



# SOCIAL MEDIA BAN FOR U16s ON THE WAY

■ TikTok, Snapchat and Instagram among those targeted by UK government

Millions of children in the UK will be forced off social media after the government announced it would ban under-16s from accessing a range of platforms.

Apps including TikTok, Snapchat and Instagram will become inaccessible for children, Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer said this week.

"We hope to pass regulation before Christmas," he said, with the ban coming into force in spring 2027.

Perhaps predictably, tech companies including Meta, Snapchat and YouTube warned a blanket ban would move children into more unsafe online

environments.

"I am not prepared to compromise on the safety and happiness of our children, and that is why this ban must happen, and why this ban will happen," Sir Keir said.

The government is yet to release the full list of platforms affected, but said YouTube, Facebook and X would also be included.

The government said over-16s may have to verify their ages to continue

using social media platforms.

But it said many adults would not need to do checks because their accounts are already over 16 years old, had a credit card linked or their email address was already verified in other ways.

Messaging apps such as WhatsApp, and Signal will not be banned, and neither will online gaming platform Roblox.

But certain features will be restricted for un-

der-16s, such as livestreaming and strangers being able to contact children.

YouTube Kids is also exempt from the ban.

The government will also look at restrictions on some functionalities on social media, such as infinite scroll and curfews, for 16 and 17-year-olds.

Intimate and sexual chats with AI will also be banned for under-18s.

The ban follows growing pressure from campaigners to make the online world safer for young people, and is part of an international trend of gov-

ernments restricting who can access social media.

"This social media ban won't solve every problem overnight, but it is a major step forward," said Joe Ryrie, co-founder of the Smartphone Free Childhood campaign group.

### 'vital resource'

"Millions of children will now get a few more years to grow up before entering online environments that were never designed with their wellbeing in mind."

Snapchat said it shared the objective of online

safety, but disagreed with a full ban.

Meta said a ban risked "isolating teens from online communities and information, and driving them to unregulated alternatives".

YouTube said it has many protections in place for teens, and called itself "a vital resource for young people, educators and parents".

"Blanket bans push kids out of such curated, supervised, beneficial experiences and towards anonymous, less safe services," its statement said.

# Russia attacking UK by proxy 'every day' says Starmer

■ PM speaks out after Russian agents jailed for arson attacks on properties and vehicles

SIR KIER STARMER has said the UK is dealing with proxy attacks on the UK from Russia and other 'bad actors' on a daily basis, after two men were found of conspiring to carry out arson attacks on property and a car connected to him.

Ukrainian national Roman Lavrynovych, 22, and Ukrainian-born Romanian national Stanislav Carpiuc, 27, were convicted by an Old Bailey jury on Tuesday.

In May 2025, a Toyota once owned by Sir Keir was set alight in a street in north London. Days later two homes were set ablaze, including one rented out to the prime minister's sister-in-law, which he still owned.

## False theory

The prosecution told the court Lavrynovych carried out the arson attacks after being recruited online by Russian-speaking Telegram user "El Money" who promised him payment.

Some security sources had said that an outlandish and false theory that emerged after the attack – that the defendants were aggrieved sex workers who torched Starmer's home because they had not been paid

– could have been created by far-right figures in the UK and amplified by hostile Russian agents.

Asked if he was concerned that the conspiracy theory – which was spread by figures such as Tommy Robinson – suggested that some elements of the far right were acting, inadvertently or otherwise, as de-facto Russian agents, Starmer said: "There are many actors who want to divide our country and to cause conflict in our country."

"Some of the evidence that came out of trial speaks for itself, but there are wider issues here," he added. "We see this the whole time."

He accused politicians and other "actors" in the UK of being "more than happy to indulge in tearing our country apart", adding that there were also "those from outside our country who are trying to find ways to exploit division in our country to destabilise our democracy".

Starmer added: "[W]e need to be really clear in relation to that and we need to fight it at every twist and every turn."

Lavrynovych was acquitted of damaging property by fire with in-

tent to endanger life on 11 and 12 May 2025 at two properties in north London.

He was convicted of alternate counts of damaging property by fire being reckless as to whether life was endangered.

A third man, Petro Pochynok, 35, was found not guilty of conspiracy to commit arson.

All three, who live in London, had denied conspiring together and "with others" to damage property by fire between

1 April and 13 May 2025.

On 8 May 2025, a car previously owned by the prime minister was found on fire on a street he previously lived on in Kentish Town.

Three days later, a fire was discovered at flats linked to Sir Keir in nearby Islington. He had lived there years before.

