■ Emotional Harry tells of Meghan's 'misery' as he fights for privacy

AN EMOTIONAL Prince Harry claimed tabloid intrusion had made his wife's life 'an absolute misery' as he pressed his case in London's High Court against Associated Newspapers this week.

It was a landmark occasion for the Duke of Sussex, who returned to his home soil not for a royal engagement, but for a high-stakes legal battle that could redefine his relationship with the British media forever.

Harry has taken center stage in a massive privacy claim against Associated Newspapers (ANL). But while the legal arguments are complex, the emotion behind them has been impossible to ignore.

On Wednesday, the Duke took the witness stand for over two hours, delivering a performance that was as much a personal venting of grievances as it is a legal testimony. Observers noted that Harry appeared "visibly affected" at several points, particularly when discussing the impact of press scrutiny on his family life.

'breaking point'

In a detailed 23-page witness statement, the Duke claimed that the constant "intrusion" into his private life had made his wife Meghan's experience in the UK an "absolute misery." He

spoke candidly about the "paranoia" he felt during his younger years, alleging that the use of private investigators and sophisticated surveillance left him unable to trust even his closest friends.

"I felt I was being pushed toward a breaking point," he told the court, arguing that his privacy was "sold for the sake of a headline."

The Prince wasn't the only star in the courtroom this week. In a move designed to show a "united front," Harry returned to the High Court Thursday morning to support his fellow claimant, Elizabeth Hurley.

bugging homes

The actress and model sat near the Duke as the court heard further allegations of phone-hacking and blagging - the act of impersonating individuals or using deception to obtain highly sensitive information such as medical records, flight details, and itemized phone bills.

ANL also stands accused of bugging homes and cars...in one of the

week's most shocking claims, Elizabeth Hurley claimed private investigators placed microphones on windowsills and secret listening devices inside private vehicles, a claim heavily substantiated by the testimony of several private investigators who claim they were on the ANL payroll for decades.

Harry and Hurley two are part of a high-profile group - including Sir Elton John and Sadie Frost - who have joined forces to take on the publisher. By staying in the court to listen to Hurley's evidence, Harry sent a clear message: he is in this for the long haul, and he isn't fighting alone.

The lawsuit doesn't just focus on celebrities. Perhaps the most incendiary allegation involves Baroness Doreen Lawrence, mother of the murdered teenager Stephen Lawrence. The claimants allege that a Daily Mail journalist instructed an investigator to obtain information from her by falsely claiming to be a reporter from The Guardian.

Baroness Lawrence has stated she feels "profoundly betrayed" by a newspaper that previously championed her campaign for justice.

In his 23-page witness statement, Prince Harry argued that the impact of these alleged acts was not just a breach of privacy, but a total destruction of trust. He claimed the "obsessive" surveillance drove him to become "paranoid beyond belief" and caused him to become isolated from his social circle, as he wrongly suspected close friends and bodyguards of "leaking" stories.

security win

ANL has labeled these claims "preposterous" and "lurid smears." Their legal defense rests on two main pillars; that

they were engaged in legitimate reporting from which the 14 articles in question were sourced through standard journalistic practices, such as "leaky" friends in Harry's social circle, official press releases, and royal correspondents attending public events.

While the privacy trial continues, Harry has reportedly secured a major victory behind the scenes. After years of legal wrangling over his police protection, sources suggest the Home Office has finally reached a "new arrangement" regarding his safety.

Following a fresh risk assessment, it is understood that the Duke will be granted taxpayer-funded security while visiting the UK. This is a significant develop-

ment for Harry, who has previously cited a lack of protection as the primary reason he has been reluctant to bring Archie and Lilibet back to Britain. With this "ring of steel" back in place, rumors of a family reunion this summer are already starting to swirl.

Despite these developments, the War of the Waleses is far from over. This trial is expected to last for nine weeks, with legal costs already projected to exceed £38 million.

For Harry, this isn't just about the money; it's about a personal crusade for "accountability." Whether the judge agrees with his version of events remains to be seen, but one thing is certain: the Duke of Sussex is no longer staying silent.

