Budget in autumn.

Asked if taxes would be going up, Reeves said she would not "speculate" but added: "Of

course there is a cost to the welfare changes that Parliament voted through this week and that will be reflected in the Budget."

In a sign that she would not be changing her own restrictions on borrowing, the chancellor said "stability that we've been able to return to the economy... is only possible because of the fiscal discipline which is underpinned by the fiscal rules".

Reeves's two main rules are not to borrow to fund day-to-day public spending; and to get debt falling as a share of the UK economic output by 2029/30.

# Three ex-bosses of Lucy Letby arrested on suspicion of gross negligence manslaughter

Three former senior staff at the hospital where nurse Lucy Letby murdered seven babies and attempted to kill seven others have been arrested on suspicion of gross negligence manslaughter.

They worked on the senior leadership team at the Countess of Chester Hospital between 2015 and 2016 and were bailed after being questioned on Monday.

The arrests came after an investigation into potential corporate manslaughter at the hospital was opened in 2023, and then widened in March this year to include gross negligence manslaughter.

Letby, 35, from Hereford, is serving 15 whole life prison sentences after targeting babies at the hospital's neonatal unit between June 2015 and June 2016.

She was convicted of making two attempts to kill one of the babies.

Cheshire Police said the arrests "did not impact on the convictions of Lucy Letby for multiple offences of murder and attempted murder".

Det Supt Paul Hughes said the corporate man-

slaughter element of the investigation focused on the senior leadership of the hospital and its decision-making, "to determine whether any criminality has taken place concerning the response to the increased levels of fatalities".

## Unlimited fine

He said gross negligence manslaughter was a separate offence and "focuses on the grossly negligent action or inaction of individuals".

Corporate manslaughter can carry an unlimited fine for an organisation but no jail sentence for any individual, whereas gross negligence manslaughter can result in a life sentence for a person convicted of it.

The three people arrested have not been named by police, in line with normal police procedure.

Cheshire Police said it was also carrying out a separate investigation into deaths and non-fatal collapses of babies in Chester and in the Liverpool Women's Hospital, where Letby trained for periods, going back to 2012.

Det Supt Hughes said there were "no set timescales" for the manslaughter investigations.

Letby has maintained her innocence and her barrister, Mark McDonald, submitted an application to the Criminal Cases Review Commission (CCRC) earlier this year.

The application included the findings of 14 medical experts who agreed to re-examine the evidence heard at trial and concluded Letby had not harmed any babies.

## 'very sensitive'

The CCRC, which has the power to refer cases back to the Court of Appeal, said it was reviewing the application and could give no timescale on when a decision would be reached.

Mr McDonald said the news of the arrests had come at a "very sensitive" time in his client's case.

"Despite this the concerns many have raised will not go away, and we will continue to publicly discuss them," he said.

He added that "internationally renowned experts" had concluded that no babies were mur-

dered and called for a new public inquiry.

Last month former Health Secretary Jeremy Hunt called for an "urgent re-examination" of Letby's case due to what he called "serious and credible" questions raised by the expert panel.

His Conservative Party colleague, Sir Da-

vid Davis, has also been supportive of attempts to have Letby's case looked at again.

But lawyers for the families of Letby's victims described the expert panel's conclusions as "full of analytical holes" and "a rehash" of the defence case.

A public inquiry into

the circumstances around Letby's offending is also due to publish its findings in early 2026.

The Thirwall Inquiry heard evidence from the senior leadership team at the hospital about when concerns were raised about a rise in the deaths of babies on the neonatal unit.

## Glasto live feed serves up new Israel controversy for embattled Beeb

THE BBC found itself at the center of another controversy this week, after its live feed of the Glastonbury music festival featured an act advocating violence against

the Israeli Defence Forces.

The row erupted on Saturday after the English punk duo Bob Vylan led crowds at the West Holts Stage in a chant of "death,

death to the IDF" and "Free Palestine".

The corporation chose not to pull the feed, leading to a wave of condemnation from across the **cont. on page 3, col. 1**

political spectrum.

The live performance sparked accusations from the Israeli Embassy that Glastonbury had become a platform for demanding “the elimination of Jewish self-determination” and the “glorification of violence”.

