DIGITAL IDs ON THE WAY

■ **PM touts potential benefits of scheme but critics decry further erosion of civil liberties**

Sir Keir Starmer has announced plans for a compulsory UK-wide digital ID scheme.

Speaking on Friday, the prime minister claims the scheme will help crack down on illegal working and modernize the state.

The practicalities of the scheme will be subject to a consultation, which will also look at how to make it work for those without a smartphone or passport.

The previous Labour government's attempt to introduce ID cards was ultimately blocked by the Conservative-Liberal Democrat coalition.

But earlier this month, Sir Keir said in an interview he thought the debate had "moved on" since then.

central database

"We all carry a lot more digital ID now than we did 20 years ago, and I think that psychologically, it plays a different part," he added.

Reports have suggested the government plans to use a new scheme to check people's right to live and work in the UK, with people's individual ID checked against a central database.

These checks are currently based on physical documents, although routes to complete the checks online for some people have existed since 2022.

Plans for a digital ID scheme did not feature in Labour's election manifesto last year, and the government has previously rejected a proposal for digital ID suggested by former Labour Prime Minister Sir Tony Blair.

But in recent weeks ministers have spoken with increasing enthusiasm about the idea, as they have come under increasing pressure to tackle illegal migration.

Cabinet Office minister Pat McFadden has also talked about the scheme's potential to improve access to government services.

He recently visited Estonia, where digital identity can be used to access services such as medical records, voting and banking.

'desperate gimmick'

Conservative leader Kemi Badenoch said introducing mandatory ID would be "very serious step that requires a proper national debate".

She criticised the government's announcement as a "desperate gimmick" to distract attention from the "leadership maneuverings" of Greater Manchester Mayor Andy Burnham ahead of Labour's annual conference

next week.

She has previously said that digital ID was "not really going to solve the problem" of illegal working in the UK.

Reform UK has denounced the plan as a "cynical ploy to fool voters that something is being done about illegal immigration".

"It's laughable that those already breaking immigration law will suddenly comply, or that digital IDs will have any impact on illegal work," the party added.

Jeremy Corbyn, who is set to launch a new left-wing party in the coming weeks, said he was op-

Charities cut ties with Fergie

■ Epstein affair rumbles on for Royals

Seven charities have dropped the Duchess of York as a patron or ambassador after an email from 2011 revealed that she called sex offender Jeffrey Epstein her "supreme friend" and seemed to apologise for her public criticism of him.

Julia's House, a children's hospice, was the first to remove Sarah Ferguson, Prince Andrew's ex-wife, saying it was "inappropriate" for her

to continue in the role. The Teenage Cancer Trust, Natasha Allergy Research Foundation, Children's Literacy Char-

ity, National Foundation for Retired Service Animals and Prevent Breast Cancer also announced they had dropped the

duchess as patron.

The British Heart Foundation said she would no longer be its ambassador.

A spokesperson for the duchess said she was not commenting on the charities' decisions to end their links with her.

It comes after the Mail on Sunday and Sun newspapers published a 2011 email from the duchess to Epstein, which appears to have been sent after she had publicly claimed to have broken off contact with him.

Reform will 'turn Britain into Trump's America' says Lib Dem's Davey

Sir Ed Davey has used his keynote speech to warn that the UK has a choice between "the real change people crave", and a Reform government turning Britain into "Trump's America".

The leader of the Liberal Democrats has sought to paint a picture of the country at a crossroads, and has heaped accusations on Nigel Farage - suggesting he would reverse gun laws and scrap the NHS.

The party has watched in dismay as their historic success in last year's election has largely been overshadowed by Reform's

growing popularity in the opinion polls.

In an attempt to regain the initiative, Sir Ed has spent the past few days of the party's conference in Bournemouth attacking tech titan Elon Musk and the Reform UK leader.

'state of chaos'

But now he has used his speech to try and tie the ideas of Mr Farage and President Trump together in voters' minds.

He said: "Imagine living in the Trump-inspired country Farage wants us to become.

"Where there's no NHS, so patients are hit with crippling insurance bills. Or denied healthcare altogether.

"Where we pay Putin for expensive fossil fuels and destroy our beautiful countryside with fracking - while climate change rages on.

"Where gun laws are rolled back, so schools have to teach our children what to do in case of a mass shooting. Where social media barons are free to poison young minds with impunity."

Sir Ed also accused Mr Farage's party of allow-

ing "the government [to] trample on our basic rights and freedoms" by saying it will pull the UK out of the European Convention on Human Rights (ECHR) - and of giving "tacit support" to racism and misogyny.

The Lib Dem claimed a Reform government

would be "where everything is in a constant state of chaos".

Under Mr Farage, those with mental health problems would be told they are "making it up", and children with special educational needs that they have "been wrongly diagnosed", Sir Ed said.

"That is Trump's America. Don't let it become Farage's Britain," he warned.

