DOUBLE WHAMMY!

PM's hold on power looks weaker than ever after resignation of Defence Secretary AND Armed Forces Minister

SIR KEIR STARMER's tenure at No. 10 looked ever more wobbly Thursday after the abrupt resignation of both his Defence Secretary and Armed Forces minister.

In a letter addressed to Keir Starmer and posted on X on Thursday, John Healey quit as Defence chief and accused the prime minister of failing to commit the resources needed to defend the country.

"You have been unable, and the Treasury has been unwilling, to commit the resources that the nation needs to defend the country at this time of rising threats," he wrote.

Hours later armed forces minister Al Carns followed suit, writing to Sir Keir to tell him the government's defence investment plan (DIP) was "neither transformative enough nor sufficiently funded".

rising demands

Britain's defence and finance ministries have been locked in talks for months over how to meet rising demands to expand military spending, delaying the country's Defence Investment Plan since last year.

Healey said the financial settlement he received on Monday "falls

well short of what is required for defence and the country at this dangerous time," rising only to 2.68 percent of gross domestic product (GDP) in 2030 at a time when he argued a firm 3 percent headmark by that year was essential.

Healey invoked Starmer's own words against him, saying "there could be an attack by Russia on Nato as soon as 2030".

'hollowing out'

He added: "You know what defence needs. You made the argument for this powerfully in your speech at the Munich Security Conference back in February."

The resignation comes as Britain juggles an expanding set of military commitments: leading a multinational Strait of Hormuz mission amid the conflict with Iran, heading NATO's Arctic Sentry mission in the High North, and facing increased Russian activity towards the UK and NATO allies alongside escalating attacks in Ukraine.

Without adequate funding, Healey said: "I am being forced to make decisions that would reduce the readiness of our Forces and increase the risk to personnel on operations, and could make the country less safe."

Having promised to reverse what he called the "hollowing out" of the armed forces, the settlement Healey was offered on Monday was not enough for him.

As he set out in his resignation letter, according to his analysis the increase on the table would have actually meant cuts to investment because of increasing demands on the military, not least supporting Ukraine, protecting Gulf allies from Iranian attacks and ongoing efforts designed to deter Russian aggression in the Arctic.

'lack of vision'

Healey is the sixth government minister to resign since Labour's disastrous showing in last month's elections and the fourth full cabinet minister to resign from Sir Keir's government after

Louise Haigh, Angela Rayner and Wes Streeting.

Health Secretary Wes Streeting left his post on May 14. He said it was clear Starmer would not lead Labour into the next general election, criticising his government's "drift" and lack of "vision".

The departure lands at a particularly precarious moment for Starmer.

Almost 100 Labour MPs have already called on the prime minister to resign or set out a departure timetable by mid-May. His government's popularity has collapsed a scant two years after a

landslide general election victory. The delay to the Defence Investment Plan has also frustrated Britain's defence industry, which says it cannot commit to long-term programs at a time of huge geopolitical volatility.

"This is the latest in a string of high-profile resignations that have beset the Starmer government, and it is yet another blow for the Starmer premiership," said a leading Westminster observer.

"John Healey is a well-respected politician with a long career. He has clout, and he was a real significant figure within the government. His res-

ignation has opened up a new frontier of criticism aimed at Keir Starmer, because up until now the crux of the criticism has been focused around the Peter Mandelson scandal," the source added.

Starmer has faced questions over his judgement amid revelations that Mandelson, who the prime minister appointed as ambassador to the US, had close ties to late sex offender Jeffrey Epstein.

The resignation also raises the question of whether or not John Healey could be preparing his own leadership bid.

News from Britain

Zelensky thanks King for support

Ukrainian leader and the King met privately at Windsor on Sunday

UKRAINE PRESIDENT Volodymyr Zelensky thanked the King for his robust backing of Ukraine in its war with Russia.

The men met privately at Windsor Castle Sunday afternoon following Mr Zelensky's weekend summit with European leaders at No10.

Charles has publicly supported Ukraine since Vladimir Putin's invasion in February 2022.

Afterwards, the president said: "As always, a good audience with His Majesty King Charles III.

