# Yom Kippur synagogue attack leaves two dead

■ **Police shoot attacker dead at the scene...Rabbi praised for heroic action in keeping worshippers safe**

**Two Jewish people have died in a car ramming and stabbing attack at a synagogue in Manchester.**

The attack came on Thursday on Yom Kippur, the holiest day in the Jewish religious calendar, and is being treated by police as a terror incident.

Police said they believe the attacker, who was shot dead at the scene, was Jihad Al-Shamie, 35, a British citizen of Syrian descent.

Three people remain in hospital with serious injuries.

The attack took place around 9.30am outside the Heaton Park Hebrew Congregation synagogue in Crumpsall.

## arrests

Two men were killed and three others injured when a car was driven at people outside the temple and before people were attacked with a knife.

Greater Manchester Police (GMP) said three people had been arrested – two men in their 30s and a woman in her 60s – as part of the investigation into what has been declared a “terrorist incident”.

A spokesman for GMP

said a suspicious device worn by the attacker during the incident was assessed and found not to be a viable explosive.

The spokesman added: “Based on what we currently know, our records do not show any previous Prevent referrals relating to this individual.”

Eyewitnesses described how security staff prevented the attacker from getting into the synagogue.

Video footage from the scene showed armed officers pointing their weapons at a man on the ground, shooting him as he tried to get up off the ground.

They warned crowds the man “had a bomb on him” and urged them to back away.

The officers, synagogue security and its rabbi, Daniel Walker, were commended by Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer from preventing a worse tragedy.

Speaking from Downing Street after a Cobra emergency committee meeting, Starmer condemned the “terrorist attack that attacked Jews

because they are Jews”.

Addressing the Jewish community in the UK, he said: “I promise you that I will do everything in my power to guarantee you the security that you deserve, starting with a more visible police presence, protecting your community.

“I promise you that over the coming days, you will see the other Britain, the Britain of compassion, of decency, of love.

## ‘true heroes’

“And I promise you that this Britain will come together to wrap our arms around your community and show you that Britain is a place where you and your family are safe, secure and belong.”

A witness at the scene said prayers had started when the attack happened but Rabbi Daniel Walker, who was leading the service, remained calm as he and others led the congregation to safety.

He added: “They are true heroes.”

A woman, who de-



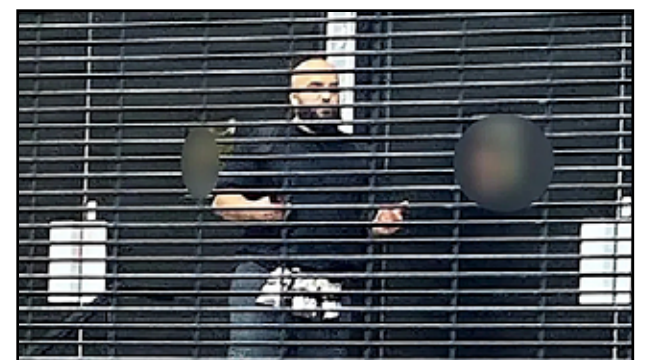

scribed herself as a religious Jew who lives next door to the synagogue, said as soon as the suspect got out of the car he “started stabbing anyone near him”.

She told the Daily Mail: “Rabbi Walker was incredibly calm, he shut the doors to the synagogue to stop him getting inside.

“He barricaded everyone inside. He is a hero, this could have been even worse.”

GMP chief constable Sir Stephen Watson praised security staff and worshippers who shut the attacker out, saying that thanks to the “immediate bravery of security staff and the worshippers inside, as well as the fast response of the police, the attacker was prevent-

ed from gaining access”.

On Thursday evening, a GMP spokesman said crime scenes remained in place on White House Avenue, Crumpsall and Langley Crescent, Prestwich, which were linked to the arrests made earlier.

“We can confirm that three suspects are currently in custody and have been arrested on

suspicion of commission, preparation and instigation of acts of terrorism,” the spokesman added.

They said the three injured men included one who had been stabbed, a second who was struck by the vehicle, and a third who later went to hospital with an injury “that may have been sustained as officers stopped the attacker”.

# Netanyahu condemns 'barbaric attack', blames UK 'weakness'

## ■ Israeli PM calls for strength and unity while Foreign Minister accuses UK of 'inaction' against antisemitism

Benjamin Netanyahu condemned the "barbaric attack" on a British synagogue on Thursday, saying that "weakness in the face of terrorism only brings more terrorism. Only strength and unity can defeat it."