But Sir Ed has not only attacked Reform UK for what could happen if they came to power, but also for the "crisis", which he accused Mr Farage of having already caused.

Labour heavyweight again questions PM's leadership

■ Manchester Mayor refuses to rule out Starmer challenge

GREATER MANCHESTER Mayor Andy Burnham has criticized the way Sir Keir Starmer runs the party, and has warned it is facing an "existential" threat.

Burnham, (right) who has become a major player in the party despite not being an MP, is seen by many Labour voters as one of the few authentic voices for traditional party val-

ues, and a welcome counterweight to what they see as the middle class, London-oriented leadership of Sir Keir.

Burnham, who has been tipped as a potential new leader - said "wholesale change" is needed if the party is to survive.

He fired warning shots at the Prime Minister as Labour prepares for its annual conference in Liver-

pool, starting on Sunday.

And while Mr Burnham expressed frustration with rumours that he plans to oust Sir Keir and launch his own leadership bid, he openly attacked the current direction of his party.

The former health secretary told Left-wing magazine New Statesman, the "challenge we've got in front of us cannot be met by a very factional and quite



divisive running of the Labour Party". He added: "Where is our plan to turn the country around?"

"I'm going to put the question back to people at Labour conference: are we up for that wholesale change? Because I think that's what the country needs."

Mr Burnham said it would be a "wrench" to leave his mayoral role, but did not rule out a tilt at the top job.

He said: "Am I ready to work with anybody who wants to sort of put in place a plan to turn the country around? I'm happy to play any role. I am ready to play any role in that."

British jet pilots 'ready for Russians'

BRITISH jet pilots are ready to confront Russian planes violating Nato airspace, Foreign Secretary Yvette Cooper told the United Nations this week.

She accused Vladimir Putin of risking "direct armed confrontation" with recent incursions into alliance members' territory.

Addressing the UN security council for the first time as Foreign Secretary, she said: "They are a deliberate attempt to undermine the territorial integrity of sovereign nations and European security.

"They risk miscalculation. They open the door to direct armed confrontation between Nato and Russia. To President Putin, I say your reckless actions

risk a direct confrontation. Our alliance is defensive, but be under no illusion, we stand ready to take all steps necessary to defend NATO's skies and NATO's territory.

"We are vigilant. We are resolute. If we need to confront planes that are operating in Nato airspace without permission, then we will do so."

Three Kremlin jets entered Estonian airspace without permission for 12 minutes last Friday.

They were intercepted by Italian aircraft operating as part of Nato's eastern sentry mission.

The incursion followed similar incidents in Poland and Romania in which Russian drones were intercepted or shot down over Nato members' territory.

Poland's prime minister Donald Tusk said his country was the closest to "open conflict" it had been since the Second World War.

In response to the drone incursion over Poland, the UK announced that RAF Typhoon jets would also take part in the eastern sentry, flying their first mission over Poland late on September 19.

gise for her public rejection of Epstein, saying: "You have always been a steadfast, generous and supreme friend to me and my family."

That seemed to contradict her public denunciation of Epstein in an interview from a few weeks earlier, in which she had said her involvement with him, including borrowing money, had been a "gigantic error of judgement" and that: "What he did was wrong and for which he was rightly jailed."

The duchess had said she would "have nothing ever to do with Jeffrey Epstein ever again" only for the later email to say she "humbly apologised" to him and "know you feel helliciously let down by me".

A spokesperson for the duchess said her subsequent email to Epstein, describing him as a friend, was written to counter a threat from him to sue her for defamation - and that she still really regretted any association with him.

"This email was sent in the context of advice the duchess was given to try to assuage Epstein and his threats," said a statement from her spokesman, when the email to Epstein had been published at the weekend.

The response to the emergence of the email - sent several years after Epstein's jailing for sex offences in 2008 - was for a series of charities to cut their links with the duchess.

That included the Teenage Cancer Trust, where she had been patron for 35 years.

She also ended her role at Julia's House charity, which supports families in Dorset and Wiltshire, where the duchess had been patron since 2018.

Trump is "racist, sexist, misogynistic and Islamophobic", says Sadiq Khan

■ London Mayor fires back after President falsely claims city plans to adopt Sharia Law

Sir Sadiq Khan has said Donald Trump has shown he is "racist, sexist, misogynistic and Islamophobic" after the president made comments about him to the United Nations.

Speaking to the UN General Assembly in New York on Tuesday, Trump said London had "a terrible, terrible mayor, and it's been changed, it's been so changed".

He added: "Now they want to go to Sharia law."

Speaking to BBC London, Sir Sadiq said: "People are wondering what it is about this Muslim mayor who leads a liberal, multi-cultural, progressive and successful city, that means I appear to be living rent-free inside Donald Trump's head."

He added: "I think President Trump has

shown he is racist, he is sexist, he is misogynistic and he is Islamophobic."

"When people say things, when people act in a certain way, when people behave in a certain way, you've got to believe them," he said.