"I thank His Majesty, the people, and the entire United Kingdom for their ironclad support for our people."

On Sunday, he met Sir Keir Starmer, French president Emmanuel Macron and German chancellor Friedrich

Merz in Downing Street to revive efforts to end the war.

Before that, Mr Zelensky revealed former Chelsea football club owner Roman Abramovich has acted as a go-between for Kyiv and Moscow on plans for peace talks.

'not about us'

The oligarch visited him last month in the Ukrainian capital with a message from Russia – and offered to deliver his response directly to Putin. Mr Zelensky reported: "I said the question is not about us. You are fighting against us on our territory."

The president said he told Mr Abramovich he was willing to meet "any time from tomorrow" in any location other than Russia or Belarus, either

one-to-one or with Donald Trump and European leaders.

Putin's messenger was sanctioned by the UK in the early days of the war over his links to the Kremlin leader.

But Mr Abramovich has previously been involved in negotiations with Moscow and reportedly played a role in arranging a prisoner swap in 2022 that secured the release of five British men captured while fighting for Ukraine.

drone strike

In a joint statement on Sunday night, the European leaders called on Putin to agree "an immediate and complete ceasefire" and condemned Russia's "large-scale missile and drone attacks" on Ukrainian

cities. On the same day, a Russian drone strike killed three people waiting at a bus stop in south-eastern Ukraine.

A separate assault damaged a storage centre for spent nuclear fuel nine miles from Chernobyl. Officials said radiation remained within safe levels.

"Rambo"

On Friday, Putin revealed he received Mr Zelensky's letter that morning suggesting peace talks but said it included "some rather rude remarks" and then berated his enemy for posing like "Rambo".

Speaking in St Petersburg, the 73-year-old said: "First of all, he mentioned in the letter about my age. Everyone should think about age. But it seems to me that at my age many other politicians carry

out their functions, and meet Mr Zelensky, 48, he replied: "I don't see any point yet."

Trump changes tack on Chagos - says he's like to buy them

DONALD Trump is reportedly weighing up whether to attempt to buy the Chagos Islands as his frustration mounts at Sir Keir Starmer's plans to hand

them to Mauritius.

The deal, which the president has not confirmed, would reportedly see the United States take direct ownership of the Indian Ocean archipelago including the strategically important Diego Garcia base.

It follows several attempts by the White House to expand the territory of the United States, including threats to seize control of Greenland, Canada and Venezuela.

Mr Trump also threatened Panama and Cuba and has mounted air strikes on Iran.

The conflict plunged the region into war and sent worldwide oil prices rocketing.

The 79-year-old Republican, who is serving his second term, was reported by The Daily

Telegraph to be planning to try to buy British Indian Ocean Territory. Such a purchase is one of several options that are said to have been presented to Mr Trump as he considers possible ways to bring the key air base under full US control.

The sovereignty of the British-controlled nation has been the subject of discussion between London and Mauritius.

A deal to cede sovereignty to Mauritius, while renting back the military base, was put on hold earlier this year after America withdrew its support.

British officials described the Diego Garcia site as a "key strategic military asset for both the UK and the US".

A government spokesman defended the deal

that was being done with Mauritius, saying:

"Maintaining long-term operational control and security of Diego Garcia is the entire basis for the UK-Mauritius agreement."

The source added that the deal had been "borne out of the real long-term risks to the base of which both the UK and US are very well aware."

Mr Trump has been deeply critical of the proposed UK agreement and described it online as "an act of GREAT STUPIDITY" in January when his government withdrew its support.

Several sources revealed that Scott Bessent, US Secretary of the Treasury, had raised the issue with Mr Trump, but added that the purchase was not his "leading" option.



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Disorder rocks Belfast after grisly knife attack

■ Mob fuelled by right-wing media targets immigrants after Sudanese refugee attacks disabled local man

BELFAST was rocked with violent disorder this week following a grisly attack on a disabled man by a Sudanese refugee.

The trouble followed an unprovoked attack on Monday night on 44-year-old Stephen Ogilvie, who was subjected to a savage, knife attack.