And Tory Shadow Foreign Secretary Dame Priti Patel condemned them for allowing “hate-fuelled content” that risks “legitimising and normalising those views in society”.

Dame Priti added: “No taxpayer-funded broadcaster should give a national platform to incitement, and yet the BBC let this happen. That decision has consequences.

“Where is the professionalism and editorial integrity at the BBC?

“Platforming performers who glorify terrorism and encourage violence against the democratic rule of law has shown that their integrity has clearly gone.

The Labour Party was equally critical, with Health Secretary Wes Streeting branding the scenes “appalling” and agreed that both the broadcaster and the festival “have got questions to answer about how we saw such a spectacle on our screens”.

Mike Tapp, the Labour MP for Dover and Deal, said: “I couldn’t help but feel what I was watching was more of a hate festival than a celebration of music and culture.”

Reform UK deputy leader Richard Tice condemned the festival as a “cauldron of vile antisemitic racism this year”.

Actress and antisemitism activist Tracy-Ann Oberman said: “I thought music festivals were predominantly about the catharsis of love, peace and sharing

humanity through music, not calls for death and hatred.”

Former TV producer Roger Bolton said the broadcaster should have “cut away and cancelled the broadcast” when the duo launched into their offensive chants. He added: “It’s something the BBC should not have allowed to have happened.”

Andrew Gilbert, vice president of the Board of Deputies of British Jews, said: “Countless music fans and BBC viewers will have shared the shock and outrage of British Jews at seeing chants for death being led from the Glastonbury stage. The Board of Deputies has responded swiftly by engaging directly with Government, senior figures at the BBC and the police.

“As for Glastonbury Festival, its professed commitment to peace, unity, respect and hope rings hollow when its stage is used to promote chants calling for death.”

Caroline Turner, of UK Lawyers for Israel, said: “The band was able to lead a gullible audience into a chant, demonstrating how easily a crowd can be led, just as crowds were led to follow death chants to Jews in Nazi Germany.”

A Glastonbury insider said the BBC may have “dropped the ball” by focusing on controversial Irish hip hop trio Kneecap, rather than properly vetting other performers.

Kneecap’s Liam O’Hanna was released on unconditional bail after appearing in a London court on a terror charge earlier this month, having been accused of displaying a flag in support of Hezbollah at a gig.

The following day the BBC issued a formal apology for allowing the “high risk” act to perform live.

## Veteran reporter Sandy Gall dead at 97

■ From Suez to Afghanistan, from Idi Amin to Osama bin Laden, the unflappable journalist was a fixture on British TV for more than 50 years

**Sandy Gall, the veteran foreign correspondent and newscaster, has died aged 97.**

A familiar face to several generations of British TV viewers, Gall reported from many of the world’s trouble spots during a 60-year career, first with the Reuters news agency and then with ITN. He was on the ground at Suez in 1956, covered wars in the Middle East and Vietnam, and was jailed by Idi Amin, the Ugandan tyrant. If he had the air of a man who had seen conflict and lived to tell the tale, there was a good reason for it.

When assigned with others to present News at Ten, he did not give up his roving career, but disappeared periodically to report and make documentaries from Afghanistan and elsewhere.

### Reuters trainee

Alexander Gall, always known as Sandy, was born in Penang, in British Malaya (now Malaysia), the son of Henderson Gall, manager of a rubber plantation, and his wife, Jean. The family moved back to Scotland when Sandy was four, and from the age of six he was sent to boarding school. He was educated at Trinity college, Glenalmond in Perthshire, and studied French and German at Aberdeen.

After university, Gall secured a job as a trainee at Reuters and was soon sent to Kenya to cover the end of the Mau Mau rebellion against British colonial rule and was then moved on to report on the 1956 Suez invasion. Postings to Berlin and Budapest followed during the height of the cold war and the aftermath of the Hungarian uprising. Tours of duty



Afghanistan remained a particular fascination for Sandy Gall, and he visited the country dozens of times both before and after the 9/11 attacks

to the Congo followed in 1960 to cover the civil war that followed independence from Belgium.