'number one city'

Responding to the president calling him a "terrible mayor", he said he was "thankful we have record numbers of Americans coming to London".

He added that different criteria showed London was "often the number one city on the globe when it comes to culture".

Cabinet minister Pat McFadden defended Sir Sadiq on Wednesday.

He said the London mayor and US president "have had a beef for

some years" and rejected the claim that London wanted to "go to" Sharia law.

He said British law and "no other kind of law" applied in the UK.

Earlier this month, justice minister Sarah Sackman told the House

of Commons Sharia law formed "no part of the law of England and Wales".

While religious courts, including Sharia councils, do operate in the UK, most of their work deals with religious marriage arbitration and financial

matters. The government has been clear that their rulings are not legally binding.

Reform UK leader Nigel Farage said that with President Trump, people should "never take what he says literally, ever, on anything, but always take everything he says seriously".

Speaking during an LBC phone-in, he added: "So is he right to say that Sharia is an issue in London? Yes.

"Is it an overwhelming issue at this stage? No.

"Has the mayor of London directly linked himself to it? No."

He added: "I think what Trump was aiming at with his big pitch that the West (is) going to hell is it's in danger of losing its culture, its heritage, its identity."

Without Coleen I'd be dead, says Rooney

■ United legend opens up about his long battle with booze

Wayne Rooney has spoken of his alcohol addiction - and says he could have died without his wife's help.

The former England great is still Manchester United's top scorer. But Rooney has now revealed how he battled with the booze even as he starred on the pitch.

Referring to his wife Coleen, he said: "I honestly believe if she wasn't there, I'd be dead. I believe that."

He also told the Rio Ferdinand Presents podcast how he would hide his drinking from the then United boss Sir Alex Ferguson at training.



Rooney said: "I wanted to go out and enjoy my time with my friends and having a night out. It got to a point where I went too far, of course it did. That was a moment in my life where I was struggling massively. With alcohol. Massively struggling and I didn't think I could turn to anyone.

"I remember going into training and putting eyes drops in, chewing gum. I just drank for two

days straight.

"Go training and at the weekend, I'd scored two goals and then I'd go back and go and drink for two days straight again."

Rooney believes Coleen saved his life and he added: "Coleen is massive.

"It's bad because we're two kids from Croxteth, and then we grew up together and obviously we started dating and got married and have kids.

"But when I was 17 she could see, she knew my mind and she knew I was a bit out there.

"You know, I loved my football. I was obsessed with football, but also I loved a night out or whatever going out. She's seen it very early on, and she's controlled that.

"Well, not controlled, but helped me control that massively."

The couple, childhood sweethearts from Croxteth in Liverpool, married in 2008 and share four sons.

Their marriage has survived scandals including Rooney's alleged infidelities and his 2017 drink-drive charge. The 39-year-old has moved into punditry after being sacked as Plymouth boss last year - but he has not ruled out a return to the dug-out.

Halt Cod fishing now, say boffins

COD fishing around Britain should be halted entirely next year to prevent stocks from collapsing, scientists have warned - with conservationists urging swift government action.

Advice from the International Council for Exploration of the Sea rec-

ommends "zero catch" quotas in 2026 for cod stocks in the "Northern shelf" - English Channel, North Sea up to Norway and west of Scotland.

Cod in the southern region of the Northern shelf is in a serious state, with 61% declines in the past decade.

Ministers reconsider migrant taxi plan after £600 fare

Ministers are reviewing the use of taxis to take asylum seekers to hospital appointments, after it emerged that some trips are costing the taxpayer £600 a time.

Pat McFadden, the work and pensions secretary, told reporters that the Home Office was looking into the claims which emerged in a BBC report.

It found that a failed asylum seeker staying in a hotel used by the Home Office had been sent on a 250-mile taxi journey that cost £600 for a knee check-up.

The Iraqi man said he would have preferred to have gone to his NHS appointment by train but that he "had no choice" other than to accept the transportation laid on by the Home Office.

It is understood that the trip cost so much because he was taken to see a consultant who had treated him at a previous address before he went into the hotel.

"Should the Home Office give me the ticket for the train? This is the easy way, and they know they spend too much money," the man said. "We know as well, but we don't have any choice. It's crazy."

The report said that migrants were not offered the option to travel by public transport, or to walk, to appointments and taxis were booked by an "automated system" at the hotel front desk.

McFadden said: "I quite understand people's concern about the use of public money in this way. I think it's a good report and it was highlighted and I understand the Home Office is looking into this."

Scottish soldiers buried in France on the 110th anniversary of their deaths

■ The pair, who were identified via DNA testing, were killed in September 1915

ONE HUNDRED and ten years after their death, two Scottish soldiers were laid to rest on Thursday in a French cemetery with full military honours.

The remains of Lieutenant (Lt) James Grant Allan, 9th Battalion, Gordon Highlanders and Lance Corporal (LCpl) Gordon McPherson, 7th Battalion, Cameron Highlanders, were laid to rest alongside six unidentified comrades exactly 110 years after they were killed in action on the first day of the Battle of Loos.