The Israeli foreign minister, Gideon Sa'ar, accused the UK of failing to act against antisemitism in his response to the attack in Manchester, which killed two people.

Sa'ar said he was "appalled" by the murders, claiming that antisemitic incitement had become

"widespread" across Britain.

"The truth must be told: blatant and rampant antisemitic and anti-Israeli incitement, as well as calls of support for terror, have recently become a widespread phenomenon in the streets of London, in cities across Britain and on its campuses," Sa'ar said in a post on X on Thursday night.

### 'toxic wave'

He further accused British authorities of failing to take the necessary action to stop the "toxic

wave of antisemitism" and allowing it to persist.

"We expect more than words from the Starmer government. We expect and demand a change of course, effective action, and enforcement against the rampant antisemitic and anti-Israeli incitement in Britain," Sa'ar said.

Netanyahu released a statement saying that Israel was standing in solidarity with the British Jewish community.

"Israel grieves with the Jewish community in the UK after the barbaric ter-

ror attack in Manchester. Our hearts are with the families of the murdered, and we pray for the swift recovery of the wounded," Netanyahu said in

a statement released by the prime minister's office on Thursday.

Netanyahu had fiercely criticised the UK government when it rec-

ognised the Palestinian state earlier last month, alongside several other states such as Australia.

"As I warned at the UN: weakness in the face of terrorism only brings more terrorism," Netanyahu said on Thursday. "Only strength and unity can defeat it."

He accused Keir Starmer and other leaders who had recognised the Palestinian state as "giving a huge reward to terrorism". Starmer has said that recognition of a Palestinian state is a necessary step to a peaceful two-state solution and that Hamas would be excluded in any future Palestinian state.

# Top cop vows to purge the Met of racism

## ■ Rowley apologizes after explosive Panorama documentary reveals racism and sexism at Charing Cross police station

Britain's top police officer has vowed to purge the Met of the racism, misogyny or abuse of power exposed in an explosive BBC Panorama documentary which aired on Wednesday.

Commissioner Sir Mark Rowley apologised for what he called the "reprehensible and completely unacceptable" behaviour of some Charing Cross police station offi-

cers.

The Independent Office for Police Conduct is to launch an inquiry into nine serving officers, one former officer and a designated detention officer for potential gross misconduct. The nine still in the force have already been suspended.

One constable is under suspicion of perverting the course of justice.

Officers were secretly

filmed making sexualised comments and sharing racist views about immigrants and Muslims.

Panorama's Rory Bibb spent seven months up to January this year in a civilian role at the Charing Cross custody suite.

His footage showed PC Phil Neilson, while off duty, referring to an immigrant who had overstayed his visa. He

says: "Either put a bullet through his head or deport him. And the ones that sh\*g women, rape women, you do the c\*\*k and let them bleed out."

PC Martin Borg brags about a colleague stamping on a detainee's leg, and laughs about the suspect screaming.

He was filmed saying that Muslims "hate us", and that "Islam is a problem".

In a separate incident, Sergeant Joe McIlvenny turned conversations to sex while at work. Others were filmed bragging about breaking people's fingers, and one who repeatedly hit a detainee on the back of the legs with his baton.

A 17-year-old autistic

teenager was shown being restrained by up to eight officers for throwing a pillow, and then being held on the floor for two hours.

The entire Charing Cross custody team has been disbanded and redeployed.

Sir Mark said: "There is no place in policing for anyone who betrays the

values of integrity, fairness and respect."

Speaking out before the BBC programme was broadcast this week, he said: "It's my expectation that for those involved, where there is incontrovertible evidence ... will be put on a fast-track hearing within weeks and on a path to likely dismissal."

# World renowned primatologist Jane Goodall dead at 91

■ Veteran researcher was outspoken advocate of environmental issues and campaigned against the use of animals in medical research and zoos

The world-renowned primatologist Jane Goodall has died at the age of 91, her institute has said.

The Jane Goodall Institute announced that she had died of natural causes while in California as part of a US speaking tour.

"Dr Goodall's discoveries as an ethologist revolutionised science," the statement read. "She was a tireless advocate for the protection and restoration of our natural world."

Born in London in 1934, Goodall began researching free-living chimpanzees in Tanzania in 1960. In 1977 she founded the Jane Goodall Institute, which works to protect the species and supports youth projects aimed at benefiting animals and the environment.