The assailant, wielding a kitchen blade, slashed repeatedly at Ogilvie's head, face, and back. Passersby intervened with astonishing bravery - one local man literally fought the knifeman off with a hurley - but the damage was done. Ogilvie survived, but he has lost his left eye, and his right is severely damaged.

graphic footage

It was a horrific crime, made instantly worse by the internet. Within minutes, highly graphic mobile phone footage of the incident was uploaded and quickly went viral on anti-immigrant websites.

By Tuesday morning, social media was crackling with a well-orchestrated fury. The initial rumor mill, aided by an early police misstep, claimed the attacker was Somali. He wasn't. He was later identified in court as Hadi Alodid, a 30-year-old Sudanese refugee who had been granted legal leave

to remain until 2028 after arriving via Dublin. Soon Elon Musk and Tommy Robinson chimed in, using the horrific footage to stoke a domestic bonfire. WhatsApp messages flew across Northern Ireland, instructing "men of the age 18 and over" to don dark clothing and prepare to fight.

sledgehammers

As tensions simmered with evening approaching, shutters were slamming down on African and Arab-owned supermarkets, barbershops, and corner stores across Belfast. The Belfast Islamic Centre cancelled evening prayers, advising its congregation to hunker down. They knew what was coming.

As dusk fell, hordes of men dressed in black, faces obscured by balaclavas and hoodies, took to the streets. On the Antrim Road, mobs used sledgehammers to smash paving stones, gathering ammunition to pelt at the Police Service of Northern Ireland (PSNI). On the Lower Newtownards Road in East Belfast, a sleek multi-million-pound Glider bus was hijacked and turned into a roaring wall of fire.

But the real horror took place away from the main thoroughfares, down the

residential side streets like McMaster Street and Oakley Street. Masked gangs went door-to-door, explicitly targeting homes they believed were occupied by immigrants. They kicked in doors, shattered windows, and threw petrol bombs.

war zone

Local police struggled to contain the violence and restore order over the next two days. By Thursday morning twenty-seven people have been made homeless. Among those burned out of their homes were Ugandan healthcare workers, a Ukrainian family who thought they had escaped a war zone, and a Romani family who, according to neighbours, were being forced out of their home for the third time. In the chaos, the PSNI Chief Constable revealed that a two-month-old baby had to be rescued from a burning building.

Meanwhile, a bizarre, carnival atmosphere took hold in pockets of the crowd. Men drank beer and snapped selfies against the backdrop of burning terraced houses. One father was spotted hoisting his young son onto his shoulders to get a better view of a property going up in flames.

The violence quickly bled out of the capital. Pockets of arson and rioting flared up in Portadown, Dundonald, and Newtownabbey, while copycat protests simmered across the water in Glasgow, Edinburgh, and Southampton. By Wednesday night, the Northern Ireland Fire and Rescue Service had responded to over 250 emergency calls. Even the health service was choked; the Royal College of Nursing reported that masked men were stopping nurses on their way to night shifts, demanding to see their credentials be-

fore letting them pass.

Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer called the original stabbing "abhorrent" and slammed the subsequent riots. At Stormont, the leaders of the five main political parties issued a rare joint statement pleading for calm.

'alien culture'

Yet, the language from some political quarters remains highly combustible. Jim Allister, leader of the Traditional Unionist Voice party (TUV) a right-wing unionist political party, openly questioned what was being done to stop the "impor-

tation of an alien culture that seems to now include attempted beheading," while DUP leader Gavin Robinson demanded an end to "uncontrolled immigration."

On Wednesday, Hadi Alodid appeared via video link at Belfast Magistrates Court, charged with attempted murder and threats to kill an NHS radiographer while being treated for a hand wound.

Belfast has spent decades trying to put out the fires of its past, but this week proved just how little it takes to set the city alight all over again.

Hamilton and Kardashian romance moves up a gear

Kim Kardashian's relationship with Lewis Hamilton is revving up.

The decorated F1 driver gave a nod to Kardashian during a Sunday press conference following the Monaco Grand Prix, where he placed second.

After a reporter asked him about a certain "high-profile supporter" cheering him on in the stands, Hamilton replied, "It's amazing to have her come this weekend and have her support."

He then noted "incredible turnout just overall," before pausing and adding with a smile, "It's amazing to have good people around you, and good people supporting you, and you know, she does that for me every day."