The service was supported by serving soldiers from 4th Battalion The Royal Regiment of Scotland.

Lt Allan left Edinburgh University to join the Gordon Highlanders in 1914, when war was declared. He joined at the same time as his brother Nimmo, and they both went to fight in France.

He was killed on 25 September 1915. A friend and fellow officer wrote

"Jim's men thought the world of him" and continued "I have gained from his friendship...He may have left this world but only to go to a freer one...I have been strengthened by the thought of him, or his presence".

positive match

He was identified after artefacts found with the casualties suggested one was an officer, which narrowed their search. The families of the battalion's 14 missing officers were traced and tested, with Lt Allan's family proving a positive match.

LCpl McPherson was working as a tobacconist when he joined the Cameron Highlanders in November 1914 alongside his two brothers and their father. He too was killed on 25 September 1915, a fellow soldier of his machine-gun section, described him as "the life and soul of the section. His imitations of Charles Chaplin were enjoyed very much by his com-

rades. His favourite song, 'Trumpeter, what are you sounding now!', grew to be the most popular song in the section...It was Gordon's song. We can't sing it now."

LCpl McPherson was identified by a small set of buttons from the Newcastle Corporation Tramway that he had in his pocket at the time of his death. After studying the 1911 census, the War Detectives discov-

ered that LCpl McPherson's father worked for the Tramway so a DNA test was sent to the next of kin, which came back positive.

All the soldiers buried this week were discovered during construction work for a new hospital on the outskirts of Lens.

The service was organised by the MOD's Joint Casualty and Compassionate Centre (JCCC), also known as the

'MOD War Detectives'.

Nicola Nash, MOD War Detective said: Lt Allan and LCpl McPherson have both been buried today 110 years after they were killed. With half a million British servicemen still missing from the First World War, every identity we make is a huge achievement. It has been a real privilege to give closure to their families and lay these heroes to rest with honour."

Royal Society mulls Musk expulsion following remarks at London rally

Elon Musk's controversial comments at the Unite the Kingdom rally in London earlier this month have raised doubts over his fellowship of the Royal Society - the world's most prestigious scientific institution.

Addressing the rally organised by right-wing activist Tommy Robinson, Musk criticized "uncontrolled migration" and said: "Whether you choose violence or not, violence is coming to you. You either fight back or you die."

In response, Sir Adrian Smith, president of the Society, wrote a letter to fellows in which he raised concerns about "resort-

He said the matter would be discussed at the society's next council meeting.

and the growing tendency to resort to the language of violence in pursuit of political programmes - including, unfortunately, an address to the recent London rally from a Fellow of the Royal Society."

Earlier this year, thousands of scientists signed a letter raising concerns about his involvement in funding cuts to US scientific research, as part of his previous role in Trump's Department of Government Efficiency.

The Society debated his fellowship in March but it was decided he would remain. Some fellows said any attempts to remove him could be seen as a curtailment of freedom of expression.

Without referencing Musk directly, Sir Adrian Smith wrote to fellows: "I am sure that many of you will share my concern at the events of the last week

and the growing tendency to resort to the language of violence in pursuit of political programmes - including, unfortunately, an address to the recent London rally from a Fellow of the Royal Society."

He went on to say that: "Most of us have had the good fortune to have lived our lives in contexts where core values of tolerance, courtesy, respect for others, and freedom of speech have been widely acknowledged and respected and we have come to take them for granted."

"It is no accident that human understanding and science have also flourished to an extraordinary extent in this period."

RIP Dickie Bird, who fell eight years short of his century

■ Tributes flow for legendary cricket umpire, whose presided over 66 Test matches

Legendary cricket umpire Dickie Bird has died aged 92, Yorkshire County Cricket Club has announced.

In a statement this week, the club said: "It is with profound sadness that The Yorkshire County Cricket Club announces the passing of Harold Dennis 'Dickie' Bird MBE OBE, one of cricket's most beloved figures, who died peacefully at home at the age of 92.

"Dickie Bird enjoyed an illustrious career as an international umpire, writing his name into history as the most famous and popular official in the game's history.

"He is synonymous with Yorkshire Cricket, where he has been one

of the most loyal supporters. In 2014, he was named President of The Yorkshire County Cricket Club, a role he held with pride and distinction, with the club winning two County Championship titles during his tenure."