## tributes

She was considered the leading expert on chimpanzees, her career spanning more than 60 years. Her research was pivotal in proving the similarities in primate and human behaviour.

The renowned conservationist was on stage in New York just last week, before appearing talking about her work on a Wall Street Journal podcast two days later.

She was due to appear at a speaking event reflecting on her long life and career in Los Angeles on 3 October, before another event in Washington DC the following week.

Tributes poured in from around the world

from conservation and animal rights charities, as the UN praised how she had "worked tirelessly for our planet and all its inhabitants, leaving an extraordinary legacy for humanity and nature".

Greenpeace UK's co-executive director, Will McCallum, said Goodall was "one of the true conservation giants of our time".

After developing a love of animals from an early age, Goodall visited a friend in Kenya in the late 1950s and began working for an archaeologist there, who sent her to study primate behaviour in London.

While still in her 20s, Goodall began researching chimpanzees at Gombe Stream national park in Tanzania. Her work observing their social behaviour helped challenge the idea that only humans could use tools and that chimps were vegetarian.

She went on to set up the Jane Goodall Institute to improve the understanding and treatment of primates, and to protect their natural habitats with the help of local people. It now has officers in more than 25 countries around the world.

## outspoken advocate

Goodall, who was awarded the title of Messenger of Peace by the UN in 2002, was an outspoken advocate of environmental issues and campaigned against the use of animals in medical research and zoos.

In 1991, the institute

launched the Roots and Shoots project to involve young people in conservation. The project started with a group of students working with Goodall but went on to create a network of active young people across nearly 100 countries.

Earlier this year, the institute's Hope Through Action project faced funding cuts from the US government under Donald Trump, after it had been pledged \$29.5m (£22m) over five years.

The initiative was designed to protect endangered chimpanzees and their habitats in western Tanzania through reforestation and "community-led methodology" to conserve biodiversity and improve local livelihoods.

Well into her 80s, Goodall showed little sign of slowing down as she continued to write and speak about her work. During the pandemic, she launched a podcast called Hope-cast in which she inter-

viewed other environmentalists and activists.

She was made a dame in 2004, and earlier this year received the Medal of Freedom, America's highest civilian honour, from the outgoing president, Joe Biden. In 2022, her legacy was marked in more unusual fashion in the form of a Jane Goodall Barbie doll, as part of the producer's series on inspiring women.

## 'obstinate'

In a 2023 interview with the Guardian, she spoke of the importance of focusing on making any kind of difference rather than trying to solve the world's problems.

"We have a window of time to change this planet's course, but it's rapidly closing," she said. "If governments do what they say they'll do, we still have a chance."

Looking back on her childhood, she remembered an early appetite for discovery, hiding inside a hen house for

hours to find out where eggs come from. "When I finally returned, Mum had called the police," she said. "I'd been missing for hours. Instead of punishing me, she listened intently to my discoveries."

Her mother was instrumental in pushing her to pursue her dreams, including volunteering on her daughter's first expedition because women were not allowed to travel solo.

In 2021, Goodall published *The Book of Hope*,

in which she admitted she sometimes felt she was fighting a losing battle, but explained how she kept going.

Speaking at the time, she said: "You have to feel depressed, but then there's something that says: 'There is still an awful lot left and that's what we've got to fight to save.'"

"So then you get extra energy. I have days when I feel like not getting up, but it doesn't last long. I guess because I'm obstinate."

GARY OLDMAN was knighted at Windsor Castle this week - with Prince William doing the honours 0 and revealing he's also a fan of the Oscar-winning actor. On Tuesday the

Prince of Wales held the investiture ceremony, where Oldman knelt before the royal and was officially knighted with a sword tap on his shoulders.

Oldman, 67, also revealed what they chatted about, sharing that William, 43, told the actor he's watching him on Apple TV's *Slow Horses*. The actor even recounted that the prince said when he sees Oldman on screen as his veteran MI5 agent character, "I just want to give you a good wash."

In reply, Oldman said, "Well, I think I've scrubbed up okay today."

The actor added that Prince William also "mentioned *The Fifth El-*

ement and *Churchill of Darkest Hour*," confirming the royal is a "fan."

## 'very emotional'

"He said he was very happy that I was here today and that it was him that had the opportunity to present me with [the honor]," Oldman said.

After being awarded the knighthood, Oldman called the experience "very emotional."