The Skims founder was at the track in Monaco all weekend cheering on her new flame alongside her younger sister Khloé.

After the race on Sunday, Kardashian joined the team as they celebrat-

ed on the track, where Hamilton met her to give her a hug. He later blew her a kiss from the podium after receiving the second-place trophy.

While the pair haven't made their relationship official, Kardashian took to social media last week to share photos of her and Hamilton biking down the West Side Highway in New York City. The two posed for selfies while enjoying their ride — with Hamilton capturing the mo-

ment Kardashian nearly fell off her bike.

Hamilton, 41, and Kardashian, 45, have known each other since 2014, but their relationship didn't take a romantic turn until early 2026, according to Access Hollywood.

The duo made their first public appearance together during this year's Super Bowl and have since been spotted at Coachella and in Tokyo, where Hamilton took Kardashian for a spin in his Ferrari.

The stars have mostly kept their relationship out of the public eye over the past months. When asked about the Super

Bowl date in February, Hamilton told Sky Sports reporter Ted Kravitz, "It's my private life. I'm not talking about that."

Idris Elba: don't make Bond woke

HE has long been tipped as the next James Bond but Sir Idris Elba has played down his chances of taking over as 007, saying: "It's not a realistic thing."

And the Luther star insists future films in the hit franchise "should not be woke".

Sir Idris, 53, reckons Bond author Ian Fleming's source material should be left alone.

He said: "Bond is so unrealistic, so a hint of reality is good, but let's not try and make it woke. I think you've got to be pure to what it is – escapism. Don't try and answer the world's taste. Just be Bond."

On the rumours of him being the next Bond, the actor told GQ magazine: "I've always felt that it's not a realistic thing."

"James Bond was written how he was written for a reason. But I was complimented by it."

"And also, I think, in realistic terms, some markets just do not go for that. Bond is big all over the world. And [audiences] won't [all] go for a black male, an African male, playing Bond. That's not what they like in their culture. Period."

After years of anticipation and speculation over who will succeed Daniel Craig as 007, the official search for the next Bond began early last month.

According to Hollywood outlet Variety, auditions have taken place in recent weeks, and a statement suggests the long wait for a new James Bond is nearing its end.

Rumoured possibilities include TV actor Callum Turner, Superman performer Henry Cavill and 28 Years Later star Aaron Taylor-Johnson.

■ Tartan Army out in force for their team's first World Cup appearance since France 1998

Thousands of Scotland fans descended on Boston this week after making the long journey to the US for the World Cup.

Anticipation is building as the men's team prepare to play in the tournament for the first time in almost 30 years.

The Tartan Army promises to be out in full force for the team's opening fixture with Haiti, which will be played at 21:00 local time on Saturday.

permit issues

While dozens of fans have reported issues with travel permits being revoked at the last minute, thousands have already completed the journey.

Edinburgh Airport was awash with kilts and Scotland tops on Wednesday and Thursday as fans headed to the States via different flight routes.

Some going direct to Massachusetts, where Scotland play their first two group games in Boston, with others travelling to neighbouring states.

The Delta direct flight to Boston was special for one family, who managed to secure match tickets mid-flight.

'absolutely buzzing'

Christopher Currie from Ayr told BBC Scotland he used the airline's wi-fi to buy four tickets to see Scotland v Haiti for a "decent" price.

He said: "We managed to buy tickets at 34,000ft (10363m) so it's been a great flight. We're absolutely buzzing now."

It will be his son Hudson's first big international game.

Fans who have already travelled to the US include 69-year-old Jim Stewart from Edinburgh.

He has been following

Scotland since he saw his first game at Hampden as a 15-year-old schoolboy in 1972.

That match ended in a 1-0 defeat to England – but Jim was hooked.

One of his most memorable moments came in 1977 at Wembley, where he saw the 2-1 victory over England. The match is still remembered for the post-match pitch invasion, where fans stole parts of the turf and broke the crossbar on one of the goals.

"I was on the pitch that day. My dad's got a bit of Wembley turf in his garden somewhere still – but no goalposts," said Jim.