## 'abhorrent attack'

On 12 May 2025, a fire was discovered at the entrance to Sir Keir's Kentish Town home, which was being rented out to his sister-in-law. She was inside with her family when the property was set alight by Lavrynovych.

The defendants were said not to have demonstrated any particular political or ideological motivation, and that it did not matter whether they knew that the property they were allegedly targeting was connected to the prime minister or whether that formed part of their motivation.

A Downing Street spokesperson said it had been "an abhorrent attack" and thanked investigators and prosecutors. Speaking at the

G7 summit in Évian-les-Bains, France, on Wednesday, Starmer said the attack on the house had "clearly impacted and affected my family".

Starmer's warning comes at a time of heightened tension between Russia and the UK. On Sunday a Russian shadow fleet vessel containing 98,000 tonnes of oil was intercepted by British troops in the Channel, and on Tuesday a Russian warship fired warning shots at a British-flagged yacht.

Starmer said the warning shots were "deeply concerning and reckless".

Earlier at the summit, Starmer said the attack on the property needed to be seen in the "broader context" of Russia's war in Ukraine. The prime minister, who announced new sanctions on Russia to target finance networks and expand the number of vessels targeted as part of Moscow's shadow fleet carrying oil or liquified natural gas to more than 600, said there was a "mood change" in the debate about Ukraine.

TikTok said: "We will examine the details of the government's measures, and we look forward to collaborating constructively with the government on this important issue."

Speaking in the House of Commons, Technology Secretary Liz Kendall said the measures would "take power away from the tech giants, who have had countless opportunities to keep children safe".

She said she was clear that there was still much more to do for adults as well as children on social media, and that "today's announcement is not 'one and done' or the end of the story".

The ban was generally welcomed by a group of bereaved parents who say their children died as a result of a variety of harms on social media.

"I'm so glad now that this announcement has been made", Esther Ghey told BBC Breakfast.

Her daughter Brianna was killed by two teenagers in 2023. One of the killers said she had become interested in "dark materials" online, including videos of murder and torture.

Ghey said the ban can "potentially save so many children's lives", but added there needed to be support in place for children who will not be able to access social media.

Rocio Cifuentes, the children's commissioner for Wales, said a ban "was too simplistic a framing" - and that the accountability should have been on the platforms to make them safe for children to use.

England's children's commissioner, Dame Rachel de Souza, meanwhile, called it "positive" - and said the ban should be extended to all children, including those up to the age of 18.

# Scottish fans drink Boston dry

■ "We've never seen anything like it" says vendor as Tartan Army neck FOUR times as much beer as the locals in huge party weekend

The parent company of Sam Adams said its Boston Taproom ran out of the brand's flagship Boston Lager over the weekend because Scotland fans in Boston for the 2026 World Cup drank four times as much as the bar usually sells.

Boston Beer Co. said in a news release that from Thursday to Sunday, the Tartan Army drank four times what the company normally stocks during a typical four-day holiday stretch like the Fourth of July, adding that it had to schedule an emergency delivery of beer Saturday morning and are adding extra deliveries this week to make sure it has enough.

"We've never seen anything like it," Billy DeCain of the Sam Adams Boston Taproom told reporters.

"The White Bull

Tavern, there was no beer," Scottish fan Dave Orr told NBC. "The Scottish fans just drank the place dry and all they had was Bud Light."

"Pretty much everything. We ran out of everything," Paul Morris of The White Bull Tavern said. "Tennent's being number one.

"The fans have been unbelievable. They're great - fun, drinking, partying - having a great time."

## Fenway Army

Noelle Somers, chief operating officer at Hennessy's Bar, told The Boston Globe that the sales "tripled St. Patrick's Day."

"We've been here for over 30 years, and we've never seen anything like it," she told the Boston Globe.

On Saturday night, the fans watched Scotland

defeat Haiti 1-0 at Gillette Stadium.

And after navigating the packed trains and traffic jams, the party continued long into the morning across Boston's many bars. Then, just under 24 hours after Scotland's win on the pitch, the Boston Red Sox put on "Scotland Day" at Fenway Park.

The Tartan Army led a fan march from Evans Way Park to the ballpark. It was led by a cohort of folks playing bagpipes as they brought a touch of Scotland to New England.

A conservative estimate saw at least 5,000 fans take part - but judging by eye in Fenway Park, thousands more

made the trip to watch the Red Sox play the Texas Rangers. Local fans were treated to non-stop renditions of "Yes Sir, I Can Boogie" and other less family-friendly chants during the course of the match. In fact for many locals the antics of their Scots visitors completely overshadowed the action on the field.