"I think I feel very honored, very humbled and flattered, I think in equal measure," he added. "It compares to nothing else. It's a singular event, that is what it is. I thought the Oscar was a big deal. No disrespect to the academy, but it sort of pales in comparison to this. It's just been

## Starmmer to end asylum 'golden ticket'

People granted asylum will no longer be given "the golden ticket" of resettlement and family reunion rights, Keir Starmer said on Thursday, as the embattled Prime Minister sought to regain the initiative from Reform UK

As the PM prepared to discuss illegal migration with European leaders, No 10 outlined plans to strip successful claimants of the right to automatically invite spouses and children to join them.

The right to permanently settle in the UK will be bestowed upon those who prove to be contributing to society, he said, "not by paying a people-smuggler to cross the Channel in a boat".

Under current rules, successful asylum seekers have the right to invite family members to join them and settle in the UK.

The new policies are meant to ensure that peo-

ple who have been granted asylum will receive less protection than they currently receive, a government source said.

"There are people who are 'asylum shopping' across the continent, looking for the country that offers them the most," the source said.

"We have been criticised in this country for being too generous - creating a pull factor. We will reduce the pull factors."

The policies are a riposte to Reform's plans announced last week to strip the status of indefinite leave to remain [ILR] from hundreds of thousands of non-EU citizens who already have it and to force them to reapply for visas under stricter criteria.

Starmer is under intense pressure from within his own party to fight back against the growing electoral threat of Nigel Farage's party.

In advance of the European Political Community (EPC) summit on Thursday, where leaders will discuss how to tackle illegal migration, Starmer said: "We're making fundamental changes to what those granted asylum are afforded in the UK.

"Settlement must be earned by contributing to our country, not by paying a people-smuggler to cross the Channel in a boat.

"The UK will continue to play its role in welcoming genuine refugees fleeing persecution. But we must also address the pull factors driving dangerous and illegal small-boat crossings. There will be no golden ticket to settling in the UK, people will have to earn it."

In September, the government suspended the family reunion route that allowed people with recognised refugee status or

humanitarian protection to sponsor close relatives to join them. The route, which admitted spouses or partners and dependent children under 18, granted 20,817 family reunion visas in the year ending June 2025.

Starmer's comments follow the announcement by the home secretary, Shabana Mahmood, on Monday that the government will impose new requirements on those seeking ILR to settle in the UK.

Mahmood said those seeking to settle permanently, most of whom come to the UK through regular routes, will face requirements of a higher standard of English, proof that they have contributed to society, and will be excluded if they have a criminal record.

Ministers will also examine whether to impose similar requirements upon those given asylum, sources said.

# JK Rowling rebukes “ignorant” Emma Watson

■ Harry Potter star had tried to offer an olive branch following their bust-up over Trans issue

**JK ROWLING** has rebuked “ignorant” Emma Watson after the Harry Potter star tried to offer an olive branch following their bust-up.

Ms Watson – Hermione Granger in the film franchise – said last week she still “loves and treasures” the author despite publicly berating her views on the trans movement.

But Ms Rowling left her 14 million online followers in no doubt she has not forgiven “former friend” Ms Watson, 35, nor her co-stars Daniel Radcliffe and Rupert Grint.

In a response of nearly 700 words, she wrote they “have every

right to embrace gender identity ideology”, adding: “Such beliefs are legally protected, and I wouldn’t want to see any of them threatened with loss of work or violence or death because of them. However, Emma and Dan in particular have both made it clear over the last few years that they think our former professional association gives them a particular right – nay, obligation – to critique me and my views in public.

“Years after they finished acting in Potter, they continue to assume the role of de facto spokespeople for the world I created. When you’ve known

people since they were 10 years old it’s hard to shake a certain protectiveness.

“Until quite recently, I hadn’t managed to throw off the memory of children who needed to be gently coaxed through their dialogue in a big scary film studio.”

She said she had “repeatedly declined” invitations to comment on Ms Watson in recent years, stressing she “didn’t want her to be hounded as the result of anything I said”. The “turning point” came after the actress declared at the 2022 Baftas “I’m here for all of the witches” in a none-too-subtle

criticism of her one-time mentor.

Ms Rowling said: “Emma asked someone to pass on a handwritten note from her to me, which contained the single sentence ‘I’m so sorry for what you’re going through’. This was back when the death, rape and torture threats against me were at their peak, at a time when my personal security measures had had to be tightened considerably and I was constantly worried for my family’s safety.