'different places'

His first World Cup was Spain in 1982, when he and eight friends bought a campervan, covered it in tartan wallpaper and drove to Malaga.

Football matches took a back seat when Jim moved to England to

pursue a career as a financial advisor, but his interest was rekindled in the early 2000s.

Jim says he hasn't missed a Scotland game – home or away – since the 2018 game against Peru. He describes it as a great way to see the world.

"I enjoy meeting up with people and seeing different places I never in my life would have thought I'd have gone to – Peru, Kazakhstan, Albania, Armenia, Russia and Moldova," he said.

Hammers boss tried to nail us, say multiple women of porn king Sullivan

Multiple women have accused billionaire businessman and West Ham co-owner David Sullivan of abusing his power and preying on them for sex, in some cases when they were teenagers.

The allegations from seven women have been uncovered in a joint investigation by BBC Panorama and the Times and span decades, starting in the 1980s. All come from women who were in their late teens or early twenties and were young models seeking work at Sullivan's Daily and Sunday Sport newspapers.

They accuse Sullivan of

sexually exploitative and predatory behaviour, including pressuring them for sex during business meetings, where he offered to boost their careers if they slept with him or gave him oral sex.

One of them, Florence (not her real name), said she felt forced to have sex with him even though she did not want to.

Sullivan, 77, said he "categorically" denies the claims, which span the period when he made a fortune from pornography, newspapers and football.

On Saturday, hours after BBC Panorama and

the Times confirmed we would be publishing the investigation on Monday, Sullivan resigned as joint chair of West Ham. He said he wanted to focus on fighting what he called "factually incorrect and entirely false, decades-old allegations concerning my personal life", describing the investigation as "fundamentally unfair".

Sullivan has separately admitted paying for sex in the 1990s with a girl who, he says, he believed was 16 or 17 years old. Sullivan was in his 40s at the time. It only became illegal to pay for sex with

a 16 or 17 year old in 2003.

In the 1980s and 90s, Sullivan was a powerful gatekeeper for women hoping to have a career in glamour modelling. Florence said he had told her during a business meeting at his home that she would be one of his newspapers' "regular girls" if

they had sex.

Then aged 20, she tried to make excuses, including that she was on her period, before he manoeuvred her into a bedroom and started having sex with her, she said. Lawyers for Sullivan described her account as implausible.

Shania Twain delights locals with small gig in London pub

Shania Twain went back to her musical roots when she played to 200 fans in an East London pub this week.

The Grammy-winning country-pop legend, 60, reminisced about her early days playing bars as a child in her hometown of Timmins, Ontario, as she took to the tiny stage at The Shacklewell Arms in Dalston.

Shania told fans: "They would say 'Welcome to the stage, little Miss Twain' and that was me! And I would sing my little country songs and little did I know I would be all the way over here."

She later added: "I'm so happy to be here and be reliving some of my youth."

It was her most intimate gig in decades and a far cry from her next London shows. The Canadian singer-songwriter

is supporting Harry Styles in his 12-night residency at Wembley Stadium, beginning this Friday.

Posting on Facebook before Saturday's show, which fans had to join a ballot to buy tickets for, Shania showed snaps of herself performing as a child.

As well as her global hits such as That Don't Impress Me Much, her pub set included covers of Kenny Rogers' The Gambler and Cotton Eye Joe by Rednex. Shania opened with single Dirty

Rosie from her upcoming album, Little Miss Twain.

She told the crowd: "This next album of mine is called Little Miss Twain and it's all based on my life before I got my record contract. And I only got signed in Nashville, Tennessee, when I was in my late twenties so this was a long build-up. I promise you I was playing these very same kind of bars all those years from the age of eight years old to my late 20s and little Miss Twain was trying to become a recording artist."

Princess Anne, 75, wore the yellow hat first seen at the 1981 christening of daughter Zara, who was also a guest with husband Mike Tindall.