News from Britain

KEIR'S COLD FRONT: PM vows "I will not yield" to Trump's Greenland grab

Sir Keir Starmer has finally found his backbone, telling Donald Trump in no uncertain terms that the UK won't be bullied into a frozen surrender.

In a high-stakes week that saw the Prime Minister ditch his usual lawyerly caution, the Not-So-Special Relationship hit a sub-zero patch over the future of a giant piece of ice and a 10% tax on our favorite British exports.

After days of the White House threatening to "punish" Britain with massive tariffs unless we backed their bid to buy Greenland, Sir Keir delivered his most defiant performance yet. Standing at the dispatch box during a fiery Prime Minister's Questions, a steely-eyed Starmer accused the President of trying to "extort" the British people.

rambling speech

The row exploded when President Trump, fresh from a rambling Davos speech where he claimed he had done more for NATO than any leader in history, took aim at Britain's recent Chagos Islands deal. The President branded the re-

turn of the islands "great stupidity" and linked it directly to his quest for Greenland, suggesting that if Britain could "give away" islands in the Indian Ocean, they should have no problem letting him "buy" one in the Arctic.

But the PM wasn't having it. Starmer accused Trump of a cynical U-turn, claiming the President had previously praised the Chagos deal in private only to weaponize it in public for his own "expansionist" ends.

"I will not yield," Sir Keir told a packed Commons, his voice rising above the Tory jeers. "Britain will not yield on our principles and our values under the threat of tariffs. The future of Greenland is for the people of Greenland and the Kingdom of Denmark alone. It is not a pawn on a billionaire's chessboard."

tariff terror

The threat was very real for British families. Trump had vowed to slap a 10% "Greenland Tax" on everything from Scotch whisky and cashmere sweaters to Jaguar

Land Rovers, set to kick in on February 1st. He even threatened to hike that to a staggering 25% by June if the UK didn't fall in line.

Trump's logic? He claimed Britain and our European allies were playing a "dangerous game" by sending "reconnaissance troops" to the Arctic island. The reality was a bit less James Bond - the UK had sent exactly one military officer at the request of the Danish government to assist with a search-and-rescue exercise. But for the man in the White House, it was enough to spark a transatlantic trade war.

chilly truce

By Thursday morning, however, the frost seemed to be thawing - though the underlying chill remains. Following a frantic, one-on-one "peace summit" in Davos with NATO chief Mark Rutte, Trump suddenly took to Truth Social to announce a "framework deal" for the Arctic.

The President - who spent much of the week confusing Greenland with its neighbor Iceland - dropped the tariff threat



Greenland "is not a pawn on a billionaire's chessboard," said Starmer this week

and vowed he would not 'use force' to acquire the territory, but later insisted he wanted negotiations for its purchase to begin immediately, warning that if Nato agreed to a sale, he would remain 'eternally grateful' and if not, that he 'would remember'

Speaking from Number 10, Sir Keir welcomed the "shift," but warned that the "hard yards" of

Arctic security are only just beginning. "Alliances endure because they are built on respect and partnership, not pressure," he added pointedly.

While the immediate threat of a trade war has vanished like a spring snowfall, the damage to the "Special Relationship" may be harder to repair. With MPs in the Commons already calling for a boycott of this summer's

World Cup and even suggesting the King cancel his planned state visit to the US, the honeymoon period between Starmer and the second Trump administration is officially over.

Sir Keir might have kept his cool this week, but with Trump's "Golden Dome" now looming over the Arctic, the geopolitical weather forecast looks increasingly stormy.

Farage has Thatcher's 'bulldog spirit' claims Reform's latest Tory recruit

NIGEL Farage has the same "bulldog spirit" as Margaret Thatcher, new Reform UK MP Andrew Rosindell has said.

He became the second top Tory to jump ship in a week, after Robert Jenrick defected last Thursday.