“Emma had just publicly poured more

petrol on the flames, yet thought a one-line expression of concern from her would reassure me of her fundamental sympathy and kindness. Like other people who’ve never experienced adult life uncushioned by wealth and fame, Emma has so little experience of real life she’s ignorant of how ignorant she is.

“She’ll never need a homeless shelter. She’s never going to be placed on a mixed sex public hospital ward. Has she had to strip off in a newly mixed-sex changing room at a council-run swim-

ming pool? I wasn’t a multi-millionaire at 14. I lived in poverty while writing the book that made Emma famous.

“I therefore understand from my own life experience what the trashing of women’s rights in which Emma has so enthusiastically participated means to women and girls without her privileges. Had Emma not decided in her most recent interview to declare that she loves and treasures me...I might never have been this honest.

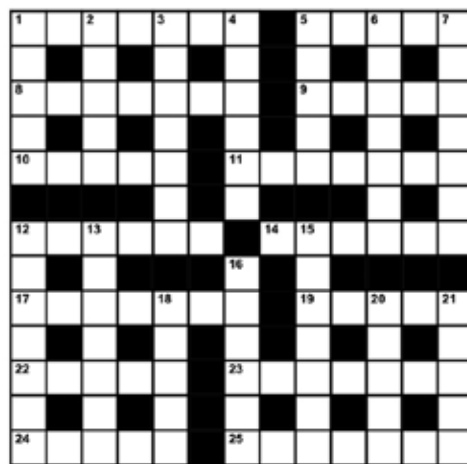
“Adults can’t expect to cosy up to an activist movement that regularly calls for a friend’s assassination, then assert their right to the former friend’s love, as though the friend was in fact their mother.”

Ms Rowling, 60, added: “Emma is rightly free to disagree with me and indeed to discuss her feelings about me in public. But I have the same right, and I’ve finally decided to exercise it.”

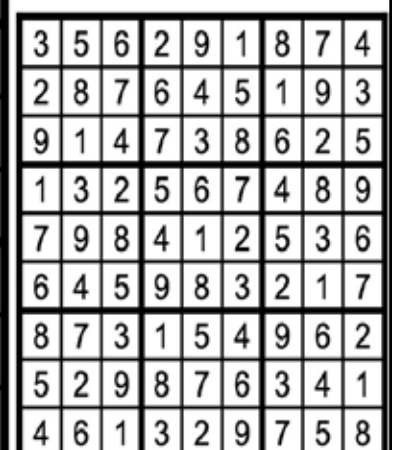

# Blue Lights Season Three: Belfast's finest are back on the beat

## ■ Gritty drama returns to Britbox next month

For many Britons of a certain vintage, autumn once meant cooler days, longer nights, and a cup of tea by the fire while something compelling flickered on the telly.

Times may have changed - our climate, our habits, our screens - but there remains a particular thrill when a new British drama lands on a streaming service. Last week saw the very welcome return of *Slow Horses*. Early next month, we can welcome back another standout: *Blue Lights*, available from BritBox or via Amazon Prime.

The Belfast-set police drama, now entering its third season, has been a revelation since its 2023 debut. Bracing, authentic and unsentimental, it shook up a genre that had drifted toward cosy village mysteries. *Blue Lights* instead planted itself firmly in reality. Belfast wasn't just scenery; it was integral to the story, a city still haunted by its past and uneasy

about its future.

When *Blue Lights* first appeared, it felt like a jolt. No action heroes in leather jackets, no glossy shootouts for the sake of spectacle. Instead, viewers met characters who looked and felt recognisable. The drama swapped cliché for clarity, showing policing as a grind of risk, bureaucracy and quiet endurance.

Central to its appeal has been the trio of rookies - Grace (Siân Brooke), Annie (Katherine Devlin) and Tommy (Nathan Braniff). They weren't flawless recruits nor tortured antiheroes, just ordinary people who had chosen an extraordinary line of work: policing a city where suspicion of authority still simmers. The cast's performances have been consistently vulnerable, drawing viewers into the characters' missteps as much as their small triumphs.

Season one introduced the rookies as they found their feet on Belfast's

streets. Each call-out carried the danger of violence, but the greater battle was often against fatigue, hesitation or the paperwork that dragged them down. The show's power lay in stripping back the gloss: policing here was messy, frustrating, and rarely glamorous.

Season two darkened the mood. With experience came heavier burdens. Local gangs flexed their muscle, political pressures added weight, and personal lives frayed under the strain. Friendships became lifelines, rivalries deepened, and trust was always fragile. The result was a taut, riveting second act that built on the show's original strengths while broadening its scope.

