'A SEVERING OF TIES'

■ Australia and New Zealand back stripping Andrew of succession rights

In a historic shift that threatens to further isolate the disgraced former Duke of York, the governments of Australia and New Zealand have officially signaled their support for removing Andrew Mountbatten-Windsor from the line of succession.

The move, described by constitutional experts as a "final severing of ties," follows the former prince's arrest on February 19, 2026, on suspicion of misconduct in public office.

Australian Prime Minister Anthony Albanese was the first to formalize this stance, writing a direct letter to, Sir Keir Starmer on Monday. Albanese confirmed that his government would agree to any proposal from Westminster to strike the former prince from the royal lineage.

'disgusted'

"In light of recent events concerning Andrew Mountbatten-Windsor, I am writing to confirm that my Government would agree to any proposal to remove him from the line of royal succession," Albanese wrote. Speaking to the ABC, he added that Australians are "disgusted"

by the mounting allegations regarding the former prince's dealings with the late Jeffrey Epstein, emphasizing that "no one is above the law."

The Australian Prime Minister has already begun the process of writing to the 14 other Commonwealth realms to inform them of Australia's position. This proactive stance is intended to streamline what will otherwise be a grueling legislative process.

Kiwis join in

Hours after Australia's announcement, New Zealand's Prime Minister Christopher Luxon echoed the sentiment from Wellington. While Luxon initially appeared more reserved, noting that the former prince is eighth in line and unlikely to ever reign, he ultimately committed New Zealand's support to the U.K. government's decision.

"The bottom line is

that no one is above the law," Luxon told reporters. "Once that investigation is closed, should the U.K. government decide to remove him from the line of succession, that is something we would support.

technicality

The momentum for this change surged following revelations from unsealed U.S. Justice Department files. These documents allegedly suggest that between 2001 and 2011, during his tenure as a U.K. trade envoy, the then-Prince Andrew shared confidential government information with Jeffrey Epstein.

Though Andrew was stripped of his "His Royal Highness" (HRH) status and the title of "Prince" in late 2025, he remained in the line of succession - a technicality that many now find untenable. By removing him, the Commonwealth realms hope

to ensure that even in the most remote of circumstances, he could never serve as a Regent or Monarch.

Labyrinth

Removing a royal from the line of succession is far more complex than stripping a title. Under the Statute of Westminster 1931, any change to the succession must be agreed upon by all 15 Commonwealth realms where King Charles III is head of state.

The process must begin with an Act of Parliament in Westminster and then go through a 'harmonization process', where realms including Aus-

tralia, Canada, and New Zealand must then pass their own domestic legislation or constitutional amendments to mirror the U.K. law.

Historically, this process is rare. The last major change occurred with the Succession to the Crown Act 2013, which ended male-preference primogeniture. That change took nearly two years of international coordination to finalize.

relevance

While King Charles III has not publicly commented on the legislative push, Buckingham Palace has sig-

naled it will not stand in the way of Parliament's will. For many in the Southern Hemisphere, however, the scandal has reignited long-standing debates about the monarchy's relevance.

While Prime Minister Albanese remains a self-described republican, he has ruled out a referendum for now, focusing instead on the immediate legal crisis. Nevertheless, by leading the charge to "boot out" Andrew, Australia and New Zealand are signaling that their continued loyalty to the Crown is contingent upon the institution's ability to purge itself of scandal.

Disgraced Mandelson all spun out

■ From New Labour architect to police suspect: How a “baseless” flight risk and a cache of secret emails finally cornered Westminster’s ultimate survivor

The “Prince of Darkness” has finally encountered a shadow he cannot outmaneuver.

In a dawn raid that has shattered the relative calm of Westminster, Lord Peter Mandelson—the ultimate survivor of the New Labour era—was arrested at his north London home on Monday. The sight of the former Cabinet titan and sacked U.S. Ambassador being escorted into an unmarked police vehicle marks a seismic shift in the British legal landscape, signaling that the long-simmering Epstein scandal has finally boiled over into a criminal reckoning.

devastating cache

The Metropolitan Police confirmed the arrest on suspicion of misconduct in public office, a charge that carries the heavy weight of historical betrayal. At the heart of the probe is a devastating cache of documents recently unearthed by the U.S. Department of Justice. These “Epstein Files” suggest that Mandelson’s relationship with the late financier Jeffrey Epstein was not merely a social

convenience, but a conduit for the exchange of high-level state secrets.