Mr Rosindell said he was persuaded to resign as a shadow foreign office minister on Kemi Badenoch's front bench because of the "failure" of the Conservative Party to hold Labour to account on its decision to hand the Chagos Islands to Mauritius.

He also took a swipe at his former boss, saying his decision to quit the party was made easier by

Mrs Badenoch "throwing Rob under the bus" after she uncovered his plot to defect to Reform. And he added that her remarks - describing the two MPs' departures as "spring cleaning" - showed an

"ugly side".

Mr Rosindell, who has been a Conservative MP for Romford since 2001 and a party member for 45 years, said: "What really did it was sitting in

the chamber and hearing that Robert Jenrick had been expelled from the Conservative Party. I was devastated.

"Kemi should have had him in, personally spoken to him, if she'd found that document [memo on Jenrick's planned defection]. Surely Robert was worth saving.

"quite ugly"

"So if he isn't worth saving, and he's going to be thrown under a bus, I'm thinking someone like me could easily be thrown under a bus too."

Expressing bitterness towards remarks on his departure, he added: "I think that what they show is a side which I think is quite ugly.

"If I was her, I'd be sorrowful for losing two of her hardest working and strongest Conservative MPs."

The Brexiteer joked that his political views meant that he was "Reform before there was Reform".

And he said that he only really made up his mind to defect after speaking on the phone to his new party's leader Mr Farage on Saturday and Sunday. The lifelong admirer of Mrs Thatcher said he believed Mr Farage has similar traits to the former Conservative Prime Minister.

"He has the bulldog spirit like she did," Mr Rosindell said.

"She would never weaken against any attack on Britain or British interests. So I think he has the makings of being a truly great Prime Minister.

"And I think if Margaret Thatcher was here today, she'd be admiring him for what he's saying and doing, and she'd certainly agree with his politics, because his political views are very close to everything she stood up for."

'Humiliated' Brooklyn Beckham goes no contact with his family

■ Eldest son of David and Victoria takes to Instagram to accuse his parents of "trying endlessly" to ruin his relationship with Nicola

In the glossy, high-stakes world of the Beckham dynasty, the veneer has finally cracked, revealing a rift as deep as the Atlantic that separates Brooklyn Peltz-Beckham from his iconic parents.

While rumors of a cold war have simmered since his 2022 wedding to billionaire heiress Nicola Peltz, this week marks the moment the eldest Beckham son went "nuclear," effectively issuing a public declaration of independence.

On Monday Brooklyn, 26, took to Instagram to share a staggering six-page statement in which he accused David and Victoria of "trying endlessly" to ruin his relationship with Nicola.

The most shocking revelation involved a dispute over his very identity. Brooklyn alleged that weeks before his wedding, his parents pressured- and even attempted to bribe - him into signing away the legal rights to his name. He claimed his refusal to sign led to a financial "holdout" and that his parents "have never treated him the same since."

'Humiliation'


Brooklyn's statement peeled back the curtain on the "fairytale" wedding in Palm Beach, painting it instead as a battlefield of passive-aggression. He detailed several grievances that have now become the center of a global media firestorm:

The Dress: Brooklyn confirmed the long-rumored story that Victoria cancelled making Nicola's wedding dress at the "eleventh hour," forcing the bride to scramble for a Valentino replacement.

He claimed Victoria called him "evil" during planning because he and Nicola chose to seat their respective grandmothers at the head table.

But in perhaps the most personal blow, Brooklyn described feeling "humiliated" when Victoria allegedly hijacked the first dance. A wedding guest this week corroborated the claim, describing Victoria's behavior as "inappropriate" and noting that Nicola was seen running from the room in tears.

The elder Beckhams have largely maintained their signature "never complain, never explain"

stance, but the silence is beginning to fray. On Tuesday, January 20, David Beckham appeared on CNBC's Squawk Box. While he didn't address the specific allegations of bribery, he pointedly re-

marked that social media is a double-edged sword and noted that his kids have "made mistakes."