### What to expect

The new season builds on those foundations, with Grace, Annie and Tommy no longer wide-eyed rookies but hardened officers. That maturity brings its own

risks: disillusionment, fatigue, and the constant fear of being consumed by the job. Declan Lawn and Adam Patterson's scripts continue to balance the mundanity of routine police work with

larger, more explosive storylines, keeping the series firmly grounded.

This year also sees the supporting cast pushed further forward. Martin McCann's weary but

## Macca gets back to Beatle days with intimate Santa Barbara gig

**PAUL MCCARTNEY delivered an intimate one-off performance in Santa Barbara last Friday, in a modest kick-off for his more spectacle-driven 21-city North American Got Back tour.**

The show took place at the intimate, 4,500 seat Santa Barbara Bowl against the velvety backdrop of the Pacific Ocean. And the former Beatle's set selection showed he still had his bandmates on his mind 65 years after he first got together with John, George and Ringo.

McCartney (pictured, right) performed a moving rendition of "I've Got a Feeling" mid-show that featured archival footage of his late co-songwriter John Lennon singing the songs closing refrain on the large screen behind McCartney and he and his band played live - there was a collective sense of goosebumps in the audience during that moment. "I want to get to sing with John again,"

Paul said. Lennon died in 1980 at age 40 after he was shot and killed by a disturbed fan.

There was plenty of stardust sprinkled through an audience that included Neil Young, Bernie Taupin, Mark Hamill, Don Johnson, Rita Wilson and Olivia Harrison. McCartney, 83, kicked off his two-hour performance with a live version of the Beatles' early hit "Help!" marking the first time he has played the song live since 1990. And that was just the first of 18 Beatles classics that McCartney revisited during the show, along with a selection of additional hits from his time with Wings as well as recent solo works.

Looking fit and energetic playing an ever-changing selection of guitars, bass and mandolins as well sitting at the piano, McCartney later amused the crowd when he slipped off his black suitcoat and the lining was a blue sky filled with



fluffy white clouds. "That was the only wardrobe change of the whole evening," he cracked.

There were several very warm nods to his bandmates. "So now we're going to take you back in time, a long time ago," he said. "We're going to take you back to a little town - a city, actually - in the north of England called Liverpool. And in that city there were four young men who formed a group and did rather well."

He also paid tribute to the late legendary music producer George Martin, who was pivotal in shaping the Beatles' sound.

"Eventually, anyway, long story short we got a

record contract and went down to London, and we met and worked with the great George Martin. He was one of those men in your life you were really privileged to have met - he was a beautiful guy, smart, funny."

McCartney then launched into the band's first hit with Martin, "Love Me Do."

"That takes me back to our early days," he said after the song. "And when we first came over here, we couldn't hear our music for the girls screaming. Girls, can we hear you scream?" The women in the audience gave him frenzied screams. "Imagine trying to play through that!"

loyal Stevie and Joanne Crawford's sharp Helen take on greater prominence.

In an age where crime dramas often lean into either glossy escapism or familiar formula, Blue Lights has carved a space of its own. Its Belfast setting grounds it in history and politics, while its characters

remind us of the human cost of policing. These are not superheroes, but people who stumble, argue, and make mistakes, yet return each day to face the same pressures.

Two seasons in, Blue Lights has become one of the BBC's most compelling dramas precisely because it resists sentimentality. It shows policing as neither glamorous nor hopeless, but as a daily negotiation with risk, compromise and

conscience.

As season three arrives, the stakes are higher, the characters wearier, and the city no less volatile. If the series can maintain its delicate balance—gritty realism mixed with sharp storytelling—it will cement its place as one of the best dramas currently on British television.

PGA chief to apologize for Ryder Cup abuse

The abuse directed at Rory McIlroy and the rest of the European team at the Ryder Cup "crossed the line", says PGA of America chief executive Derek Sprague.

McIlroy was the main target of abuse at Bethpage as Europe held off a fierce comeback from the United States on Sunday to seal a 15-13 victory.

The abuse increased on day two of the tournament as Europe opened up a seven-point lead. While McIlroy was subjected to verbal abuse, his wife Erica was hit by a drink thrown by an American fan on the 17th tee.

"It's unfortunate that people crossed the line last week," Sprague told

the Golf Channel.

"There's no place for that at the Ryder Cup, no place for it in the game of golf and we are not happy with what happened last week."

