# Keir's Chinese Takeaway

■ UK and China hail reset in relations as Starmer calls for 'mature' relationship

Prime Minister Keir Starmer and Chinese President Xi Jinping have called for a closer strategic partnership as they met in Beijing this week during the first trip of its kind by a British leader in eight years.

"I have long been clear that the UK and China need a long-term, consistent and comprehensive strategic partnership," Starmer said after the meeting at Beijing's Great Hall of the People on Thursday.

During their meeting, Starmer told Xi that he hopes the two leaders can "identify opportunities to collaborate, but also allow a meaningful dialogue on areas where we disagree".

"I think that working together on issues like climate change, global stability during challenging times for the world, is precisely what we should be doing as we build this relationship in the way that I've described," he said in his remarks.

### 'forge ahead'

Before his trip, Starmer had said doing business with China was the pragmatic choice, and it was time for a "mature" relationship with the world's second-largest economy.

Xi stressed the need for more "dialogue and cooperation" amid a "complex and intertwined" international situation.

"Good things often

come with difficulties. As long as it is the right thing to do in accordance with the fundamental interests of the country and its people, leaders will not shy away from difficulties and will forge ahead bravely," Xi said.

### 'common ground'

Starmer's meeting with Xi was followed by a second meeting with Chinese Premier Li Qiang later in the day. On Friday Starmer headed to Shanghai to conclude his three-day visit.

The visit underlined Starmer's decision to give the UK greater options moving forward given the changing nature of its relationship with the United States. As fractures have widened between London and Washington over tariffs, defence spending, the war in Ukraine and President Trump's ambitions to annex Greenland, the Prime Minister thinks it imperative that Britain has more flexibility in both trade and international affairs moving forward, rather than being yoked to a firmly pro-American policy.

Strengthening economic and security co-

operation has been at the top of Starmer's agenda, according to one Westminster insider. "Starmer has the very big task of bringing this diplomatic relationship out of years of deep freeze, so the focus when he talks to Xi Jinping will be finding areas of common ground," he said.


The relationship between the UK and China has been frosty since Beijing launched a political crackdown in Hong Kong, the former British colony, following months of antigovernment protests in 2019.

London has also criticized the prosecution in Hong Kong of the pro-democracy media tycoon Jimmy Lai, who is also a British citizen, on national security charges.

### 'good progress'

In October, the head of the UK's domestic intelligence agency MI5 said "Chinese state actors pose" a security threat "every day" following a high-profile espionage case that saw two men charged with spying for China.

Starmer said he raised the issues of Lai and

China's human rights record during his meeting with Xi.

"We did have a respectful discussion about that, raised those issues as you would expect ... It gives us great opportunities, but it also gives us the opportunity to have those discussions about areas where we disagree," the prime minister told reporters in Beijing when asked if the subjects had been raised.

Starmer also said "really good progress" had been made on other topics, including whisky tariffs and visa-free travel.

"We made some really good progress on tariffs for whisky, on visa-free travel to China and on information exchange and cooperation on irregular migration, focus-

ing particularly on small boats and engine parts," he told reporters, calling it "a very good constructive meeting with real outcomes".

It is unclear how Trump will respond to Starmer's visit to Beijing, but the UK prime minister said maintaining a "consistent" relationship with China is "firmly in the national interest".

Starmer is seeking deeper economic ties with China, as well, which was the UK's fourth-largest trading partner in 2022, according to UK government data.

Accompanying the prime minister on his trip is a delegation representing nearly 50 UK businesses and cultural organisations, including HSBC, British Airways,

AstraZeneca and GSK.

British companies want greater access to the Chinese market, especially high-end brands selling to a newly affluent China and UK consumers want more affordable Chinese technologies like electric vehicles, solar panels and wind turbines.

One leading commentator said of the meeting: "This about far more than small trade deals here and there. For Beijing, it's a chance to prove it can be a reliable trade partner to key allies of an increasingly unpredictable US president. China is using its dominance in manufacturing to entice Western partners to its shores in the hope it will increase its power and influence on the world stage."

# Tories' Kemi 'sorry' for jibe about latest defector's mental health

■ Party left flat-footed after backlash over the parting shot as Suella Braverman switches to Reform UK

Conservative leader Kemi Badenoch has apologised for a party statement which made reference to Suella Braverman's mental health following her defection to Reform UK.