Meanwhile, younger brother Cruz Beckham appeared to pick a side. Shortly after Brooklyn's

post, Cruz shared a family photo with the caption, "I love my family... you gave us life and cared for us no matter what," a move widely interpreted as a public rebuke of his older brother's "betrayal."

...while Eugenie does the same to Andrew

In the rigid hierarchy of the British Royal Family, silence is usually the sharpest weapon. But this week, the silence radiating from Princess Eugenie toward her father, the disgraced Andrew Mountbatten-Windsor, has become deafening.

In a week when the world of celebrity gossip was captivated by Brook-

lyn Beckham's public "Bexit" from his parents, royal insiders confirmed on Sunday that Princess Eugenie has initiated her own total severance.

After years of navigating the fallout of her father's association with Jeffrey Epstein, the 35-year-old princess has reportedly moved to a "no contact" status that marks the most signifi-

cant internal rupture the House of Windsor has seen in decades.

Betrayal

The catalyst for this week's definitive break was a fresh wave of leaked communications - uncovered in the latest "Epstein Files" released just before the new year - and Andrew's continued, defiant refusal to issue

a formal apology to the victims of sex trafficking. For Eugenie, this wasn't just a matter of family reputation; it was a di-

rect conflict with her life's work.

tive, Eugenie has spent years campaigning against the very crimes her father's associates committed. Sources close to the Princess suggest that the recent revelations were the final straw. "She can no longer reconcile her public mission with her private association," one friend noted. "The cognitive dissonance became a cage she had to break out of."

Christmas Snub

The breakdown has been building since the holidays. While the royal family gathered at Sandringham for Christmas, Andrew was conspicuously absent, reportedly urged by King Charles to remain in London.

Tellingly, Eugenie and her husband, Jack Brooksbank, chose to spend the day with the King and Prince William rather than visiting her father at Royal Lodge.

The tension reached a fever pitch during the christening of Princess Beatrice's 11-month-old daughter, Athena, in London. While the family attempted a unified front for the ceremony, the aftermath told a different story.

While Andrew attended the service, he was notably excluded from the post-christening gathering at a local pub. Witnesses described Eugenie as "entirely focused on her children," refusing to acknowledge her father even when they were in the same room.

For years, the York girls were raised to believe that any criticism of their parents was a "conspiracy." This week, the youngest daughter finally looked at the facts and chose the victims over the "Tiger Dad" she once defended.

Do not free my son's killer!

■ Jamie Bulger's mom warns Jon Venables will kill again if released

CHILD murderer Jon Venables will kill again if he is let out of prison, James Bulger's heartbroken mum has warned.

Venables is set to face another Parole Board hearing, opening up the possibility he could be freed for a third time.

Denise Fergus, mother of murdered two-year-old James, said she faces a daily "nightmare" of not knowing her son's killers' new identities, which are protected by law.

And she wants anyone who breaches parole twice to be barred from being released.

Ms Fergus told Good Morning Britain: "I'm hoping they don't release him."

"I'm hoping and praying they take into consideration everything

he's done. Murdering James and whatever he's done after that.

"I'm hoping they realise that he is still a high risk to other kids. And I hope he never sees the light of day again.

"Because I know if he gets out – and I've said this time and time again – we will end up with another case like James."

'living in fear'

Venables, now 43, abducted, tortured and murdered James alongside Robert Thompson in Merseyside in 1993, when he was 10. He will have his parole case heard more than two years after his previous appeal.

Venables was released on licence in July 2001 but was recalled to prison in 2010 after indecent images of children were

found on his computer.

He was freed again, but jailed for a third time for possessing child porn.

Ms Fergus said she lives in fear over her son's killers' identities.

She added: "They probably know how many kids I've got. They

probably know their ages, their names. How do I not know that – especially Thompson because he's out – how do I not know that he has been standing next to one of my kids, my sons?"

She is struggling to get the Ministry of Justice to

fight her case. She told GMB:

"Over the years I've met so many justice secretaries. Every time I feel like I'm getting somewhere, they change jobs or they have to step down. We're left having to start from the very bottom."