McIlroy described the abuse as "unacceptable" and said it should be "off-limits".

Sprague says he plans on apologising to McIlroy and his family.

"I haven't spoken to Rory or Erica [McIlroy] but I do plan on sending them an email with my heartfelt apologies because of what occurred,"

he said.

McIlroy suffered lengthy abuse before eventually snapping by swearing at a spectator that called out while he was addressing the ball.

"I chirped back because it got to me a few times, but we tried to handle everything that came our way with class and poise, and for the most part, I felt like we did that," said McIlroy.

"It was a rough week for all of us. But at the same time, we certainly shut them up with our performance."

This was a stuttering performance from Forest - who lost Murillo to injury again - against a physical Midtjylland side who denied Postecoglou's men any momentum and rhythm.

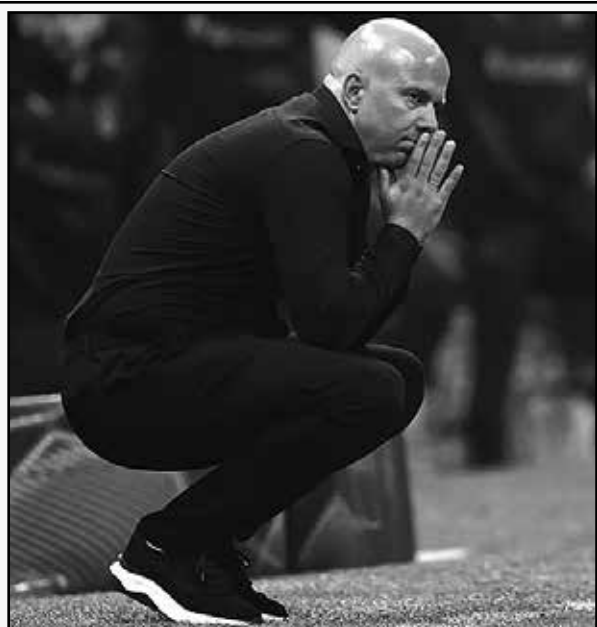
The energetic Elliot Anderson tried to drive Forest forward and Chris Wood had two goals disallowed.

Liverpool suffered their second successive defeat as Galatasaray inflicted a Champions League loss on a thunderous night in Istanbul on Tuesday.

Head coach Arne Slot left talisman Mohamed Salah on the bench after Liverpool lost at Crystal Palace, but the Premier League champions failed to fire amid a constant cacophony of noise at RAMS Park.

And, to add to Liverpool's misery, goalkeeper Alisson went off injured in the second half after pulling off a superb save from Galatasaray striker Victor Osimhen.

Osimhen gave Galatasaray the lead after 16 minutes when French referee Clement Turpin adjudged that Dominik Szoboszlai had fouled Baris Alper Yilmaz.

The goal came just 17 seconds after former Tottenham Hotspur defender Davinson Sanchez had cleared off the line from Cody Gakpo.

Slot introduced Salah and Alexander Isak just after the hour in an attempt to salvage something but it was to no avail.

Liverpool thought they would get the chance to rescue a point when referee Turpin pointed to the spot after Ibrahima Konate went

down, but the decision was overturned following a video assistant referee (VAR) review.

Liverpool once again failed to match the standards they set when strolling to the Premier League title last season as they went down to defeat in the cauldron that is this intimidating, deafening arena in Istanbul.

Slot's side were exposed at the back, with Alisson their saviour as Yilmaz was able to race clear on goal even before Galatasaray went ahead from the spot early on.

Liverpool currently have a soft underbelly that has been a feature of their season so far, with several of their expensive stars struggling to make an impact, despite the fact they still stand top of the Premier League.

It took a stoppage time goal from Virgil van Dijk to win their opening Champions League game against Atletico Madrid at Anfield and, while there is no cause for concern yet about their campaign, the simple truth is that performances must improve.

Slot's decision to leave Salah on the bench did not reap dividends, while £116m Florian Wirtz was once again anonymous.

## McGinn on the mark again as Villa continue to find their groove

John McGinn scored again as Aston Villa continued their winning run with an entertaining victory over Feyenoord in the Europa League on Thursday night.

Villa began their European campaign last week without a win in six games.

But three goals in three matches from their captain have helped them secure back-to-back wins in the Europa League either side of a first victory in the Premier League.

McGinn slotted home Villa's second in Rotterdam after the ball was nudged into his path when Donyell Malen sprinted into the area but was halted by three Feyenoord players.