In 1963, he joined ITN as a foreign correspondent, covering the aftermath of the assassination of President John F Kennedy, the six-day and Yom Kippur wars between Israel and its Arab neighbours and the deepening morass of the Vietnam war thereafter.

### execution cells

In both the Congo and later Uganda, Gall found himself arrested by troops and placed in execution cells with other journalists before being rescued – in the first case by the UN, and in the second, by Amin’s change of heart.

In Saigon, in May 1975, as the city fell, departing British consular staff held Gall in such high esteem that they entrusted him with the keys of the embassy club so that he and other correspondents could continue to use the swimming pool and bar. In the following month he and ITN’s camera crew shot eight

hours of film following the Vietcong occupation of the city before they could be evacuated, only to find, when they got back to London, that the company’s technicians were on strike. Just 10 minutes of the film was broadcast when ITN returned to air some days later.

### Obsession

Gall was one of News at Ten’s early newscasters – giving bulletins a sense of gravitas – alongside Alastair Burnet and Reginald Bosanquet. His foreign assignments continued long after his retirement from ITN at the age of 65 in 1992, following the first Gulf war.

Afghanistan became something of an obsession. He had first visited the country in 1982, trekking on foot for 12 days through the mountains in order to meet and interview the guerrilla leader Ahmad Shah Massoud, who was leading the fight against the Soviet invading army. He returned many times over the following 30

years, during the Soviet occupation and after the Anglo-American invasion of 2001.

A series of books and documentaries culminated in 2012 in his book War Against the Taliban: Why It All Went Wrong in Afghanistan, which blamed Pakistan for assisting and shielding the insurgents by giving them sanctuary.

### ‘like Scotland’

“I originally went there with a romantic idea of this small country fighting a vast empire, a kind of David versus Goliath,” he told the Yorkshire Post in 2012. But he became captivated by the beauty of the country and the friendliness of many of its people. “Afghanistan is very much like Scotland – mountainous, beautiful and the people are hospitable. But unlike Scotland there’s no whisky,” he said.

Gall married Eleanor Smyth in 1958. She died in 2018. He is survived by a son, Alexander, and three daughters, Carlotta, Fiona and Michaela.

**92-year-old jailed for rape**

A MAN of 92 was this week found guilty of the rape and murder of an elderly widow in what is thought to be the UK's longest-running cold case to be solved.

Ryland Headley, then aged 34, broke into the home of 75-year-old Louisa Dunne in Bristol in June 1967 before attacking her.

The mother of two's body was found by neighbours inside her terraced home in the Easton area of the city on the morning of June 28.

A woman was heard screaming hours before Louisa, who had been twice widowed and lived alone, was discovered dead.

The victim, who was using the front room as a bedroom, was found lying on a pile of clothes and police found no evidence of any violent struggle in the house.

The case remained unsolved for more than 50 years until Avon and Somerset detectives sent off items from the original investigation for DNA testing. Those results provided a DNA match to Headley, who had moved to Suffolk, and had served a prison sentence for raping two elderly women in 1977.

Headley, of Ipswich, denied the rape and murder of Louisa but he did not give evidence.

He was found guilty by a Bristol Crown Court jury on Tuesday after nine hours and 53 minutes of deliberations.

Speaking outside the court, Det Insp Dave Marchant, who led the investigation, said: "Headley, who has a shocking and abhorrent history of violent sexual attacks on elderly women, brutally attacked Louisa in her own home, where she should have been safe.

"Her murder left a community in shock. There are people living in Bristol today who can

**Kate opens up over cancer 'rollercoaster'**

■ "You have to find your new normal," Princess of Wales tells reporters

**THE Princess of Wales has opened up about her rollercoaster cancer journey, admitting her struggles continued even after treatment ended as she found it difficult to come to terms with her "new normal".**

Kate, 43, told of her "life-changing" experiences with the disease as she said her difficulties were not over when she revealed in January that her illness was in remission.

The mum of three said: "You have to find your new normal and that takes time...and it's a rollercoaster, it's not one smooth plane, which you expect it to be.

"But the reality is it's not, you go through hard times."