First military site opens for asylum seekers

The first asylum seekers have been moved into a former military site in East Sussex, the Home Office has confirmed.

Twenty-seven men seeking asylum arrived at the Crowborough training camp on Wednesday, which will eventually be scaled up to house more than 500 migrants.

The government said the move was part of its "mission to end the use of expensive hotels", with Home Secretary Shabana Mahmood saying "Crowborough is just the start".

There have been frequent protests against the plans, which were first announced last year but had been put on hold.

The government said moving to large sites like Crowborough was an important part of its "reforms

to tackle illegal migration and the pull factors that make the UK an attractive destination".

Mahmood said: "I will bring forward site after site until every asylum hotel is closed and returned to local communities."

More than 400 hotels were opened under the last government at a cost of £9m a day, according to the Home Office.

Now just under 200 remain in use, with overall asylum costs down 15%, a Home Office spokesperson said.

Mahmood said she would defend "vigorously" any legal challenges to moving asylum seekers into sites like Crowborough.

She said she "understood the strength of local feeling", and their con-

cerns.

"We will get out of every asylum hotel in this country, and military sites are part of that solution," she said.

"So we will be making this move, not just in Crowborough, but in other parts of the country as well."

Wealden District Council leader James Partridge said housing asylum seekers at Crowborough was

the wrong decision.

But he added: "We do need to make the best of it."

Partridge called on the community to come together "in the way we did when the Afghan families and Ukrainian refugees arrived".

Rachel Millward, the deputy leader of Wealden District Council, said the Home Office had not engaged with the communi-

ty or properly detailed the plans.

"That means the alarm, fear and possibility of misinformation has just gone up and up," she told local radio.

In the early hours of Thursday, there was a heavy police presence at the camp.

Footage appeared to show a minibus entering the site at about 03:00 GMT.

Dave's Great Escape: The bird who flew the coop and found a following

A peacock that ran away to a new village and evaded capture for several weeks has become an unlikely social media star.

Dave the peacock left his home in Claybrooke Magna, Leicestershire, early in December and an appeal to help find him led to a number of sightings four miles away in Broughton Astley.

While he was on the run, Dave endeared himself to people in Broughton Astley, who set up a dedicated Facebook group, The Dave Diary, and a TikTok account, called Only Dave's Fans, which chronicled his adventures and various

sightings.

Owner Alex Robinson finally recaptured Dave on Tuesday - but said he had "clearly" been kept well-fed while he was at large in the neighbouring village.

Dave is part of a family of four peacocks owned by Robinson - although only one called Glenda was at home when he returned.

The other two, Kenneth and Margaret, also ran away and are currently somewhere in the countryside in the village of Leire, which is nearer their home than Broughton Astley.

Robinson and her partner Kyle Dewis bought the birds from

livestock markets in Melton Mowbray and Thrapston about four years ago, when the peacocks and peahens cost about £200 each.

She said all four birds had been "homebodies" and had not roamed further afield until recently.

Robinson said: "We do have an aviary which we do keep them in most of the time, but we like to have them free range."

"Dave and his clan have been quite happy and stayed where they should be, but for the past couple of months they've been going off and coming back - and Dave has taken it a little bit too far this time."

While attempts were

Your insults boost sales, RyanAir boss tells Elon Musk

Michael O'Leary says Elon Musk can insult him "every day" if it keeps boosting Ryanair's sales.

The budget airline's chief executive had rowed with the tech billionaire over whether Musk's Starlink system could add wifi to Ryanair flights.

After O'Leary said it was not feasible, Musk called him a "chimp" and asked his X followers if he should buy the Dublin-based firm.

O'Leary, 64, said this week: "If he wants to call me an idiot, he wouldn't be the first and he certainly won't be the last. But if it helps to boost Ryanair sales, you could insult me all day, every day."


He claimed the "spat" had driven a 2% to 3% rise in Ryanair ticket sales in just five days, adding: "I welcome the accusation that I'm a chimp...it's somewhat unfair on the chimp community."