"I thought Red Sox fans were passionate," said longtime local fan Colin McDermott. "But I've never seen anything like this. The way they march, sing, chant in unison, it's funny, it's inspiring and you can't help but join in.

"We Americans could learn a lot from those guys," he added.

## For those back home... it's pure delirium at 2am

FOR SCOTLAND fans with neither the time or not the money to cross the Pond to support their heroes, there was no shortage of celebration on home soil as watched their team secure a first World Cup victory in 36 years.

Supporters had gathered in bars and venues across the country with a sense of anticipation to watch the opening match against Haiti - despite the 02:00 BST kick-off time.

There were roars of delight at the John McGinn goal which proved to be enough to earn a crucial 1-0 victory - and then relief when the final whistle blew at the stadium thou-

sands of miles away in Boston.

It is estimated that up to 30,000 fans travelled to the US for the match, filling up both the stadium and the fan zone.

Back home, those fans who stayed up late - or got up very early - emerged blinking into the early morning sunshine as they reflected on a result which sees Scotland top their group.

The nation has been gripped by the build-up to the men's team's first match in a World Cup since 1998.

Fans had packed out the pubs and other venues which had been granted late licenses to show the

game.

They ranged from the thousands who descended on the OVO Hydro in Glasgow for what was billed as the country's biggest fan zone, to small community events across the country.

About 500 people watched the action on big screens at a fan zone at Aberdeen's Beach Ballroom.

The doors had opened at 22:30 BST on Saturday under a beautiful orange sunset sky, as the fans were played in by a bagpiper.

Hours later daylight greeted those happy supporters, many kitted out in Saltires and Scotland tops, as they spilled back out

onto the street.

Nineteen-year-old Alex Stewart, from Forfar, was among those who were celebrating.

"For me it's the first time seeing Scotland at a World Cup and watching us win a game is unbelievable.

"We're sitting top of the group. It opens the

group up entirely."

Looking ahead to the next two games in the group, he added: "You've got two big names in Brazil and Morocco... just go for it."

Craig Stewart, 31, also from Forfar, was "ecstatic" about the result.

While he admitted the performance had been

"shaky", he said the result was what mattered at the end of the day.

Lefika Duncan Taubong, 36, predicted a Scotland win - and is positive about the nation's chances at the World Cup.

"Miracles happen - Scotland are going through to the knockouts," he said.

## ■ Tartan Army hits Boston with Glasgow prank

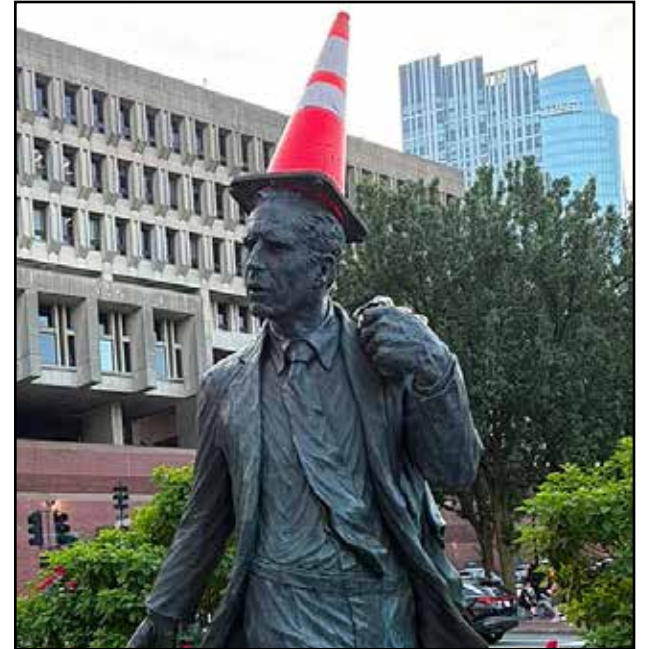
An army of up to 30,000 roaring Scotland football fans invaded Boston for the World Cup at the weekend - and they are leaving a very orange, very Scottish mark on the city.

Apart from drinking several local bars dry while before, during and after watching their heroes win their opening World Cup game, Scottish fans also left baffled locals scratching their heads as the Tartan Army gave Boston's historic landmarks a hilarious Glasgow-style makeover, plonking bright traffic cones on every statue they could find.

The cheeky prank is a legendary tradition straight from the streets of Glasgow, where the famous Duke of Wellington statue has sported

Bostonian Brendan McGillicuddy, 26, told reporters he loved seeing the new additions on his morning commute.