‘overreach’

Investigators are reportedly scrutinizing emails from 2009 that appear to show Mandelson, then the Business Secretary, feeding Epstein sensitive intel regarding the €500 billion Eurozone bailout and confidential strategies for U.K. state asset sales.

The fallout was instantaneous and explosive. Mandelson’s legal team at Mishcon de Reya wasted no time in launching a counter-offensive, branding the arrest a “performative overreach.” They argued that Mandelson had already pledged his full cooperation and was nowhere near the flight risk the police claimed he was. The drama took a surreal turn when it was revealed that the tip-off regarding Mandelson’s supposed plan to flee to the British Virgin Islands came from none other than House of Commons Speaker Sir Lindsay Hoyle. The Speaker’s involvement has triggered its own secondary scan-

dal, with Scotland Yard forced to apologize for accidentally leaking Hoyle’s identity as the informant - a breach of protocol that has left the Commons in an uproar.

For Prime Minister Keir Starmer, the arrest is nothing short of a political catastrophe. Starmer’s decision to appoint Mandelson as the U.K.’s envoy to Washington in late 2024 was already a gamble that had alienated the left wing of his party; now, it looks like a fatal lapse in judgment. The opposition has been merciless, painting the Prime Minister as a man who prioritized “Old Guard” connections over basic due diligence.

wildfire

The resignation of Starmer’s Chief of Staff, Morgan McSweeney, in the wake of the arrest suggests a Downing Street in a state of total collapse, struggling to contain a wildfire that is rapidly consuming the government’s credibility.

As Mandelson remains on bail, the broader implications for the British establishment are staggering. Coming so closely on

the heels of the detention of Andrew Mountbatten-Windsor, the former Prince Andrew, this move suggests a coordinated effort by authorities to dismantle a perceived “protected class.” No longer just a matter of tabloid gossip or social disgrace, the Epstein links are now

being treated as a potential conspiracy against the state.

The “Epstein Reckoning” has moved from the mansions of Manhattan to the corridors of British power, and as the government prepares to release its internal vetting documents next month, the

sense of dread in Whitehall is palpable. Peter Mandelson has spent a career masterfully reinventing himself, but as the evidence mounts and his political cover evaporates, even the most seasoned spin doctor may find this to be a story he cannot rewrite.

Chaos in the Commons: Speaker on the brink

LONDON: The grand, wood-paneled chambers of the House of Commons have seen their share of historical drama, but the atmosphere on Wednesday afternoon was one of pure, unadulterated vitriol.

As Peter Mandelson returned to his Camden home on bail, the focus of the Epstein fallout shifted abruptly from the “Prince of Darkness” to the man in the Speaker’s Chair. Sir Lindsay Hoyle now finds himself fighting for his political life after a stunning admission that he was the source who triggered Mandelson’s arrest - a move many MPs are branding an unprecedented breach of neutrality.

‘in good faith’

The session began with a rare “Speaker’s Statement,” delivered by a visibly-strained Hoyle. He confirmed to a hushed House that he had personally contacted the Metropolitan Police with a tip that Mandelson

was a flight risk, allegedly planning to flee to the British Virgin Islands.

Hoyle insisted he acted “in good faith” and as a “duty of responsibility,” but the explanation did little to quell the rising fury from across the benches. The revelation that the police then accidentally leaked Hoyle’s identity to Mandelson’s legal team has turned a high-stakes criminal probe into a constitutional crisis.

“The Speaker is the referee, not a player in the game,” shouted one veteran Labour backbencher over a chorus of jeers.

“When the Chair starts to moonlight as a police informant based on what his own lawyers call ‘baseless gossip,’ the impartial nature of this House is dead.”

The backlash was not confined to Mandelson’s few remaining allies. A cross-party coalition of MPs, led by the SNP and bolstered by several high-ranking Conservatives, has begun circulating a motion of no confidence in the Speaker.

They argue that Hoyle’s intervention bypassed the very due

process he is meant to protect. By Wednesday evening, the number of signatures on the "Hoyle Must Go" motion had surged toward triple digits, leaving the Speaker's tenure looking increasingly untenable.