"But he's back safe,


and looks really well.

Brutal, bloody and brilliant

TV: Season Two of *A Thousand Blows* is a knockout

If you thought the first series of *A Thousand Blows* was a bruising affair, then strap on your gumshields and prepare for a real pummelling.

Steven Knight's Victorian pugilist epic has returned to our screens on Disney+ (or Hulu in our house) with a second season that is darker, grittier, and - dare I say it - even more unmissable than the first.

While most period dramas are content with tea sets and hushed conversations in drawing rooms, Knight (the mastermind behind *Peaky Blinders*) prefers the smell of stale ale, the sound of crunching bone, and the sight of London's East End looking like a soot-stained circle of hell. And thank goodness for that.

We pick up a year after the explosive events of the first series, and let's just say our "heroes" haven't spent that time holidaying in Brighton.

Stephen Graham, that pint-sized powerhouse of British acting, returns as

Henry "Sugar" Goodson. When we find him, he's a shadow of the man who once ruled the Wapping docks. Estranged from his family and pickled in gin, Sugar is a cautionary tale of what happens when a hard man loses his edge. Graham is, as ever, magnificent. He plays Sugar like a wounded bulldog - dangerous, unpredictable, yet somehow heartbreakingly vulnerable. Watching him battle his demons (and the occasional street thug) is worth the subscription fee alone.

But while Graham is the heavy hitter, it's Erin Doherty as Mary Carr who truly steals the show. The former *Crown* star has traded Princess Anne's twinsets for the sharp-tongued leadership of the Forty Elephants, London's notorious all-female gang.

Ousted from her throne in the series one finale, Mary is back with a vengeance. Her plan to reclaim her crown involves a daring heist of a priceless Caravaggio painting

that would make Ocean's Eleven look like a Sunday school picnic. Doherty brings a frantic, magnetic energy to the role; she is "tough-as-boots" and twice as sharp. Whether she's outsmarting aristocrats or brandishing a pistol to cover a getaway, she is the beating heart of this murky underworld.

Then there is Malachi Kirby as Hezekiah Moscow. After inadvertently killing a man in the ring, Hezekiah has been reduced to fighting on offshore barges to dodge the law. Kirby's performance is a masterclass in quiet intensity. He isn't just fighting for titles anymore; he's fighting for his soul in a city that treats him like a pariah. His journey this season, from the depths of despair to an unlikely alliance with the Royal Family (yes, really!), provides the show with its moral compass.

The plot is a tangled web of revenge, redemption, and cold-blooded betrayal. This season's villain, the oily Murtagh, is a man you'll love to hate, pulling strings from the shadows and framing Sugar's brother, Treacle, for a crime he didn't com-

mit. It all culminates in a finale that features a boxing match, a high-stakes heist, and enough dynamite to level half of Wapping.

Is it perfect? Not quite.

At times, the "Cockney-isms" are laid on a bit thick - you half expect someone to break into a chorus of *Maybe It's Because I'm a Londoner*. And yes, some of the co-

incidences are as convenient as a black cab on a rainy night. But when the drama is this high-octane, who cares?

Verdict: A heavyweight champion of a drama.

Sinners duo ensure Brits not shut out from Oscar noms

Wunmi Mosaku and Delroy Lindo will be flying the flag for the usually well-performing Brits at this year's Academy Awards.

The *Sinners* stars are the only U.K. natives to land acting Oscar nominations on Thursday, unveiled by Danielle Brooks and Lewis Pullman from the Academy's Samuel Goldwyn Theater. Notably, Emily Blunt (*The Smashing Machine*) and Cynthia Erivo (*Wicked: For Good*) did not score nods.

Thanks to Mosaku and Lindo, the U.K. is somewhat covered at the 98th Academy Awards -

though it's been a decidedly weaker year for British talent. Had the duo not earned nods, it would have been the first time in 40 years that Britons failed to earn an acting Oscar nomination. This last occurred in 1986.