An initial statement, which the party later said was sent in error, said "the Conservatives did all we could to look after Suella's mental health, but she was clearly very unhappy".

Badenoch told reporters the comment was "completely wrong and not the kind of culture we should have in our party".

## 'bitter and desperate'

The Tories had faced a backlash over the statement from mental health charities and politicians on all sides.

Braverman said the reference to her mental health was "a bit pathetic" and "more signs of a bitter and desperate party that seems to be in free-fall".

Asked if she had apologized for the statement, Badenoch said: "Yes, that has come out from me. That should never have

gone out. It has been retracted. And I've also spoken to the person who sent it.

Braverman, a former Conservative home secretary, defected to Nigel Farage's party on Monday, accusing the Tories of "betrayal" and "a witch hunt to hound out right-wingers".

She was the third sitting Tory MP to join Reform UK in less than two weeks, following Robert Jenrick and Andrew Rosindell, taking the party's tally of MPs to eight.

It comes after former Conservative chancellor Nadhim Zahawi also joined the party earlier this month.

Addressing the defections of Braverman, Jenrick and Zahawi in her speech, Badenoch said: "To those who are defecting, who don't actually disagree with our policies, I will say I'm sorry you didn't win the leadership contest.

"I'm sorry you didn't get a job in the shadow cabinet. I'm sorry you didn't get into the Lords, but you are not offering a plan to fix this country. This is a tantrum dressed

up as politics."

Around 20 former Tory MPs have joined Reform, with recent high-profile defectors accusing the party of failure.

## 'in denial'

During Deputy Prime Minister's Questions, David Lammy joked that Tory MPs were "lining up" to join Reform "while they squabble about the damage that they did to our country".

In her speech, Badenoch also took aim at former politicians who "are in denial" and "don't want to admit that immigration is too high".

"Some people say that we need to split the difference and find the centre ground," she said.

"It's not about the centre ground, it's about the common ground and it is about common sense." She added that "most people in our country want to control immigration" and the Tories were "a mainstream party".

Taking questions from journalists after her speech, Badenoch was asked about a new political movement launched

by former West Midlands mayor Sir Andy Street and former Scottish Conservative leader earlier this week.

The initiative - named Prosper UK - aims to win back centrist voters who feel "politically homeless".

Asked how damaging the new movement could

be to the Conservative Party, Badenoch said: "Anybody who is trying to push an agenda that is not the platform I stood on is not being helpful."

She added: "If they've

got new ideas which are on the right, not left-wing ideas, and we will welcome them. But right now we need to move away from any sort of factionalism or groupings."

## High tech policing on the way - Mahmood

The Home Secretary, Shabana Mahmood, has outlined plans for what would be the biggest change in policing in England and Wales for more than 60 years.

She told MPs she would roll out live facial recognition technology across both countries and implement a greater use of artificial intelligence. She also proposes creating a national police service to tackle organised crime, fraud, terrorism and threats from hostile states and merging forces into much bigger regional bodies.

The Home Secretary described policing in En-

gland and Wales as 'the last great unreformed public service'. Most police force boundaries have remained unchanged since the reforms of the 1960s, an era before even

the pocket calculator had been invented, let alone cybercrime. At the centre of her proposals is a national police service.

This would tackle the most complex issues like organised crime and terrorism. But Shabana Mahmood told MPs it would also act as a centre of excellence advising new, larger regional forces. She said some county constabularies were simply out of date."

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## Chandra brings misery to Britain

Heavy rain and "life-threatening" conditions continue to plague England as the region struggles with the devastating aftermath of the latest named storm to hit the UK, Chandra.

Nearly 150 flood alerts remain active across the country at press time. The Met Office has issued a fresh yellow rain warning effective from noon to midnight Thursday, specifically targeting south-west England. Officials warn of imminent threats to homes, businesses, and essential travel routes.

In Somerset, local council leader Bill Revans declared a major incident after 147 properties across Somerset and Dorset were submerged. Recovery teams worked through the night to clear impassable roads, shifting focus to protecting the region's most vulnerable residents.