'greatest characters'

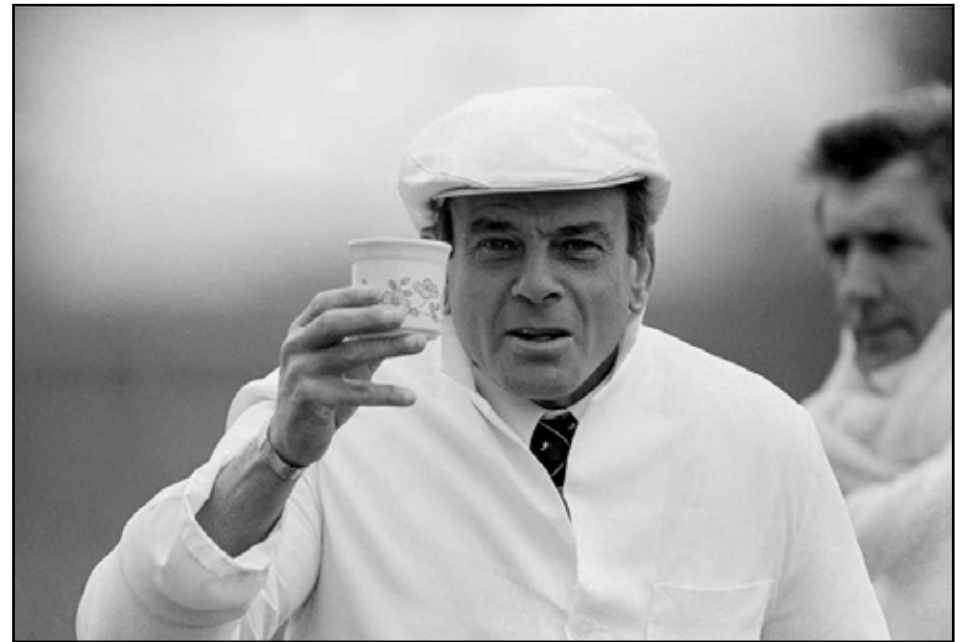
Describing him as "one of the most prominent umpires of his era", the club said he "will be truly missed by all at the club, having spent an incredible amount of time in support of everyone here and will be remembered as one of the greatest characters in Yorkshire's history".

Bird came to be one of the best-known figures in the sport, an outstanding umpire also

famous for his amusing interactions with players and fans alike, as well as his seeming talent for being involved in quirky, memorable moments.

Among the incidents that saw his legend grow were a bomb scare at Lord's, when he observed proceedings while sitting on the covers in the centre of the pitch, the burst water pipes at Headingley and his entertaining exchange of opinions with a frustrated crowd, a first recorded instance of "good light stopped play" thanks to a Trent Bridge greenhouse and an elbow injury sustained while slipping in the showers at the Women's World Cup.

Blessed with a good

nature and vivid character, the unmarried and childless Bird's wide popularity ultimately transcended umpiring.

His autobiography sold more than a million copies, becoming the nation's biggest-selling sports book ever, and he entertained the public for years as a TV personality and travelling raconteur.

"he was special"

In a favoured story, he claimed his one-man show drew a bigger audience in Leeds than superstar singer Shirley Bassey.

He was awarded an MBE in 1986 and an OBE in 2012 in recognition of his outstanding contribution to cricket.

In an umpiring career spanning nearly 30 years, he stood in 66 Test matches and 69 one-day internationals, including three World Cup finals.

Former England cricket captain Sir Ian Botham told Sky News: "He was special. We used to take the mickey out of him, saying, 'oh, come on, Dickie, you've got to give some decisions'.

"But, you know, 99.9% of the time, he was spot

on. He had a good sense of humour. I saw him not very long ago. And, I'm quite shocked to see that he passed away. He looked in pretty good order. He hadn't really changed that much when I saw him last.

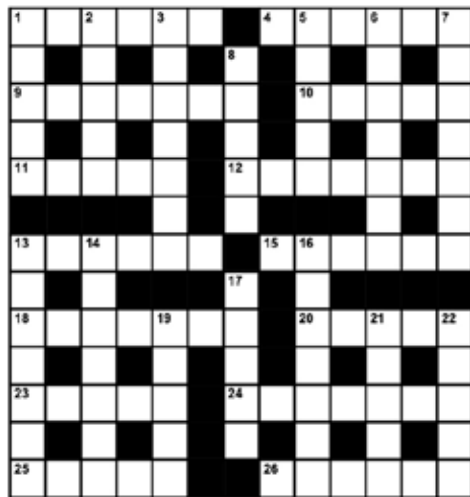
"So, very sad. And 92 - he'll be disappointed he didn't get those extra eight for a century."

The England and Wales Cricket Board said it was "deeply saddened" by the death of Bird, who it described as "a proud Yorkshireman and a much-loved umpire" who "will be sorely missed".