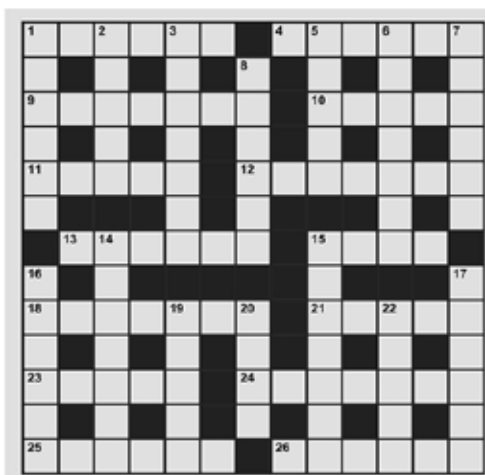

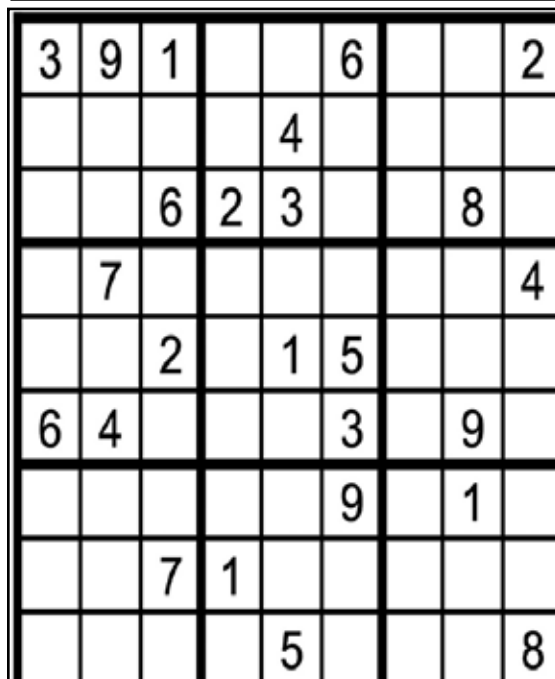

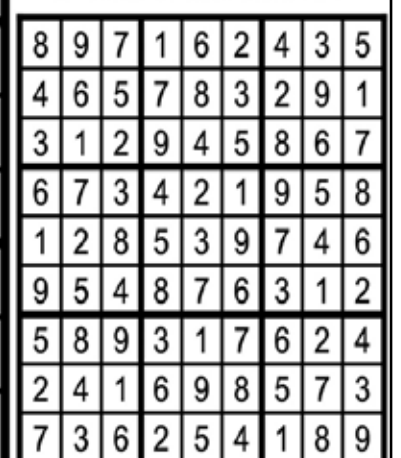

£120m not enough for Anderson, Forest tell City

Manchester City's have had a second record-breaking offers for Nottingham Forest midfielder Elliott Anderson rejected. Forest owner Evangelos Marinakis dismissed the latest offer on Wednesday, which was for an eye-watering £120.

City have intensified their pursuit of the 23-year-old England international, with an offer of an initial £106m plus add-ons. Should they sign Anderson, it would eclipse the £105m Arsenal paid West Ham for Declan Rice in 2023 as the record transfer for an English player. City had an opening bid rejected by Forest earlier this month and Anderson's preference is a move to Etihad Stadium over Manchester United, while personal terms are not an issue.

United are effectively out of the running, having not wanted to get into a bidding war and only wanting players eager to join them. City have long been admirers of Newcastle academy graduate Anderson.

The player is currently preparing for the World Cup in the United States, Canada and Mexico, but club-to-club talks can continue to take place. He started England's 3-0 win over Costa Rica on Wednesday - the final friendly for the Three Lions before their opening World Cup game against Croatia on 17 June.

Anderson was one of Forest's star performers last season as they reached the Europa League semi-finals and avoided relegation from the Premier League, despite having four managers. He

arrived from Newcastle in 2024 for £35m and has made 92 appearances, scoring six goals. Bernardo Silva's exit from City at the end of his contract means they are looking to bolster their midfield and Anderson tops the list of

potential targets.

Newcastle midfielder Sandro Tonali is another player understood to be highly rated by City, with reports suggesting the Italy international has also been monitored as a long-term target.

"When I first spoke to Kieran prior to appointing him, I knew we would be getting an extremely bright, hugely driven coach who craved the opportunity to make his own mark on a football club as a manager. To say he has done that is an understatement.