"Our priority is to make sure people are aware that help is available," Revans stated.

The Met Office warned that the incoming deluge could trigger power outages and further travel chaos. Key areas under the spotlight include: Bournemouth, Christchurch, and Poole, Cornwall and Devon Dorset, Plymouth, and Somerset, Wiltshire and Torbay

The RNLI has issued a stark warning for the coastlines of Devon and Cornwall. Waves reaching 15ft (4.6 metres) were expected to crash over seafronts and harbor walls into the weekend, posing a significant risk to the public.

# Great Ormond Street surgeon harmed 94 children, review finds

## ■ Shocking report into actions of Yaser Jabbar from 2017 to 2022 says 36 of the patients suffered severe harm under his care

Nearly 100 children were harmed by a Great Ormond Street Hospital limb reconstruction surgeon, a review has found.

The investigation, published by the world-famous London hospital into Yaser Jabbar, found widespread evidence of unacceptable practice in the botched operations he carried out.

Jabbar worked at the hospital between 2017 and 2022, providing care to 789 children – 94 of them came to harm, GOSH's report concluded.

Most of those – 91 – were patients he did surgery on. He specialised in limb-lengthening and reconstruction for children with complex problems.

The hospital said it was "deeply sorry" for the harm caused.

The treatments he provided, which included inserting metal plates, bone grafts and implants, are considered high-risk and some level of complications are to be expected.

GOSH said it could not determine whether all the cases of harm were avoidable, but Jabbar's practice was substandard in many areas and this had undoubtedly caused harm.

### Constant pain

The report highlighted cases of premature removal of bone fixation devices, operations carried out without a clear rationale, problems with how bones were pinned and making cuts into bones at the wrong level. The way complications were identified and managed was also

criticised.

More than a quarter of patients he operated on came to harm, the report said. Thirty-five had suffered severe harm. Another child suffered severe harm, but that was not related to surgery.

The report did not detail individual cases, but families have previously spoken about the problems their children have experienced.

### 'too little, too late'

One girl, Bunty, who was born with a rare bone disease that caused her left leg to be bowed and short, was operated on multiple times by Jabbar and eventually had to have her lower leg amputated. This was classed as causing moderate harm.

Her father, Dean Stalham, said the findings were "too little, too late" and the problems should have been spotted earlier.

Lizzie Roberts, whose son Tate was operated on by Jabbar when he was 16 to treat the complications of a road accident 10 years previously, said the hospital had effectively "marked its own homework".

She says her son has been left in constant pain after having an unnecessary operation on his ankle that they did not consent to. The surgery was only meant to be on his knee, she says.

He is now facing more surgery and has had to drop out of college. His case was also classed as one of moderate harm.

Both families have asked the police to launch an investigation into the case. The Met-

ropolitan Police said it would review the findings of the report to see if that should happen.

Jabbar, who trained in the UK, is now understood to live abroad and no longer has a licence to practise medicine in the UK.

GOSH launched this investigation in 2024, bringing in independent doctors to review patient records, although the hospital itself pulled together their findings and have published them.

### 'deeply sorry'

The investigation was initiated after the Royal College of Surgeons (RCS) carried out a review on behalf of the hospital. It came after concerns were raised by a member of staff.

That review said there were serious concerns in relation to working culture, with some staff upset about the standard of care and saying the environment was "toxic" and that some surgery done on children was "inappropriate" and "incorrect".

NHS England's London region is now car-

rying out a review into GOSH's handling of the case.

GOSH said it had already acted on recommendations made by the RCS report, including introducing training on handling complaints, investing more in whistle-blowing support for staff and getting surgeons to discuss the most complex cases they are seeing with the National Royal Orthopaedic Hospital.

Before the concerns were raised in June 2022, the trust said it had received seven complaints about Jabbar and looked into one serious incident, its handling of which was signed off by

NHS England. The trust insists none of these suggested further investigation or action was needed.

GOSH chief executive Matthew Shaw acknowledged this was the bleakest day in the history of the hospital.

He said he was "deeply sorry" for the harm caused, but insisted the hospital had acted "incredibly quickly" once concerns were raised.

He said in areas like this, which were hyper-specialised and where there were only a small number of surgeons in the NHS, it was harder to detect problems with practice.