'defining disaster'

While Hoyle dodged verbal arrows, Prime Minister Keir Starmer remained conspicuously silent, trapped in a nightmare of his own making. The arrest of his hand-picked Washington envoy has handed the Opposition a lethal weapon. Leader of the Opposition Kemi Badenoch seized the moment, calling the Mandelson affair the "defining disaster" of the Starmer premiership. She pointedly asked how a Prime Minister who built his reputation on the rule of law could appoint a man now suspected of leaking state secrets to a sex trafficker.

The pressure on Number 10 intensified further as a "Humble Address" motion passed, legally compelling the government to release all internal vetting documents related to Mandelson's 2024 appointment. Government ministers have signaled they cannot block the release, which is expected to include raw intelligence reports that Starmer reportedly ignored.

As the sun set over the Thames, the sense of an ending was palpable. With the Speaker's authority in tatters and the Prime Minister's judgment under a microscope, the Mandelson arrest has evolved into something far larger than a single misconduct charge. It has become a stress test for British democracy itself—one that the current leadership is perilously close to failing.

Did Epstein use RAF bases to traffic girls?

■ MoD vows to 'ruthlessly pursue' allegations sex offender landed private jet at UK military sites

The Ministry of Defence (MoD) has launched a review into whether RAF bases were used by Jeffrey Epstein.

It is expected the review will look into records and emails, while Defence Secretary John Healey was said to have ordered officials to turn over every stone to establish whether the late sex offender landed his private jet at military sites when visiting the UK.

An MoD source said it would "ruthlessly pursue any information that can shed light on this scandal".

It comes after former Prime Minister Gordon Brown demanded a police investigation into whether Andrew Mountbatten-Windsor had used RAF bases to meet Epstein.

'standard practice'

Brown said he had submitted a five-page dossier to several UK police forces – including the Met, Sussex and Thames Valley Police – providing new and additional information from Epstein-related documents published in the US.

Last Sunday, the Sunday Telegraph reported

that the former prime minister was understood to be concerned about a flight Epstein took on a Gulfstream jet that landed at RAF Marham air base in Norfolk in December 2000.


The base is around 20 miles from the Sandringham Estate.

Last year, a BBC News investigation established that around 90 flights linked to Epstein had arrived and departed from UK airports, some with British women on board who say they were abused.

At the time, the Ministry of Defence said it was "standard practice for spare capacity at RAF airfields in the UK to be used for private or commercial aircraft, subject to fees which cover all costs".

Mountbatten-Windsor has previously denied any wrongdoing in relation to Epstein, who died in a New York prison cell in 2019 as he awaited trial on sex trafficking charges.

An MoD spokesperson said: "The defence secretary has ordered a review of all records that the department may hold relating to Epstein flights

landing at RAF bases to ensure that any information which relates to Epstein's crimes is uncovered and provided to the relevant authorities.

"The MoD will support any civilian police investigations. Our thoughts are with all the victims of Epstein's vile crimes."

Last week, Essex Police said it was "assessing the information that has emerged" about private flights into and out of Stansted Airport, following the US government's release of Epstein materials.

Stansted Airport said in a statement that the

terminals used for private flights are "entirely independent" and that "no private jet passengers enter the main airport terminal".

Immigration and customs checks for passen-

gers arriving via private jets are carried out "directly by Border Force", it said, adding that it does not "manage or have any visibility of passenger arrangements on privately operated aircraft".

All Palace files open to you, King tells Andy cops

DETECTIVES investigating Andrew Mountbatten-Windsor's links to Jeffrey Epstein will have the unconditional support of Palace staff as they trawl files thrown open by the King.

Charles is allowing police full access to papers held at Buckingham Palace, it emerged this week. In

the wake of his younger brother's arrest on suspicion of misconduct in public office, the monarch said: "The law must take its course."

Sources now say the King is prepared to al-

low investigators to comb through any records, emails, and government files relating to Mountbatten-Windsor's role as a UK trade envoy from 2001-2011.

Officers investigating his friendship with pedophile billionaire Epstein will be aided by Palace staff.

private office

A source said: "We have said we will cooperate fully and wholeheartedly".

The former prince, 66, has been stripped of his titles and patronages but as Duke of York had a

private office at Buckingham Palace until 2022. He was arrested on Thursday at his home on the Sandringham Estate in Norfolk and quizzed for 11 hours at Aylsham police station before being released under investigation.

At the time Charles issued an unprecedented statement in which he reiterated his unequivocal support for the police.

He said: "What now follows is the full, fair and proper process by which this issue is investigated in the appropriate manner and by the

appropriate authorities. In this, as I have said before, they have our full and wholehearted support and cooperation.