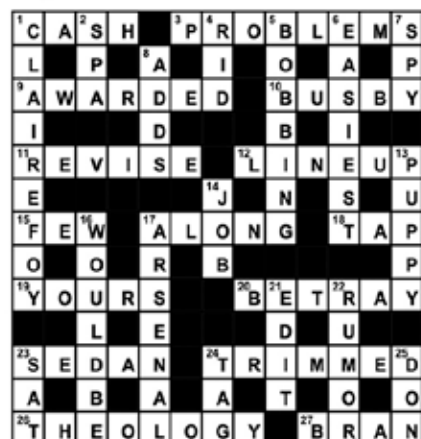

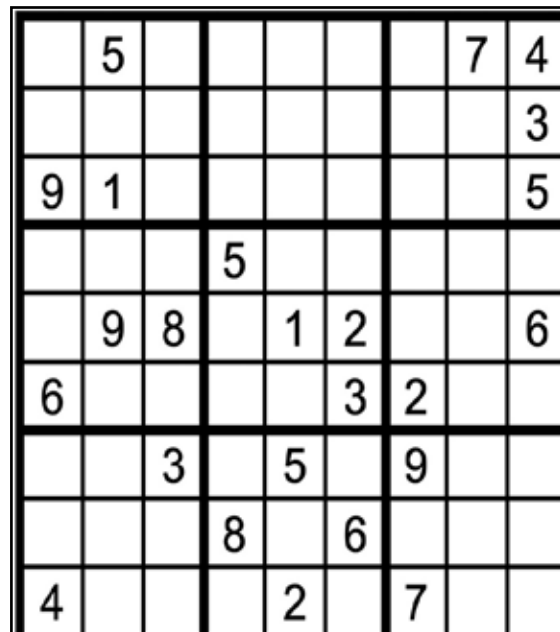

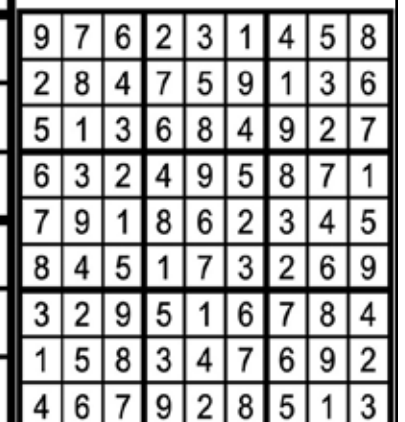

SLOW HORSES: Season Five drops, but was it worth the wait?

■ Engrossing British espionage drama returns to Apple TV

IT'S BEEN a long wait for fans of *Slow Horses* but the big day finally arrived this week.

Season five of the acclaimed British spy drama dropped on Apple TV with a sense of both renewal and risk. After four seasons of the tautly written espionage saga, laced with black humour and bruised humanity, this latest chapter adapts Mick Herron's *London Rules* and shifts the emphasis in ways that are bound to divide viewers.

Change of tone

It begins with a jolt: a mass shooting in London sets the stage for a season steeped in political volatility, media panic, and right-wing extremism. The specter of Slough House itself becoming a target raises the stakes, while MI5's internal corruption and

cover-ups once again form the dark backdrop against which these outcasts must operate.

What is immediately striking about this season is the change in tone. Where previous instalments leaned heavily into tension and paranoia, season five finds new energy in satire and absurdity. The series has always undercut the glamour of spy work, but here it pushes further into farce, allowing

comedy to rub directly against menace. The effect is refreshing at times, as if the show is deliberately pulling away from self-importance, but it can also feel uneven, the shifts between terror and humour so sharp that coherence suffers. Still, it demonstrates a willingness not to stagnate and ensures the series avoids the trap of self-parody.

Up comes Ho

Perhaps the boldest creative decision is the elevation of Roddy Ho. Long a figure of comic relief—brilliant at tech, insufferable in almost every other respect—Roddy now becomes central to the plot. Christopher Chung seizes the opportunity, delivering a performance that expands the character beyond caricature. His arrogance and naivety remain intact, but a romantic subplot, in which his new girlfriend may or may not be ensnaring him in a honey trap, lends him unexpected vulnerability. Critics in Britain have been divided over this new direction; some have praised Roddy's rise for giving the show a fresh spark, but for others it tips the delicate balance between satire and suspense too far to the former. Either way, it shifts the series' centre

of gravity in a significant way.

The familiar players, meanwhile, continue to provide the weight. Gary Oldman's Jackson Lamb remains the show's anchor, his acerbic one-liners and slovenly manner still concealing a ruthless intelligence and occasional, begrudging flashes of care for his team. Jack Lowden's River Cartwright is once again battered by betrayal and family ghosts, his arc haunted by questions of legacy and loyalty. Kristin Scott Thomas, as Diana Taverner, embodies the bureaucratic ruthlessness of MI5 with steel and precision, her scenes bristling with cynicism. And the ensemble of slow horses themselves carry scars from past losses, particularly Shirley's grief over Marcus's death and Louisa's ongoing struggle with trauma, even if some of these characters are more sidelined than in earlier seasons.

scattershot

The plotting, however, is where the cracks show most clearly. With only six episodes to work with, the writers cram in a dense array of storylines: terrorism, political maneuvering, Roddy's romantic entanglements, River's family turmoil, MI5 infighting. The result is a pace that can feel scattershot, some threads rushed while others dangle unresolved. The best episodes manage to braid absurdity and dread into

a seamless whole, but too often the season feels as though it is sprinting from crisis to crisis, leaving little room for tension to build or for emotional payoffs to land with full force.