"Achieving three promotions in four seasons,

in what is your first role as a manager, is an achievement which means Kieran is now rightly discussed in the same breath as the legends of this club. The mark he, his staff and his players have made on Ipswich Town and its community will live forever. It has captured a generation.

Cricket: Stokes benched after latest booze blunder

CRICKET: Ben Stokes will miss England's second Test against New Zealand at The Oval following an incident in a London nightclub, with Joe Root stepping up as interim captain.

Stokes and pace bowler Gus Atkinson, who is also omitted from the squad, broke the team's midnight curfew in the

early hours of Monday morning and were present when a member of England's security staff was struck by Saracens rugby player Toota Auva'a.

Harry Brook is England's vice-captain, yet has been overlooked. He was punched by a bouncer outside a nightclub in Wellington in

October on the eve of a one-day international against New Zealand.

And so it means a sensational return to the captaincy for Root, who led England in a record 64 Tests between 2017 and 2022.

The 35-year-old, who is England's all-time leading run-scorer, stepped down after a se-

quence of one win in 17 Tests. He was succeeded by his good friend Stokes.

Three and easy for England!

England stepped up a gear in their final friendly before the World Cup with an impressive performance to beat Costa Rica in Orlando.

After kick-off was delayed for an hour by storms, Declan Rice gave England an early lead with a deflected shot as he took advantage of good work by new Barcelona signing Anthony Gordon.

Jude Bellingham started ahead of Morgan Rogers in the number 10 role and looked sharp as he pressed his claim to start in the team's World Cup opener against Croatia in Dallas on 17 June.

Bellingham put Noni Madueke through in the first half, only for the Arsenal forward to hit the post after rounding Costa Rica keeper Patrick Sequeira when he looked sure to find an

empty net.

Real Madrid man Bellingham's brilliant run then helped England find a second goal after 68 minutes, when he set up substitute Eberechi Eke for a shot that was handled – Gordon scoring the resulting penalty.

Ollie Watkins came off the bench and pounced with a close-range header three minutes from the end to give England a victory margin that reflected their dominance.

England will now have a behind-closed-doors game against Miami FC to give some players extra minutes and work on strategy before the serious business starts against Croatia.

England's first friendly after arriving in the United States had been little more than a

glorified training session when New Zealand were beaten 1-0 in Tampa on Saturday.

Costa Rica, in contrast, provided the perfect opposition as England stepped up to another level.

This was exactly the sort of workout head coach Thomas Tuchel wanted as he finalises plans for the World Cup opener against Croatia.

England faced durable opposition who were determined to give the game a competitive edge with uncompromising tackling and stubborn defence.

And Tuchel will also have been delighted with how players who are effectively fighting for their places showed determination to make an impression.

Gordon was lively from the first whistle,

making Rice's goal and giving Costa Rica defender Shawn Johnson a torrid time. He also took responsibility for the second-half penalty that sealed victory with regular taker Harry Kane having been substituted.

Bellingham showed the sort of world-class touches that will make it difficult for Tuchel to leave him out, while defender John Stones got another 63 minutes under his belt to put himself in contention to start

against Croatia.

Tuchel can carry out final tweaks in that private game against Miami FC before he makes selection decisions that really matter as England's World Cup gets under way.

Great Scott will be ready, insists McLean

Kenny McLean is confident "special" midfielder Scott McTominay will be fit for Scotland's World Cup opener against Haiti on Sunday.

The Napoli talisman sat out training on Thursday with an upset stomach.

"Mine is alright thankfully," fellow midfielder McLean said. "Hopefully that doesn't spread. Fingers crossed Scott will be fine. I'm sure he will be."

In a side whose strength is its collective unity, McLean says McTominay's individual excellence will be key to Scotland's World Cup hopes.

"I don't need to speak too much on him, everyone knows how big he is," said the Norwich player.

"It's a team effort and

"We want to make

more history," said the Norwich midfielder. "There's more to come - we believe and I believe.

"Preparation has been amazing, couldn't have gone any better. We need to maximise the opportunity we've got.

"We know how special this can be for us. We know we're in a good place to create more memories. We know it's about what we do and we have everything in place to be as good as we can be, create more history and create memories again."