The princess, a passionate advocate for the benefits of spending time in nature, spoke as she toured a wellbeing garden at Colchester Hospital in Essex on Tuesday.

She said: "There is a whole phase when you finish your treatment, everybody expects you to be better – go! But that's not the case at all. You put on a sort of brave face, stoicism

through treatment.

"Treatment's done, then it's like, 'I can crack on, get back to normal' – but actually the phase afterwards is really difficult.

"You're not necessarily under the clinical team any longer but you're not able to function normally at home as you perhaps once used to.

**'really valuable'**

"And actually someone to help talk you through that, show you and guide you through that sort of phase that comes after treatment I think is really valuable."

As the princess continued with her visit to the centre, she said: "To have a place like this, to have the support network, through creativity and singing or gardening whatever it might be, is so valuable and it's great this community has it.

"It would be great if lots of communities had this kind of support."

It was understood that Kate's visit was intended to raise awareness about the role of nature in providing joy

and supporting mental, physical and spiritual wellbeing.

This has long been a subject close to the princess's heart – in May she shared a video of a trip to the Lake District with the Scouts and spoke warm-

ly about how nature helps her find a "sense of peace and reconnection".

This week's engagement also coincided with the donation to Colchester Hospital of 50 "Catherine's Rose" plants,

named for the princess by the Royal Horticultural Society.

Funds from sales went to the Royal Marsden Cancer Charity, which is jointly patronised by the Prince and Princess of Wales.

**Murdered pupil had told father: I won't go to school while people have knives'**

**A 15-YEAR-OLD boy told his dad he "wasn't going to school where people had knives" just days before he was fatally stabbed in the heart by another pupil, a court heard this week.**

Harvey Willgoose died after a simmering argument on social media site Snapchat erupted into violence at All Saints Catholic High School in Sheffield, it is alleged.

Another boy, also 15, admits stabbing him but denies murder, claiming it was manslaughter. The city's crown court was shown footage of the inci-

dent on February 3, with prosecutor Richard Thyne KC saying: "It is shocking but it is necessary to play it."

Days earlier Harvey had skipped class after a knife incident at school involving other pupils. He texted his dad to say: "Am not going in that school while people have knives."

The incident led to Harvey and the defendant falling out in a Snapchat group, it is claimed, with each siding with one of the boys involved in the dispute, who were suspended.

Opening the case, Mr Thyne told how after being disarmed, Harvey's killer – who can't be named – said to head teacher Sean Pender: "I'm not right in the head. My mum doesn't look after me right. I've stabbed him."

The altercation happened in a school courtyard just as the lunch break was starting. The prosecution's case, Mr Thyne said, is that the CCTV shows Harvey appearing to put his left hand on the defendant's right arm before the boy "takes a knife out of

his left pocket, passes it across into his right hand, and then stabs twice at Harvey's torso".

The defendant – who wore a white shirt in court – advances towards

Harvey, who backs away, before the boy "returns towards where the incident began, gesturing towards Harvey with his knife and appearing to shout".

The case continues.

remember the impact this crime had on the city. Louisa's family have had an extremely long wait for answers."

Another officer who worked on the investigation described Headley as "worse than an animal".

Mr Justice Sweeting sentenced Headley to a life term the following day.

He told the jury of eight men and four women: "This was a case that has been in the public eye.

"It involved many details which are no doubt distressing. If you are summoned again in the next 10 years for jury service, you are entitled to refuse."

The trial heard that a pathologist concluded Louisa had died from asphyxia due to strangulation from a scarf and pressure on her mouth,

with a hand forcibly held over it.

Swabs were taken from her body, which tested positive for semen, but scientific examinations at that time were limited.

Police also recovered a palm print from an upstairs window. It was compared with those of 19,000 men and boys in 1967 but none matched.

Headley, then a railway worker, was living with his wife about a mile and a half from Louisa's house, but crucially just outside the geographic area in which men and boys were asked for prints.

DNA recovered matched Headley to a ratio that meant it was one billion times more likely to be his DNA than that of someone else.

His DNA had been taken by police and uploaded to the national database after an unrelated offence in 2012, which did not result in a charge.

Ozzy Osbourne says his live show with Black Sabbath this weekend will be his "final encore".