Still, when the show slows down, it continues to deliver moments of real emotional bite. The characters' grief and trauma are not easily discarded, and the series wisely refuses to let the consequences of earlier seasons fade into the background. River's haunted sense of duty, Shirley's raw anger, and Louisa's quiet sorrow remind viewers that in this world, survival always comes at a cost. These undercurrents provide ballast when the satire threatens to spin the story into farce, grounding the show in something human and painful.

above average?

Visually and stylistically, *Slow Horses* retains its distinctive bleakness: the grey wash of London streets, the drab interiors of Slough House, and the claustrophobic feel of lives lived on the margins of an institution that barely acknowledges their existence. Yet there are also flashes of stylish wit in the direction, moments when tension is punctured by absurdity or when Lamb's insults slice through the dourness like a knife. The show still revels in anti-spectacle, eschewing glamour for messiness, reminding us that espionage is as often about

paperwork and incompetence as it is about cloak-and-dagger thrills.

Critical reception has reflected this ambivalence. Some see season five as a daring reinvention, an invigorating change of pace that broadens the show's range. Others view it as a misstep, too diffuse and tonally inconsistent to match the crystalline sharpness of earlier years. The truth likely lies somewhere in between. This is not *Slow Horses* at its very best, but it remains far above the average spy drama, its willingness to be strange and mordantly funny setting it apart from sleeker but emptier fare.

In the end, season five feels like a bridge. It gives more depth to Roddy, sets up new conflicts for River and his fractured family, and keeps alive the question of whether Lamb's dysfunctional band can ever truly cohere as a team. It does not offer the sheer thrill of the second or fourth seasons, but it shows a series still capable of reinvention, still interested in its characters' humanity as much as in its plot mechanics. Whether this gamble pays off will depend on where the next chapters lead. For now, *Slow Horses* remains one of television's most distinctive spy dramas, its flaws inseparable from its ambition, its humour as sharp as its grief is deep.

Ryder Cup 2025: let battle commence!

Europeans brace for hostile reception at Bethpage

ONE OF sport's most compelling contests kicks off again this weekend with the 2025 Ryder Cup at Bethpage, New York.

The past five Ryder Cups have ended in resounding victories for the home side, but the bookies have made the home side only slight favourites, to win back the trophy, with many insiders tipping the European team to triumph on American soil for the first time since 2012.

On Thursday, he upped the ante a little more by saying that Europe have the chance this week to "go down as one of greatest Ryder Cup teams in history".

Friday's opening session, which happened after press time, is likely to be pivotal in deciding the eventual winner.

In each of the past five events the overall victors have trounced the visitors in the first-day foursomes.

Europe dropped only half a point out of 12 in these sequences in the triumphs of 2014, 2018 and 2023.

At Whistling Straits four years ago the US

took the opening foursomes 3-1 en route to a record 19-9 victory. In 2016 they won the Friday foursomes session 4-0 at Hazeltine and Europe never truly recovered.

Quick start vital

In the most recent away matches of 2016 and 2021, Europe trail 11½-4½ in foursomes. It feels as though they have to reverse this trend to have any chance this week.

It is the tone-setter for the three days of competition.

A quick start is also vital because it could determine whether New York's notoriously boisterous fans turn Bethpage into a "bear pit" from the playground it has been so far.

The build-up has been dominated by talk of how the home fans will treat the away players.

American Collin Morikawa said the atmosphere has been "tame" during

the practice days, with lots of autograph-hunting kids admitted for free. He is hoping for "absolute chaos" come Friday.

Keeping the fans subdued will be high on Europe's agenda.

The US won by 10 points in 2021's 'walloping in Wisconsin', with the home supporters celebrating victory as early as midway through the second of the three day's play, emboldened by Justin Thomas' beer-swilling, can-throwing antics on the first tee.

Last time out, the stands that towered over the first tee in Rome proved too intimidating for the American players. They failed to win the opening hole in any of the first dozen matches as Europe romped to an early lead they wouldn't relinquish.

As at Whistling Straits four years ago, the visitors have been on a charm offensive, signing thou-

sands of autographs and posing for selfies but they know the noise will be turned up come game day.

European captain Luke Donald dished out virtual reality headsets, which could be programmed with all manner of abuse, to his players. A gimmick perhaps but if it provides a marginal gain for one player it will have been deemed worth it.

Justin Rose knows the importance of getting European blue on the board, having been a key member of the last team to win away in 2012 - the famed 'Miracle at Medinah' when Europe recovered from 10-4 down late on the Saturday, to win 14.5-13.5.

"As soon as we were able to flip the script, the crowd did change, they did go quiet," he told BBC Sport.

"They didn't like it and that's going to be our goal, to pacify the crowd."

Europe certainly have the advantage in terms of playing experience, with 32 appearances between their dozen, compared with 15 for the US.