"Let me state clearly: the law must take its course."

A four day search of Mountbatten-Windsor's former home, the Grade II-listed 30-bedroom Royal Lodge on the Windsor Castle estate concluded on Monday.

Mountbatten-Windsor has consistently and vigorously denied wrongdoing in connection to his long friendship with sex trafficker Epstein, 66, who hanged himself in

his New York jail cell in 2019.

The Metropolitan Police have also asked for royal protection officers to flag any suspected misconduct. One of those former bodyguards estimated more than 40 women visited Buckingham Palace – the King's official residence – when Mountbatten-Windsor was based there between 1998 and 2004.

It is alleged Mountbatten-Windsor shared sensitive information with Epstein while serving as a trade envoy after retiring from the Royal Navy.

GB a nation 'on the rise' after record Winter Olympics haul

■ Five medals may not seem like much to the Nordic nations...but for a country with very little snow and ice, this Games's haul is a record-breaker

CHEF DE MISSION Eve Muirhead declared Great Britain a nation "on the rise" in winter sports – as Olympians received a heroes' welcome following their record-breaking exploits in Italy.

Team GB celebrated their greatest Winter Olympics by winning five medals – three gold, a silver and a bronze – at Milano Cortina 2026.

'really special'

Skeleton racer Matt Weston led athletes into the arrivals hall at Gatwick Airport Monday lunchtime, wearing his two gold medals and waving the Union Flag.

"To come away as the most successful British team at the Winter Olympics, coming away with the most-decorated male winter Olympian of all time in Matt Weston as well, it's really special," Muirhead said. "It comes down to the history-makers, the athletes.

"They have been incredible. We've had a handful of fourth places, I think we've had 24 top-10s as well, so it shows that we are a nation with

a lot of potential and most definitely on the rise."

Team GB had never previously won multiple golds at a single Winter Olympics.

Following his individual success, Weston claimed the mixed skeleton title alongside Tabby Stoecker after Charlotte Bankes and Huw Nightingale topped the podium in the mixed team snowboard cross.

The men's curling team, led by Bruce Mouat, clinched silver before freestyle skier Zoe Atkin added bronze in the women's halfpipe.

'history-makers'

Team GB touched down at 11.06am on their British Airways flight from Verona for a rousing homecoming.

"It was amazing to walk out there," said Muirhead, who won curling gold at Beijing 2022 after bronze at Sochi 2014. "It's the history-makers, the athletes – this is their moment and they deserve every single bit of it because they have been an incredible team.

"We want to make the

most of this opportunity.

"We've got a team that's come away as the most-successful Winter Olympic team, so it's important that we capitalize on that.

"We are a nation that lacks ice and snow. But it shows what a great job all the sports are doing.

"If we can get more young people involved in sport, then it's a great way to inspire the nation."

Nightingale and Bank-

es bounced back from poor results in their individual competitions to win Britain's first gold on snow.

Nightingale, 24, said: "For me, it means quite a lot to show that GB is becoming a winter nation, and we do have top athletes that are doing great in their sport. We can hopefully get young kids to want to do what we wanted to do."

Bankes, 30, who was a

flagbearer at Sunday evening's closing ceremony, said: "Coming back to the UK, it made me realise a bit more what we've achieved and all that comes with it, it's really nice. Coming away with the gold, hopefully it's inspired a lot of people into snowboarding."

Atkin followed in the footsteps of elder sister Izzy, who won Olympic slopestyle bronze in 2018.

The 23-year-old Stan-

ford University student suffered "post-Olympic blues" after a disappointing ninth-placed finish on her debut at Beijing in 2022.

"I've been dreaming about medalling at the Olympics since forever, I think since my sister did it in 2018," Atkin said.

"To perform for her and show her my best skiing was really, really special and full circle for us."

Following the Isle of Man, assisted dying legislation passed in Jersey

A law to allow terminally ill adults the right to choose to end their own lives has been approved in Jersey.

It marks the final legislative stage for the landmark proposals before they get Royal Assent in the UK – and once approved the first legal assisted deaths could happen as early as next summer.

Those eligible are people with terminal illness-

es causing unbearable suffering where they are expected to die within six months, or 12 months for those with neurodegenerative conditions such as Parkinson's and motor neurone disease (MND).