Nigerian-British actress Mosaku is recognized in the supporting actress category for her role as powerful Hoodoo priestess Annie in Ryan Coogler's vampire horror, which scored the most Oscar nominations ever. Her character is also the love interest of Michael B. Jordan, who earned an acting nomination for his performance

as the *Smokestack* twins.

It is Mosaku's first Academy Award nod, but might not come as a surprise after her *Sinners* win at the Gotham Independent Film Awards, as well as nominations at the Critics' Choice Awards and Actors Awards.

On the other hand, Lindo's supporting actor nomination might be deemed a little unexpected given the tough competition he's faced through awards season so far, such as Paul Mescal for *Hamnet*, Miles Catton for *Sinners*, or Adam Sandler for *Jay Kelly*.

West Ham on Saturday. But there was a different atmosphere at the Tottenham Hotspur Stadium on Tuesday night as Spurs attacked with pace and purpose, and first-half goals from Cristian Romero and Dominic Solanke saw off Dortmund.

He played a neat one-two with Pedro Porro before sending a low ball into the box, which bounced off Solanke's heel and on to his other foot to deflect into the net.

Tottenham had nowhere near that level of intensity in the second half, though should have added a third when Randal Kolo Muani raced through but fired straight at goalkeeper Gregor Kobel.

Guglielmo Vicario then tipped over Nico Schlotterbeck's header in stoppage time to ensure it was not a nervous end to the game for the home fans.

There is no doubt this was a result Frank badly needed - in fact a win might not have been significant enough if the performance was not there.

Emery dreaming of more European glory with Villa

Aston Villa manager Unai Emery may not believe his team are Premier League title contenders - but he is "dreaming" of Europa League glory after reaching the last 16.

Villa defeated Fenerbahce 1-0 in Turkey Thursday night to ensure a top-eight league-phase finish with a game to spare.

On Sunday, the Spaniard warned Villa are 'not top five contenders' after they lost 1-0 at home to Everton.

Should Villa finish outside the Premier League's

top four - or top five if England is awarded an extra qualifying berth - their only hope of Champions League football next season will be through winning the Europa League.

Former Seville, Arsenal and Paris St-Germain boss Emery has won the Europa League a record four times as manager, last doing so with Villarreal in 2021, and was managing his 100th game in the competition on Thursday.

He told the media "we have clear objectives in this competition to be a

contender for a trophy" after his side's victory in Istanbul.

"[We want] To be a contender in case we need this trophy to play in the Champions League. Through our league [it] is very difficult," he added.

"I am dreaming to be here getting trophies and the Europa is one objective we have this year."

Despite being the seventh-most successful club in English football by trophies won, Villa's last piece of major silverware was the League Cup in 1996.

Champions League: Reds find their form to demolish Marseille

Liverpool coasted past Marseille on Wednesday night to put themselves in a strong position to finish in the Champions League top eight on a night where Mohamed Salah returned to the starting XI for Arne Slot's side.

A moment of genius from Dominik Szoboszlai gave Liverpool the lead in the first half, an own goal from goalkeeper Geronimo Rulli doubled their advantage and Cody Gakpo added a third in the 92nd minute.

The three points took Liverpool up to fourth in

the Champions League standings and they host Qarabag at Anfield next week as they look to remain in the top eight, thereby avoiding the play-offs.

After a strong opening for the Reds, it was Szoboszlai who broke the deadlock in first-half injury-time as he smartly rolled a free-kick under the Marseille wall and beat Rulli.

In the 72nd minute Jeremie Frimpong used his pace effectively to get to the byeline and his cutback took a deflection before nicking off Rulli and dribbling in.

Gakpo came off the bench to score with the last kick of the game, curling a low effort into the far corner.

With Ibrahima Konate out because of a family matter Joe Gomez started at centre-back alongside Virgil van Dijk, who made his 350th appearance for the club.

Marseille rarely threatened in the first half but Roberto De Zerbi's side raced out of the blocks after the break, with Alisson denying Mason Greenwood before the Englishman teed up Hamed Traore, who skyed over when

he should have tested the goalkeeper.