Emiliano Buendia opened the scoring in the 61st minute with a curled finish after what had been an end-to-end first half filled with controversial decisions.

Unai Emery's side were aggrieved when Anel Ahmedhodzic brought down Ollie Watkins in the 13th minute with the striker bearing down on goal.

The Swedish defender was shown a yellow card for the challenge and referee Rade Obrenovic was advised to review the incident at the monitor to potentially upgrade to red.

However, the Slovenian official opted to stick with his original decision, despite Ahmedhodzic appearing to deny Watkins a clear goalscoring opportunity.

Villa may also have considered themselves lucky not to be 1-0 down when Ayase Ueda's first-half header clearly crossed the goal line, despite Marco Bizot's efforts to claw it away.

West Ham's "main priority" is bringing the club's fans and players closer together, says new manager Nuno Espirito Santo but he knows there is "a lot of work" to do.

After recent protests, chants of "sack the board" could be heard during Monday's 1-1 draw at Everton, Nuno's first game in charge of the Hammers after replacing Graham Potter.

But, after Jarrod Bowen's second-half equaliser had earned them a spirited point, the former Tottenham and Nottingham Forest boss took his players over to the travelling supporters at the end

of the match in a show of unity and togetherness.

"What I think is important is to appreciate what our fans did traveling to Liverpool on a Monday night and giving the support they've given," he said. "It's our main priority to come closer to our fans.

"We have to deliver so they can appreciate the work of the boys. Moving forward it's important."

After beginning his tenure with a point on the road, Nuno said his players will "embrace the challenge".

"I think the team competed well," the Portuguese manager said. "It's

a tough, tough place to come, a very good team.

"Overall it was a good game, intense, both teams had chances. The message for us [to the players] is how we can compete now."

Nuno said he has avoided making too many changes to West Ham's tactics and is instead focusing on making incremental improvements.

"Simple, don't change too many things," he responded when asked about his approach. "When you arrive at a club it's about slowly progressing and trying to find the right options and solutions."

# Palace in royal form!

■ **Europa Conference League: Glasner's men extend winning run to 19 matches with savvy victory over Dynamo Kiev**

Crystal Palace continued their impressive start to the season with a new club record as they opened their Conference League campaign with a comfortable victory against Dynamo Kyiv in Poland on Thursday.

Daniel Muñoz's looping header from Yeremy Pino's back-post cross put them on their way to success in their first ever game in the main phase of a European competition.

Substitute Eddie Nketiah doubled Palace's advantage just before the hour mark with a sharp close-range finish after a wonderful bit of skill and incisive delivery from Pino on the left.

That sent around 3,500 travelling supporters into raptures and not even the dismissal of Croatian full-back Borna Sosa - for two yellow cards carelessly collected in a three-minute period - in the 76th

minute could spoil their party.

By full-time they were not only celebrating a historic first away win in Europe, but breaking a club mark, set back in 1969, by extending their unbeaten run to 19 matches across all competitions.

It was no more than Oliver Glasner's side deserved against opponents who, in recent times, have struggled to live up to their rich European pedigree of previous decades.

Nketiah might have had two had he not just strayed offside to collect Adam Wharton's pass, just moments before his effort that did count. Dai-ichi Kamada's first-half run also deserved more than a tame finish that ended with an easy save for Kiev keeper Ruslan Neshchet.

The only disappointment was Sosa's red card, picking up quick bookings for a late challenge

on Shola Ogundana and then needlessly barging over Oleksandr Tymchyk.

Just a year ago Crystal Palace were 18th in the Premier League and worryingly without a win.

Now they are FA Cup winners and on the longest stretch of games without defeat in their 120-year history.

They sit third in the top flight with the only unbeaten record - three wins and three draws - having ended leaders Liverpool's 100% start.

Palace last lost a match on 16 April when they were thrashed 5-0 at Newcastle.

But they have not looked back since then, with perhaps a measure of how far they have come highlighted on Thursday, when Dynamo Kyiv - a club steeped in European history - deployed a system and tactics specifically geared to try to nullify

Palace's threat.

"They are so hungry to succeed, and so ambitious, and of course we want to keep them pushing, and it is really easy to keep the focus high," said

Glasner.

"We have huge respect for Dynamo Kyiv, so playing away, starting with a win with three points in the Conference League, is very positive.

"Every single competition is the same, it is as important as the other one, and this is how we want to continue, game by game, and doing the best every single game."