It means Jersey is now the second part of the British Isles where assisted dying has been fully approved – the Isle of Man was the first.

Westminster and Scotland are debating

assisted dying, with the draft law in England and Wales making slow progress in the House of Lords.

A UK government spokesperson said the length of processing time "depends on the complexities and sensitivities of a bill, as well as any legal and constitutional issues". The various proposals across the UK have generated huge controversy, with

passionate arguments for and against the changes.

While Jersey passes its legislation, the bill for England and Wales remains blocked.

'badly needed'

Both Crown dependencies have set residency requirements for eligibility – 12 months for Jersey and five years for the Isle of Man. Thirty-two politicians voted in favour of the law with

16 voting against it. The bill will be sent for Royal Assent, which should be a formality.

Jersey Minister for Health and Social Services, Tom Binet, said: "Jersey would have one of the safest and most transparent assisted dying laws in the world."

Lorna Pirozzolo, from Jersey, who has terminal breast cancer, said the reform to law was "badly needed".

"Like so many terminally ill people I've spoken with, I'm not scared of dying, but I am terrified of suffering as I go. That's why this law is so badly needed. Today brings enormous relief, not just for me, but for future generations of islanders who deserve compassion, choice and dignity at the end of life."

One of the driving forces behind the legisla-

Tartan Army wins World Cup reprieve!

■ FIFA reverses course and WILL allow fans to bring their traditional sporrans into matches

The Tartan Army have been given the green light to wear sporrans with their kilts at World Cup matches this summer, the Scottish Football Association has confirmed.

Thousands of supporters are expected to travel to the US to cheer on Steve Clarke's side after the men's national team qualified for the first time since 1998.

The World Cup stadium code of conduct states ticket holders are only permitted to bring certain types of bags into stadiums.

Sporrans initially failed to meet the strict security criteria but, following talks between world football's governing body

Fifa and the SFA, it has now been agreed fans will be able to wear them.

Scotland are set to face Haiti and Morocco in Boston and Brazil in Miami after qualifying for the finals with a thrilling 4-2 Hampden victory over Denmark in November.

The 2026 edition will feature 48 teams and be played from 11 June to 19 July in 16 cities across the US, Canada and Mexico.

Under current rules at the stadiums in Boston and Miami, the only large bags allowed into the grounds must be made from clear plastic and not exceed 12in x 12in x 6in.

Any small bags that are not see-through must measure no more than 4.5in x 6.5in - almost half

the size of many sporrans.

Without the agreement Scotland fans would have had to leave their sporrans in lockers outside or discard them altogether.

"The Tartan Army are well-known and the sporran is part of our uniform," Tartan Army veteran Hamish Husband told reporters this week.

"Our sporrans will contain our match tickets and hope - that's all we want to smuggle into the stadiums.

"When we arrive anywhere in the world, the kilt and the sporran are a sign of friendship."

He said he never had any doubts that Scotland fans would be allowed to wear their sporrans in the

stadiums for the matches.

A SFA spokesperson said: "FIFA have confirmed that sporrans will be permitted into the stadiums following the standard search and inspection procedures and will continue to work together with the Scottish FA to educate their matchday staff as they prepare to welcome fans to Boston and Miami.

"The ticketing and membership team at the Scottish FA are in continued dialogue with the tournament hosts to ensure that the Scotland fans will be welcomed to venues in the way they have been across the world."

The agreement comes after it was revealed that the Scotland squad will be kitted out in tailored suits for their World Cup

return.

In 1998 the team, managed by the late Craig Brown, wore kilts ahead of the opening match of tournament against Brazil in Paris.

But last month the SFA confirmed a Glasgow-based tailor will make "sharp, made-to-measure suits" for the players and backroom staff.

tion is Humanists UK, an organization which supports the right of terminally ill people to decide the manner and timing of their own deaths and advocates for the inclusion of strong safeguards in such proposals that reflect public wishes.

Chief executive Andrew Copson said it was a "momentous vote of confidence for compassion, dignity, and choice at the end of life".


"For far too long, terminally ill people were denied the right to decide the manner and timing of their own deaths. Today, Jersey has changed that," he said.

The assisted dying


campaigner, and former BBC presenter, Dame Esther Rantzen, welcomed the decision.

British actor beats Hollywood heavyweights to Best Actor gong at the BAFTAs

Britain's Robert Aramayo defeated Hollywood heavyweights Leonardo DiCaprio and Timothee Chalamet at the Baftas in a shock best actor win for his role in I Swear.