## Man convicted after Barron Trump calls London police to report crime

■ President's youngest son had met victim on social media

A wealthy Russian has been found guilty of beating up his girlfriend while she was on a FaceTime call with Barron Trump - but was cleared of raping her.

Matvei Rumiantsev, 22, was convicted of assaulting the woman in a jealous rage at his London flat while she was on a video call with Donald Trump's youngest son.

Rumiantsev was also found guilty of attempting to pervert the course of justice by calling the young woman from a police station after his arrest and writing to her

from Belmarsh prison where he was being held on remand a few days later.

But the ex-MMA fighter was found not guilty of two counts of rape, one count of strangulation and one count of assault by beating.

The court was earlier told how the US president's son had 'saved the woman's life' by phoning the police when he witnessed her being beaten up over a video call.

Barron, 19, spoke directly with a 999 operator when he heard

what he thought was Rumiantsev repeatedly punching his friend at the flat in Canary Wharf, east London.

Rumiantsev was jealous of the American's relationship with the woman and flew into a rage when he tried to phone her earlier that evening.

He then answered a video call from the President's son on the woman's phone, showed Barron her face then grabbed her hair and pushed her to the floor - shouting 'You are not worth anything', Snares-

## Coroner: Heading the ball 'a factor' in McQueen's death

An inquest has found that heading of football was a factor in the death of the former Scotland defender Gordon McQueen.

The coroner sitting in North Yorkshire said repetitive head impacts were likely to have contributed to his brain disease.

The former Leeds and Manchester United player, one of the dominant defenders of his generation and famed for his ability in the air, died in 2023.

This week the local coroner, John Heath, said he died from pneumonia, a consequence of vascular dementia and the brain disease chronic traumatic encephalopathy.

Repetitive head impacts sustained while playing football were likely to have contributed to the disease, he added.

After the hearing, Gordon McQueen's daughter, the broadcaster Hayley McQueen, said the family welcomed to the verdict and spoke of the dangers of heading a ball.

"He absolutely loved everything about football, but ultimately that was something that, you know, it took him in the end. And he went through a horrendous time towards the end of his life. He was certain himself it was possibly from heading a football."

A precedent was set back in 2002 with the death of the former West Brom striker, Jeff Astle. A coroner ruled his death was caused by heading footballs, and in the decades since, action has been taken. The Football Association is currently phasing in a total ban on headers for players aged under 11, and has issued

guidelines to reduce high force headers in training along with funding research.

In a statement, the FA said it was continuing to take a leading role in reviewing and improving the safety of the game. The Professional Players Union, the PFA, has a brain health fund of up to a million pounds to help affected families. But campaigners feel not enough is being done to address what the McQueen's legal team believes is a growing bank of research and evidence that establishes an irrefutable connection between brain injury and playing football.

Barron spent some time working out how to reach emergency services in Britain before telling a call handler: 'I just got a call from a girl, you know. She's getting beaten up.'

Jurors were played a recording of the conver-

sation, in which he gave the woman's address, then added: 'It's really an emergency, please. I got a call from her with a guy beating her up.'

Barron told the call handler he knew the woman through social media, after being ticked off by the operator for refusing to answer questions.

The call handler told the US president's son: 'Can you stop being rude and actually answer my questions? If you want to help the person, you'll answer

my questions clearly and precisely, thank you. So how do you know her?'

Barron answered: 'I met her on social media. She's getting really badly beat up and the call was about eight minutes ago, I don't know what could have happened by now.'

He added, 'So sorry for being rude', in the call was made at 2.23am on January 18 last year.

The 6ft 7in college student is Trump's fifth child and the president's only child with his wife Melania.

methods. We will ensure that every force is adopting the latest technology led out of the new national police service. This

will include the largest ever rollout of live facial recognition technologies across England and Wales."

The national police service would also lead on artificial intelligence and forensic science. The gov-

ernment's not specified how many regional forces it wants to create by merging county forces, though officials thought it might be around 15. Ministers hoped to get at least one merger through before the next election.

# 12-date Harry Styles set to make Wembley history

**Harry Styles will make history by playing 12 concerts at Wembley Stadium this year.**

The former One Direction star, 31, will overtake Coldplay and Taylor Swift as the artist with the most performances in a single year at the London venue.