He added: "It's my chance to say thank you to my fans for always supporting me and being there for me."

The Brummie, 76, will go out in style by playing Villa Park in Birmingham on Saturday.

As well as the 42,000 people in the stadium, tens of thousands of fans will be watching at home via a paid-for livestream.

The concert is part of an event called Back To The Beginning and reunites original members Ozzy, Tony Iommi, Gee-

zer Butler and Bill Ward for the first time in 20 years.

Other metal legends will appear too, including Metallica, Pantera and Anthrax.

Ozzy said: "It means everything. I am forever in their debt for showing up for me and the fans. I can't quite put it into

words, but I feel very emotional and blessed."

Of the fans who snapped up the tickets within hours, he added: "I hope they feel appreciated for how much they mean to me."

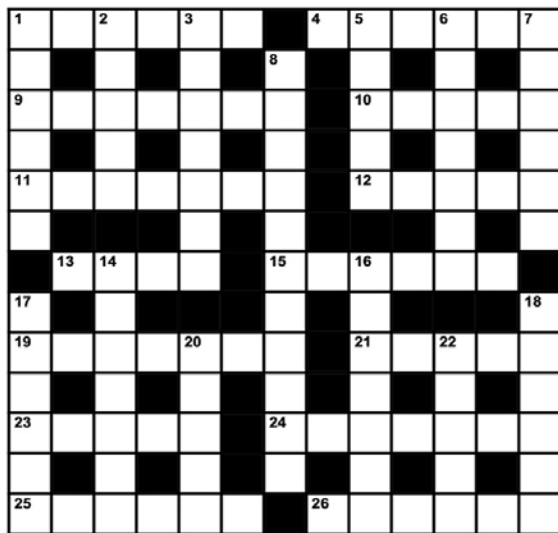

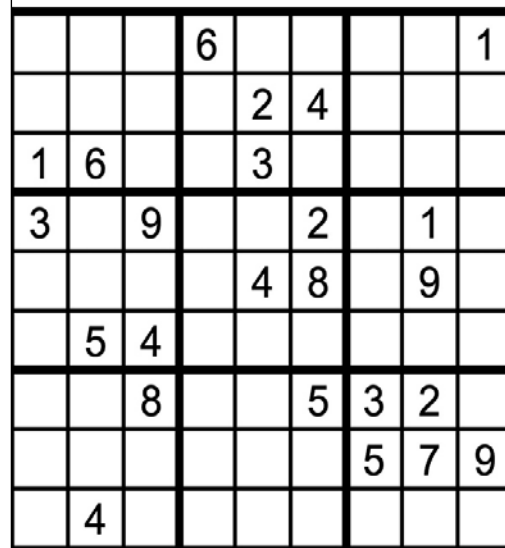

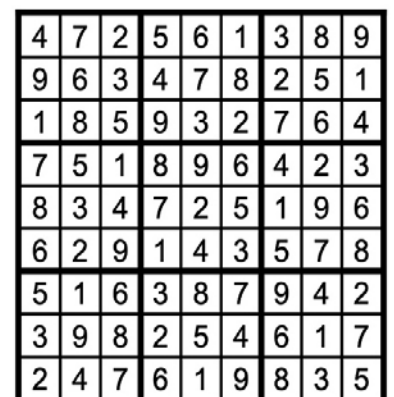

# England repeat as U21 champs

LEE CARSLEY etched his name into English football history on Saturday by masterminding another U21 triumph for the national side, as they retained the trophy they won in 2023 with a thrilling 3-2 extra time victory over Germany.

Carsley's talented and tactically astute side also showed great fortitude after dominating the first half and strolling into a two goal lead, only for

the Germans to show typical grit by fighting back to level.

It took a late goal from Jonathan Rowe to secure the trophy in an emotional climax after Harvey Elliott and Omari Hutchinson had earlier given England the lead their ascendancy deserved.

The captain James McAtee was named player of the match, while Harvey Elliott took the player of the

tournament award. But all over the pitch, among the substitutes and the staff in the dugout, there were faces responsible for making this historic win possible.