The 33-year-old's gong in Sunday night's glitzy London ceremony was all the more surprising as just minutes earlier he had picked up the rising star award for the best new talent.

The Hull actor scooped the double win for his performance as a young man growing up with Tourette's syndrome in the 1980s.

In tears, he said: "I absolutely can't believe this. I honestly cannot believe I have won this award. Every-one in this category blows me away."

British-Nigerian actress Wunmi Mosaku won the best supporting actress prize her role in Sinners.

The pregnant star, who beat Teyana Taylor of One Battle After Another and Hamnet's Emily Watson, thanked Bafta for "this incredible honour".

Ireland's Jessie Buckley won the leading actress gong for her role as William Shakespeare's wife Agnes in the film Hamnet. The movie was



also named Outstanding British Film.

The other big success of the night was One Battle After Another, starring DiCaprio, which scooped six gongs, including best film and best director.

DiCaprio's rival Aramayo was seen hugging his family and friends after being named best actor.

The actor, who studied performing arts at Wyke College in the city and attended Hull Truck Theatre, broke down in tears on stage and said afterwards: "It totally blows my mind."

Laura Bulless, from the college, said: "It felt like the whole of Hull was behind him to get that newcomer award

and then to get leading actor, it's just absolutely phenomenal."

Bulless added: "It's an amazing thing to happen for a lad from Hull and for our students to see.

"That is just something they can take with them now on whatever they are going to do next."

Commenting on his achievement, the theatre's artistic director, Mark Babych, described it as a "jump up and down" moment.

"What an incredible result," he said.

However, he said he was not surprised as "Rob is a phenomenal actor", adding the recognition was also great for "theatres like ours" and the role they play in encouraging young talent.

"We are just incredibly proud of Rob, who is clearly an enormous inspiration to people," he added.

Referring to Tourette's syndrome campaigner John Davidson, on whom I Swear is based, Aramayo said: "John Davidson is the most remarkable person I've ever met and he believes there is so much more we need to learn about Tourette's. In the words of the film, they

But the event was not without controversy. When Sinners' stars Michael B Jordan and Delroy Lindo were at the podium speaking, Davidson had a Tourette's outburst, shouting b**ch ni**er' at the pair, who maintained their composure to finish their speech.

The ceremony was broadcast on BBC One and iPlayer on a two-hour delay but WITHOUT the offending words being edited out - although the sound quality was muffled.

The gaffe was described as "completely unacceptable and harmful" by culture secretary Lisa Nandy, who said she had spoken to outgoing BBC director general Tim Davie, who has pledged an investigation into the incident.

The Commons culture committee's chairwoman, Conservative MP Dame Caroline Dinenage, said Sunday's

broadcast "raises questions about the extent to which lessons have been learned" from previous scandals.

She highlighted Bob Vylan's performance at Glastonbury last year, when the BBC streamed antisemitic remarks and other derogatory com-

ments made on stage by the punk duo.

The BBC claimed the producers editing the ceremony for its delayed BBC broadcast were doing so from a TV truck and simply did not hear the slur shouted when Lindo and Jordan were on stage.

Newcastle pushed for another, but the hosts ultimately had to be content with an emphatic 9-3 aggregate win.

Snoop sprinkles some stardust on the Swans

THE SWANS got a little taste of Long Beach this week with the glitzy arrival of part owner Snoop Dog for a humble midweek fixture against Preston North End.

The superstar rapper was greeted before kick off by delirious home fans while the soundtrack of his greatest hits blared from the sound system. As Snoop waved a Swansea-branded towel above his head, the capacity crowd did the same and chanted "Snoop Dogg's barmy army".

Snoop is used to rolling up at some of the biggest sporting events in the world.

He was an 'honorary coach' for the United States at this month's Winter Olympics in Italy, having fulfilled a similar role at the Paris summer Games of 2024.

Two years before that, he was one of the performers in the Super Bowl half-time show. Global audiences do not get much bigger.

So, a meeting between teams 14th and eighth in the Championship was not the most obvious next destination for Snoop's sporting bucket list.

But these are strange

times. Wrexham are owned by Hollywood actors and Swansea count former Ballon d'Or winner Luka Modric and US television personality and billionaire Martha Stewart among their minority investors.

In terms of fame and worldwide reach, however, Snoop is on another level.