Coldplay set the overall record with 10 Music of the Spheres tour shows last summer, while Swift's eight nights on her 2024 Eras tour is the highest number by a solo act.

Oasis racked up seven appearances at the stadium last year as part of their Live 25 tour.

A Wembley spokesman said: "We are incredibly proud to welcome Harry Styles back

for what will be a truly historic run of shows. The 12 nights will be among the most special in our stadium's long history."

Styles was initially due to play six shows at Wembley but added six more due to massive demand for tickets.

His fourth studio album Kiss All The Time. Disco, Occasionally comes out on March 6. Aperture, the first single from the album, was released last week.

Styles' Together, Together tour starts in May and also features performances in Amsterdam, New York, Sao Paulo, Mexico City, Melbourne, and Sydney.

He will be supported

at Wembley by country singer Shania Twain. DJ Jamie XX. Swedish singer-songwriter Robyn and singer Jorja Smith are among those supporting him elsewhere.

One Direction formed in 2010, when Simon Cowell put them together on ITV talent show The X Factor.

Styles and fellow members Niall Horan, Liam Payne and Louis Tomlinson went on "indefinite hiatus" in 2016 almost a year after Zayn Malik left the group.

Styles' self-titled debut solo album came out in 2017, followed by Fine Line in 2019 and Harry's House in 2022.

He has had two UK No1 singles, As It Was and Sign of the Times.


## After rescued hikers walk out on bill, the public steps up

"It does make you a bit despondent, really.







## Royal couple meet Holocaust survivors at the Palace

**King Charles III and Queen Camilla met Holocaust survivors and lit candles of remembrance at Buckingham Palace on Tuesday to mark the anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau.**

Survivors honoured for their services to Holocaust awareness in a series of portraits commissioned by the King were welcomed to the Palace, including 100-year-old Anita Lasker-Wallfisch and 98-year-old Helen Aronson.

King Charles said survivors who had died were also present "in spirit" at the reception to mark Holocaust Memorial Day.

Earlier on Tuesday, Mala Tribich became the first Holocaust survivor to address the cabinet - where she urged the government to "do what needs to be done" to tackle antisemitism today.

Holocaust Memorial Day takes place on 27 January each year and remembers the six million Jewish people murdered during World War Two.

It also commemorates the millions of people outside the Jewish faith who were murdered through Nazi persecution, and those targeted in more recent genocides.

Survivors and their families were invited to the Palace on Tuesday to mark the anniversary, including the daughter and two-year-old grandson of Zigi Shipper, who died in 2023 aged 93.

Shipper survived two concentration camps, including Auschwitz-Birkenau in occupied Poland, a death march, and the Lodz ghetto - a Jewish ghetto established by the Nazis which was plagued by disease, starvation and forced labour.

His daughter Lu Lawrence told the King she wished her father could have been present to see his "magnificent" portrait. King Charles responded that he was there "in spirit".

The King, who last year became the first British head of state to visit Auschwitz, also told 100-year-old survivor Lasker-Wallfisch that it was "wonderful" to have her join the reception.

"It goes back a long way since I first met you, it must be 20 years," he told her.

The King and Queen Camilla were later handed candles to light by Rachel Levy, who survived both Auschwitz-Birkenau and Bergen-Belsen concentration camps.

Thomas Frank praised Tottenham's "incredible" achievement as they secured an important victory at Eintracht Frankfurt to book a place in the Champions League last 16.

Randal Kolo Muani and Dominic Solanke scored in wintry conditions in Germany as Spurs avoided having to play a two-legged play-off tie in February.

Spurs, only 14th in the Premier League, scored 65 seconds into the second half of Wednesday's game when Kolo Muani flicked the ball in from six yards after Cristian Romero headed down Xavi Simons' cross.

Frank's side had been booed off in recent do-

mestic matches, with some supporters chanting for the Dane to be sacked midway through his first season.

But they were the superior side in this game and doubled their lead when substitute Solanke fired into the bottom left corner, ensuring Spurs finished fourth in the league phase and ahead of many of Europe's elite teams.

"I am very proud of the players and the character shown," said head coach Frank. "It is a big step to finish top eight and to actually finish fourth in the Champions League is incredible.