But Liverpool impressively kept out the most prolific side in Ligue 1 and extended their unbeaten run to 13 games with a solid European away performance.

Pre-match, De Zerbi had called on his Marseille players to "honour" the Stade Velodrome and the stadium was packed to the rafters well before kick-off.

The Marseille fans unveiled an eye-catching Beatles tifo before the game which read "Que l'histoire repete", translating to "History repeats itself".

That was in reference to the time these two sides met here in 2004, when Didier Drog-

ba scored as Marseille knocked Liverpool out of the Uefa Cup.

A different kind of history repeated itself though as Liverpool won in Marseille in the Champions League, just like they did in 2007 and 2008.

Inter Milan 1-3 Arsenal
Gabriel Jesus scored twice as Arsenal won at Inter Milan to maintain their 100% record in the league phase of the competition.

The Gunners were all but certain of a top-eight finish coming into this match and set their longest ever winning streak in the competition with

an impressive seventh success.

They had Inter pinned back from the beginning before Jesus' poked finish from close range put them ahead in the 10th minute.

Inter built up their own period of pressure after going behind and Petar Susic levelled when he bent a powerful strike past David Raya from the edge of the area after Nicolo Barella's initial effort was blocked.

But Arsenal, like they have so often done this season, regained the lead from a trademark set-piece in the 31st minute as Leandro Trossard headed Bukayo Saka's deep corner back into the area and the unmarked

Champions League: Bodo/Glimt stun Guardiola's superstars on frigid night in Norway

Norwegian debutants Bodo/Glimt claimed one of the biggest upsets in Champions League history on Tuesday by stunning Premier League Manchester City 3-1 in the cold of the Arctic Circle.

Played on an artificial surface, Pep Guardiola's youngsters froze in the -9C temperatures as City suffered another embarrassing loss following Saturday's derby defeat by Manchester United.

Glimt thoroughly deserved their victory, having taken a shock lead in the 22nd minute as Ole Didrik Blomberg's looping cross to the back post was headed in by Kasper Høgh.

City were all over the place defensively and young defender Max Alleyne, who was culpable for the first goal by run-

ning to the halfway line but failing to intercept a pass, then miscontrolled the ball in his own half just two minutes later.

It proved costly, allowing the hosts to double their lead as Blomberg again cut the ball across the box for Høgh to convert a fine first-time finish.

Høgh could have had a third for the rampant Glimt before the half-hour mark when he slid in at the far post but his effort on the stretch was smothered on the line by Gianluigi Donnarumma.

The usually prolific Erling Haaland has hit a sticky patch of form and his recent performances were summed up shortly before half-time when a chance fell to him eight yards out but he could not find the target with

his strike.

In the second half, Jens Petter Hauge's sensational solo effort, curling brilliantly into the top corner, put Kjetil Knutsen's side in dreamland and while Rayan Cherki pulled a goal back, City were then reduced to 10 men as Rodri was sent off for two bookable offences.

There was no way back for City thereafter and they will require a victory against Galatasaray in the final group phase game to secure a top-eight place, while Glimt kept alive their hopes of reaching the play-off round.

Just 10 years ago, Bodo/Glimt were playing in the second tier of Norwegian football. This is their first Champions League campaign.

They had not won a

match in the main stage of the competition before City came into town – they ended up claiming one of the most famous results in their his-

tory.

Though they had drawn against Tottenham earlier this season, and faced Spurs in the Europa League semi-fi-

nal last term, they had never beaten an English side in six previous meetings.

They ended that run in astonishing fashion.

Europa League round up

Europa League

Fenerbahçe 0-1 A Villa

Unai Emery's side secured a vital away win in the hostile atmosphere of Istanbul. Jadon Sancho was the hero, scoring his first goal for the club with a clinical first-half header in the 27th minute. Despite heavy late pressure from Jose Mourinho's side, Villa held firm - thanks in large part to goalkeeper Marco Bizot - to confirm their place in the top eight and progress directly to the Round of 16.