Elliott Anderson was magnificent in midfield but all 17 players to feature in the final contributed, supported well by those who did not. With Thomas Tuchel watching on from the stands in Slovakia, he will have seen the wealth of talent at England's disposal.

The story of these age-group tournaments was once one of drop outs, of a nation not helping itself with its attitude to its own national game. But those withdrawals take on a different context amid success, underlining instead an astonishing depth of talent.

selves say to you 'I cannot. I need to manage my efforts' - which would mean what you see on the pitch is not good, the audiences drop, it's as simple as that. This is all about money.

"My hope is that people now, even from a pure business perspective, will see that it does not make sense."

Former Liverpool manager Jurgen Klopp called the competition "the worst idea ever implemented in football", and global players' union Fifpro released a report days before the tournament began saying that players should be allowed at least a four-week off-season break.

"It's this feeling of accumulation of competitions that just do not talk to each other and create a calendar that is just nonsensical," added Molanogo.

"Let's see what happens in October, November [to players] - that's when you're going to start seeing because you pay the price. This Club World Cup gives us a chance to start looking at the bigger picture."

Manchester City manager Pep Guardiola understood Klopp's position, but felt competing in the Club World Cup was

the price of success.

"Would I love to have two months to prepare for next season? Yes. Would I love to be refreshed for next season? Yes. But it is what it is," Guardiola said, before City were knocked out by Al-Hilal this week.

Fifa has also defended itself, with senior sources from the governing body claiming last month the protection of player welfare has been at the core of decision-making, pointing to initiatives such as additional substitutes and permanent concussion subs.

Suggestions the competition has contributed to further congestion in the fixture calendar were firmly dismissed, with a source saying it was "not caused by the Club World Cup".

It was pointed out a maximum of seven Club World Cup games will be played by two teams every four years, with the slot for the competition replacing the one previously used for the Fifa Confederations Cup.

The extended competition was a main trigger for a joint legal action last year by the PFA, along with the French and Italian players' unions, against Fifa over the "overloaded and unworkable" football calendar. A hearing on that is likely to be held early next year.

For the Brazilian striker whose goal won the match, it was an emo-

tionally evening. Afterwards, he paid tribute to his mother, who is recovering after more than two months in hospital with a serious illness.

He said: "I have had a difficult time in the last two months. My mother spent 70 days in the ICU [intensive care unit]."

"Today she is fine, thank God. When I scored those two goals, I thought of her. She was

able to watch the game." Al-Hilal head coach Simone Inzaghi felt as if he was back on top of the world.

A month ago, Inzaghi left Inter Milan, three days after seeing his team thrashed 5-0 by Paris St-Germain in the Champions League final.

Having barely settled into to his new role, and without the services of key injured duo Salem Al

Dawsari and Aleksandar Mitrovic, he now has a huge victory to celebrate.

"The key of this result are the players, the heart they put on the pitch," he said.

"Tonight we had to do something extraordinary because we knew how good Manchester City are. We knew we had to climb Mount Everest without oxygen and we were great."

# Tragic end for Diogo Jota

Liverpool star engulfed in inferno after his Lamborghini crashes in northern Spain

The Liverpool forward Diogo Jota has been killed in a car accident in north-western Spain.

He was 28, a father of three young children and had married his long-term partner, Rute Cardoso, less than two weeks ago.

Liverpool said they were devastated and tributes were paid by Portugal's prime minister and the country's football federation. It is understood that Jota and his brother, 26-year-old André, who was also killed, were travelling in a car that came off a road in the province of Zamora. André was a professional footballer with the second-tier Portuguese club Penafiel.

The cause of the accident, which happened at about midnight on Wednesday, is not clear, but according to police reports the driver lost control after one of the car's rear tyres was punctured. The car, a Lamborghini,

burst into flames and firefighters had to extinguish a blaze in the surrounding countryside caused by the accident.

Jota joined Liverpool from Wolves in 2020 and scored 65 goals in 182 appearances for the club. He won the Premier League title, the FA Cup and League Cup with Liverpool and the Championship title with Wolves in 2018, and was a two-time winner of the Nations League with Portugal. He was an immensely popular figure in the Liverpool dressing room with a warm and friendly personality.