Naturally, Europe's players have won more points too, leading 68½-30 in that category.

McIlroy and Justin Rose are Europe's veterans and are the only two players to have won away - although Donald was also on that team at Medinah in 2012.

Between them they have amassed 33½ points from 13 combined appearances and both arrived in New York on the back of excellent years.

Scottie Scheffler is clearly the standout player for the Americans. The runaway world number one, has had another outstanding year, with two more major titles - the US PGA and Open Championship - among his six victories.

Alexander Isak claimed his first goal for Liverpool before Hugo Ekitike scored the winner and was sent off in a narrow victory over Southampton in the Carabao Cup third round on Tuesday.

Sweden striker Isak finished coolly in the 43rd minute after Federico Chiesa latched on to Saints goalkeeper Alex McCarthy's sloppy pass and cut the ball back to Isak.

But the Reds were not at their best and Shea Charles levelled on 76 minutes when Wataru Endo headed back towards his own goal, setting up a nervy finish.

Ekitike, who had replaced Isak at half-time and has impressed since his summer move to Merseyside, put the hosts back in front when Chiesa

raced on to the ball and set up the Frenchman to slot home.

But, already on a booking for a foul early in the second half, Ekitike took off his shirt in celebration and was shown red, leaving Liverpool to see out the final four minutes plus stoppage time with 10 men - and he is now suspended for Saturday's Premier League trip to Crystal Palace.

Manager Arne Slot had made 11 changes to the side that beat Everton on Saturday and this was a far-from-perfect performance from his young team.

Tottenham continued their strong start to life under Thomas Frank and sealed a spot in the fourth round of the Carabao Cup with victory against Doncaster.

Frank showed the depth of his squad, making seven changes to the side that drew at Brighton on Saturday, and they did not skip a beat.

Mathys Tel had two opportunities to score inside the opening three minutes - with one shot blocked before an air kick from eight yards saw the second pass by.

Rangers' misery continues

It was as good as it got for the Scottish Premiership's 11th-placed side.

Oh - scorer of 12 goals in 47 Celtic appearances a couple of seasons ago - somehow missed when all alone in the area. Patrik Hrosovsky then struck a post.

Rangers then thought they had a penalty when James Tavernier's header struck the raised arm of Joris Kayembe but, after a long review, Tavernier

was deemed to have given him a slight push.

After Diomande's exit, the drama continued when the Rangers captain lost Yaimar Medina, then caught him, and a penalty was given. To Rangers' relief Jack Butland denied Oh from the spot.

But the decisive moment came when Oh escaped a dithering defence and fired across the exposed goalkeeper.

The Korean still had time to miss from a yard on the slide, then have another ruled out for offside as Genk hunted a second.

McGinn a tonic for Villa!

EUROPA LEAGUE: Emery's men hold their nerve to notch vital first win

Captain John McGinn fired nervy Aston Villa to their first win of the season as they edged past Bologna on Thursday.

Unai Emery's side began their Europa League campaign with an unconvincing victory against the limited Italians.

Villa did little to persuade those watching that their early-season slump is over, producing a tentative display in their league phase opener, with Ollie Watkins also missing a second-half penalty.

Villa's winner came early when Scotland mid-

fielder McGinn struck from the edge of the box, his second goal against the Italians after netting in the Champions League last season.

Evann Guessand had already been denied by Lukasz Skorupski while the goalkeeper also saved from the lively Donyell Malen as Villa chased a second.

Yet the hosts lost their momentum and Bologna - captained by another Scotland midfielder, Lewis Ferguson - sensed a comeback with Federico Bernardeschi testing Marco Bizot soon after the break.

Skorupski then saved Watkins' weak penalty, after the striker was brought down, to give Bologna further hope and Santiago Castro's header hit the bar with 20 minutes left.

Bologna also nearly grabbed a last-gasp leveller but Bizot kept out Martin Vitik's header.

Aston Villa hauled themselves across the line for a victory that gets their season under way but they are a long way from what is expected of them.

Their last European game at Villa Park was a swashbuckling, dramatic and heroic 3-2 Champions League quarter-final second leg win over Paris St-Germain in April which pushed the eventual champions - who squeezed through 5-4 on aggregate - to the limit.

Fast forward to September and Villa are lacking confidence and conviction as they tackle Europe again.

Watkins' missed second-half penalty summed up the lack of belief at Villa Park against an average Bologna who nearly grabbed a point, but for Bizot's late save to deny Vitik.

They got the job done but did nothing to show they are out of their rut. A positive start gave way to

a stuttering display which better and more ruthless teams - in Europe and the Premier League - will punish.

It gives them something to build on before Sunday's visit of Fulham but

the loss of form of Morgan Rogers and Watkins - both so pivotal last season - is a growing concern.

Unai Emery has so often squeezed every drop out of this Villa side since he joined just under three

years ago but he needs to find some extra juice now.

The bar has been so high under Emery that there needs to be a drastic improvement to even get close to those previous heights.