"I'm very happy with the result, but even more happy with the

performance. We looked in control more or less throughout the game. It was a more than well-deserved 2-0 win."

Spurs can focus attention on improving their Premier League position before returning to Champions League action in March.

Their automatic qualification for the last 16 had been in doubt before this game, and after 35 minutes with the scoreline goalless they were down to ninth in the table.

But Frank will be delighted with what became a dominant showing from his side as European results continue to provide a welcome contrast to their Premier League struggles.

It was a European run that appeared to keep Ange Postecoglou in a Tottenham job last season, despite poor Premier League form.

Ultimately, winning the Europa League was still not enough for the Australian, who was sacked at the end of the campaign.

The Champions League has looked to be Frank's saviour, with Spurs winning five of their eight group matches, drawing twice, with their only defeat being a thrilling 5-3 loss against trophy holders Paris St-Germain.

This victory will perhaps not appease all the club's fans, who could point to a favourable draw that has seen their wins come against Villarreal, Copenhagen, Slavia Prague, Borussia Dortmund and an already-eliminated Frankfurt.

But this success may at least buy Frank time, with an injury-ravaged squad avoiding two extra games in a daunting

February fixture line-up that includes Premier League matches against three of the top four - Manchester City, Manchester United and Arsenal - as well as a game against Newcastle.

"For basically Dortmund and this game we had 12 outfield players available, so a lot of players had to push through 90 minutes maybe not being there, so the character and mentality is big in the team," added Frank.

fortunate Otvos inside the box on Dan Ndoye.

Forest boss Sean Dyche said: "It is not just the scoreline, there was that feel about it. I want these guys to do collectively well, the whole squad."

"This is another step, but it is a good step."

Jesus has been a revelation for Forest in Europe this season with six of his 11 goals coming in the Europa League.

This double also means he has got three goals in his last two games and the threat of competition for his place in attack could be spurring him on.

Napoli striker Lorenzo Lucca was last week signed on loan and he was watching this game in the stands.

That may well have been on Jesus' mind as he was impressive against Ferencvaros, producing two excellent finishes for his goals and generally being a menace to the visitors' defence with his pace and movement.

Jesus was not alone in catching the eye, with McAtee producing his best performance in a Nottingham Forest shirt since signing from Manchester City last summer, while Dan Ndoye also impressed.

These encouraging performances will give Forest some renewed optimism as they switch focus to pulling further away from the Premier League relegation zone when they host Crystal Palace on Sunday.

"All you can ask for is a response," added Dyche.

"I've never questioned their work ethic or their loyalty or honesty. It is just go and show your quality."

# Mo on song as Reds find their shooting boots

**Mohamed Salah was on target for the first time since November as Liverpool thrashed Qarabag 6-0 to automatically reach the last 16 of the Champions League.**

Salah scored Liverpool's third as Arne Slot's side once again found respite in the competition away from domestic troubles in the Premier League.

The Egyptian last scored in Liverpool's win against Aston Villa on 1 November - since when he put his long-term future in question with a public attack on Slot and the club after being dropped, then went to the Africa Cup Of Nations with his country.

It was all smiles here, though, as Liverpool outclassed the Azerbaijan side, the outcome never in doubt.

Liverpool were on their way after 15 minutes when Alexis Mac Allister headed home from a corner, technology ruling the ball had crossed the line despite the desperate attempts of Qarabag goalkeeper Mateusz Kochalski to claw it out.

Florian Wirtz's crisp low finish doubled Liverpool's lead six minutes later before Salah's big moment arrived five minutes after the break.

Salah had been fouled on the edge of the area before curling the resulting free-kick into the top corner from Dominik Szoboszlai's touch, celebrating flamboyantly in front of the Kop.

Qarabag were being run ragged, Liverpool quickly adding two more when Hugo Ekitike raced clear,

then Mac Allister tapped in his second from almost on the goalline after a defensive shambles.

Substitute Federico Chiesa completed the rout with a simple finish from Virgil van Dijk's pass in the final moments.

Liverpool's only disap-

pointment on a comfortable night was another muscle injury to Jeremie Frimpong, which forced him off inside the first two minutes.