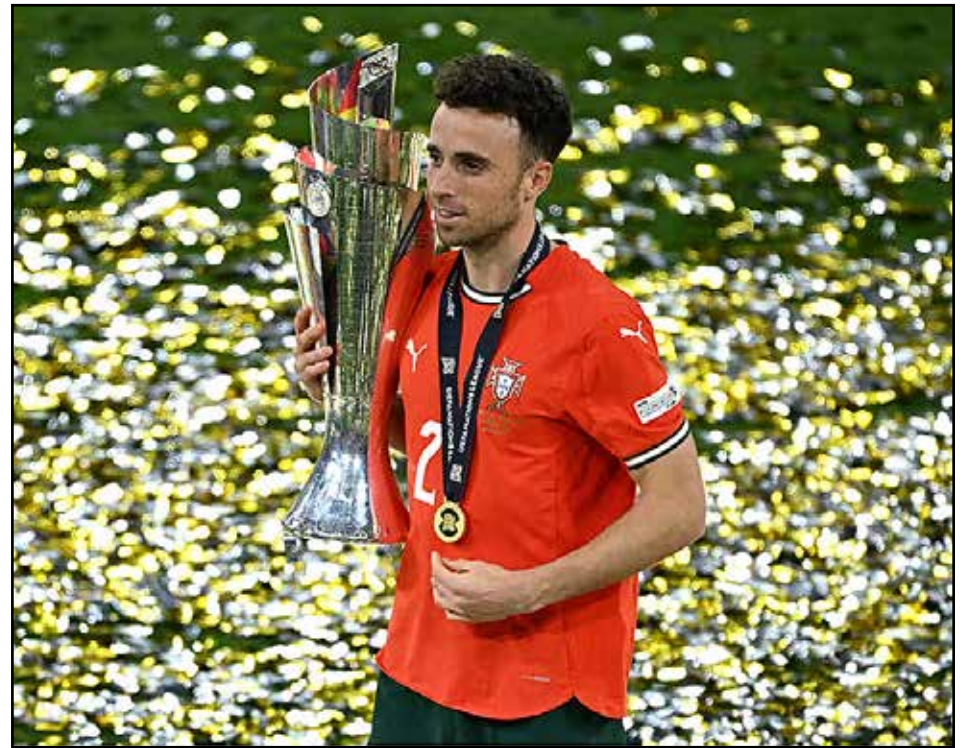
Liverpool Football Club are devastated by the tragic passing of Diogo Jota," said a club statement which also requested "the privacy of Diogo and André's family, friends, teammates and club staff as they try to come to terms with an unimaginable loss. We will continue to provide them

with our full support."

Jota and his partner were married in Porto on 22 June and announced the news in an Instagram post a few days ago. On Monday Rute shared more pictures from their wedding day and wrote: "My dream came true." Jota commented: "I'm the lucky one." They had met in high school and started going out in 2013, a year before he turned professional.

## Club World Cup 'devaluing football'

The Club World Cup is devaluing football because players cannot perform properly, according to Professional Footballers' Association chief executive Maheta Molango.

High temperatures have impacted players, while low crowds have also been a factor in Fifa's extended competition in America.

Ten Juventus players asked to be substituted during their 1-0 defeat by Real Madrid this week, with the last-16 game in Miami on Tuesday played in temperatures reaching 30C and humidity of 70%.

Borussia Dortmund's substitutes also spent the first half of their game against Mamelodi Sundowns last month watching from the dressing room because of the heat.

Six matches have had to be suspended because of thunderstorms, including a two-hour delay in Chelsea's last-16 win over Benfica.

It means, less than a year before the start of the World Cup in the USA, Canada and Mexico, Molango is worried by how the competition is impacting the players and the sport.

"We're devaluing the product and it's a shame because if I'm a US fan and that's my first exposure to soccer, that's not good," he said.

"We need to be mindful we're competing with other sports and they're very good at entertainment. Then it becomes a very poor comparison.

"We've reached a stage where the quality is dropping, because there's no way you can have a good game if you play at 4pm in Mexico.

"It's impossible, because the players them-