Fans had been lining up outside the stadium five hours before kick-off to get a glimpse of Snoop, who signed autographs and posed for photographs in the kind of sunshine that will have made the Californian feel at home.

Inside the ground, he had arranged for every single seat to have a Snoop and Swansea-branded towel inspired by those waved by supporters of his beloved American football team, the Pittsburgh Steelers.

The visitors did not seem fazed, though.

Preston had only brought around 200 fans for what was a sell-out. With tickets in the away end sold to Swansea supporters, this was a record number of home fans at a game in this stadium.

Yet the away fans were

loudest during a first half in which their team led to puncture the party atmosphere.

"Snoop Dogg, what's the score?" sang Preston's travelling contingent, before later chanting: "Where's your towel gone?"

Sat in the directors' box in a long Swansea puffer coat, which would not have looked out of place on the slopes of the Winter Olympics in northern Italy, this was Snoop's first experience of football's tribal fan culture.

Fortunately for him, he got to sample the soaring high of an injury-time equaliser as well, as substitute Liam Cullen headed the Swans level in the

95th minute.

"After the game, he [Snoop] came to the dressing room, spoke with the players," said Swansea head coach Vitor Matos.

"He's someone that likes to be involved. He was involved not only with us, but as well with the [US] Olympic team. He really loves sports.

"It's good for him to be involved. I'm happy that we have someone like him who loves the club, loves the city, wants to be here."

When Swansea's American owners Brett Cravatt and Jason Cohen brought Snoop in as a minority investor in July, the idea was not that the rapper would spend large

amounts of his own enormous wealth on the club.

Instead, the Swans wanted to increase their global appeal by tapping into Snoop's huge reach which includes more than 100m social media followers.

Some at the club believe that could create business and sponsorship opportunities which could outstrip those they had when they were in the Premier League.

Getting back to the top flight is the aim. After such a spectacular preamble, this first act at least produced a dramatic finish.

Now Swansea and Snoop wait to see what the next episode brings.

hierarchy, with many expecting those comments to lead to an immediate departure.

Cunha conceded a penalty 25 seconds after the restart when he tripped Akturkoglu.

The striker converted the spot-kick to raise the anxiety levels, until Hudson-Odoi - one of the half-time substitutes - made it 4-2 on aggregate with a low finish 22 minutes from the end.

Omari Hutchinson could have made it 2-2 on the night but was denied by Tarik Cetin after running clean through late on.

Given the theatrics of Nottingham Forest's season, it was not a surprise Fenerbahce made things

With the visitors in the middle of an injury crisis, missing goalkeeper Ederson and only able to name seven substitutes, it should have been a routine evening.

They are only two points above the relegation zone with 11 games left and their form has dropped - one of the reasons Pereira was parachuted in to replace Sean Dyche this month - and so any energy from the Europa League is welcome.

Palace shrug off domestic woes

Crystal Palace proved too strong for Bosnian side Zrinjski and moved into the last 16 of the Conference League with a comfortable 2-0 mid-week win.

The Eagles, competing in their first season of European football after winning the FA Cup in 2024-25, had drawn 1-1 in last week's away leg in Mostar, Bosnia-Herzegovina.

But Oliver Glasner's side never looked in danger of conceding a goal and produced a dominant performance in the second leg at Selhurst Park to continue their European adventure.

Their opener came in the 36th minute when Maxence Lacroix headed into the net from five yards out following an excellent delivery from Adam Wharton with a free-kick close to the left touchline.

Evann Guessand had an effort saved and Ismaila Sarr headed wide and

missed a one-on-chance, before Guessand scored with a hard, low strike in the second minute of stoppage time to seal a 2-0 win on the night and a 3-1 aggregate victory.

Palace will now play either German side Mainz or Larnaca from Cyprus in the two-legged tie, with the first game at Selhurst Park on Thursday, 12 March, followed by the away match a week later.

For Palace, this win continues a rollercoaster 12 months.

After beating Manchester City 1-0 to win the FA Cup in May - the first major trophy in the club's history - they followed that with more silverware by edging past Premier League champions Liverpool on penalties to clinch the Community Shield.

But, off the pitch, the club were unsuccessful in their legal attempt to stay in the Europa League, as they were then demoted to the third-tier Confer-

cup final, joined Arsenal and captain Marc Guehi almost moved to Liverpool, only for the deal to fall apart as the Eagles could not sort out a replacement.