The loss at Bournemouth placed Slot and his players under severe scrutiny once more in

what has become a dismal defence of their Premier League title.

The Champions League has, however, been a happier hunting ground as Liverpool followed their 3-0 win in Marseille by ruthlessly dismissing Qarabag.

# Kai the man as Gunners make it eight for eight

**Kai Havertz scored on his first start for nearly a year as Arsenal completed a flawless league phase campaign, making it eight wins out of eight in the Champions League with victory over Kairat Almaty.**

Arsenal had already secured a top-two finish with their 3-1 win over Inter Milan last week, meaning they are guaranteed home ties in the second legs of their knockout ties.

They took the lead on Wednesday after just two minutes when Havertz played through Viktor Gyokeres and the forward powered a shot low into the net.

Kairat, who are bottom of the league phase with only one point, surprisingly levelled just three minutes later when Jorginho scored from the penalty spot after Riccardo Calafiori was adjudged to have pulled back the midfielder.

Arsenal then resumed control, and Havertz, who was making his first start for the Gunners since 5 February last year, put his side ahead with a powerful left-foot finish.

Gyokeres missed a couple of good opportunities to add to his goal tally, but as he attempted to get on the end of a Havertz low cross into

the area he helped the ball on for Gabriel Martinelli to tap in from close range for Arsenal's third.

Gabriel Jesus thought he had added a fourth late on, but his strike was ruled out for offside before Ricardinho nodded in a late goal to pull one back for Kairat.

The win means Arsenal finish top of the

league phase and are only the second English side to win eight or more consecutive games in Champions League history, after Pep Guardiola's Manchester City, who won 10 in a row between May 2023 and March 2024.

There was not much jeopardy coming into this match, with Arsenal either going to fin-

ish first or second in the league phase.

But the match against Kairat allowed Mikel Arteta to rotate his squad and the Arsenal manager made 11 changes.

The biggest positive of the night was that Arteta was able to name Havertz in a starting XI in a competitive game for the first time in 357 days.

**Two second-half goals from Joao Pedro saw Chelsea come from behind against Napoli to finish in the top eight while knocking the Italian side out of the Champions League.**

Enzo Fernandez had opened the scoring with a penalty, in Wednesday night's clash, but Antonio Vergara and Rasmus Hojlund put Napoli ahead just before half-time.

However, Cole Palmer was brought on at the interval and set up both of Joao Pedro's second half goals.

It was heartbreak for Napoli and ecstasy for

Chelsea, who secured a place in the last 16.

Chelsea began strongly when captain Reece James struck a free-kick against the hand of Juan Jesus to win a penalty in the 18th minute, which Enzo Fernandez drilled powerfully into the bottom corner.

The home side's opener came in the form of a remarkable first Napoli goal for local playmaker Antonio Vergara, as he escaped Moises Caicedo in midfield, turned Wesley Fofana and placed his shot past Chelsea goalkeeper Robert Sanchez.

Vergara's 33rd-min-

ute strike was followed 10 minutes later by Rasmus Hojlund's goal, the on-loan Manchester United striker beating Fofana to meet Olivera's low cross and guide a first-time finish into the corner.

Coming on at half-time, Palmer made an impact by feeding Joao Pedro, who shrugged off a challenge and smashed in an equaliser from the edge of the box in the 61st minute.

The Brazilian striker was then found by Palmer while counter-attacking and slotted an 82nd-minute winner under the legs of Meret.

**Europa League: Villa fight back to win yet again - but Watkins blow deepens injury woes**

conceded a calamitous opener.

Mings was robbed by Edmund Baidoo and Konate's awful shot with the goal gaping looked to be going wide before being turned in by Victor Lindelof.

Within four minutes of the restart substitute Yeo flicked in Salzburg's second, but Rogers pulled a goal back just after the hour - after Sota Kitano should have made it 3-0 - and Mings atoned for his error by heading in with 14 minutes left.

Substitute Jimoh-Aloba then grabbed an 87th-minute winner when he found the corner from 15 yards.

Villa were sloppy and

sluggish for an hour on Thursday and Salzburg were in total control at 2-0 up.


They opened the scoring in the 17th minute when Ryan Yates' cross was turned into his own net by Bence Otvos and added a second four min-