Jeremy Clarkson has revealed he was diagnosed with an "aggressive" form of prostate cancer last summer and had an operation to remove 10% of his prostate, eight months after he underwent heart surgery for blocked coronary arteries.

In the final two episodes of the fifth series of his Prime Video documentary, Clarkson's

Farm, the 66-year-old presenter told his farm manager, Kaleb Cooper, and his land agent, Charlie Ireland: "I've got cancer."

In the scenes, which were filmed last year and released on Tuesday night, the former Top Gear host added: "I had a medical, remember, back in May? I disappeared off the other week and I had a biopsy and it is cancer, and it's aggressive."

## Jeremy Clarkson reveals 'aggressive' cancer diagnosis

The 66-year-old said he expected to be "fine" but would be out of action "for a while." He said he had known "since May."

He said in the Prime Video show that he had undergone an operation to remove the cancerous section.

"I won't know whether it's worked or not until November, probably," he said. "The prostate, 10% of it's dead, the 10%

where the cancer is."

Speaking from a hospital bed at the end of the season finale, Clarkson said he had experienced complications during treatment.

"We started Season 5 with me in a hospital bed, and here we are at the end of Season 5, and I'm back in a hospital bed," he said.

"What I wanted to say was if this is all successful, I'll see you for Season 6,

and if it isn't, I won't. Take care, everyone."

Clarkson hinted at the episode's content on Instagram on Tuesday, telling followers he had some "somber news" and warned fans that the upcoming episodes were a "difficult watch."

He said: "Ordinarily, we try to keep the show bucolic and charming, and cheerful, but two episodes which drop in the

middle of the night tonight are, they're none of those things, really."

Clarkson presented Top Gear on the BBC for 25 years, from 1988 to 1999 and again, for the show's relaunch, from 2002 to 2015, until his contract was not renewed. The hugely popular motoring show is one of the company's most successful global exports and ran for 240 episodes over 33 series.

## Starmer warns Burnham

Sir Keir Starmer has warned Andy Burnham against launching an immediate challenge to his leadership after the Manchester mayor won the Makerfield by-election on Thursday night.

Burnham will need resign as Manchester mayor, with a by-election to replace him expected by 6 August.

Burnham is widely anticipated to challenge the prime minister for the leadership now he has been elected to Parliament.

Speaking from the G7 summit, the prime minister said a leadership contest would be a "bad thing" for the country and reiterated that he intended to fight any challenge.

Sir Keir said the potential mayoral election would be "very important" and that his party were "going to have to pull our sleeves up to make sure that there is another Labour victory".

The prime minister

also indicated that he would offer Burnham a cabinet job if he wins in Makerfield, telling reporters: "I hope he wins the by-election and he'll play a big part in the Labour government."

The prime minister's warning comes as Labour MP Wes Streeting says he is prepared to trigger a leadership contest, following Thursday's by-election.

Streeting resigned as health secretary last month but has said he delayed making a leadership challenge until after the Makerfield by-election to give Burnham a chance to take part.

Streeting said he would "prefer the PM to take a decision on his own terms rather than leave it for me or Andy or anyone else to trigger a contest."

"If not we can't carry on with this uncertainty and paralysis and there will need to be a contest and I would be prepared to do that."

# Harry 'planning to bring kids to UK'

The Duke and Duchess of Sussex are expected to bring their two children to the UK in July.

Prince Harry and Meghan will be accompanied by Archie, seven, and Lilibet, five. Next month will be one year to the start of the Invictus Games.

It will be the first time the duke, who lives in California, has visited the UK with his family in four years.

Prince Harry has spoken previously about his desire to bring his two children back to his country of birth. It is not clear what the security arrangements for the visit will be.

It is not yet known whether King Charles will meet his grandchildren on this visit.

The King last saw his grandchildren during the late Queen's Plat-

inum Jubilee celebrations in 2022.

In an interview last year, Prince Harry spoke of his desire for a "reconciliation" with the Royal Family.

Last September, he met his father King Charles at Clarence House in London, their first face to face meeting since February 2024.

The meeting was seen as a first step in improving relations between father and son and building trust in what has seemed a deep family rift.

Prince Harry's security was downgraded

after he stepped back from frontline royal duties in 2020 and moved to the US with his family.

In May, Prince Harry lost a legal case to have his police protection reinstated when visiting the UK.

Speaking to reporters after the ruling, he said it was not safe to bring his family back to the country of his birth because he could not guarantee their safety.

In December, sources suggested that Prince Harry's access to security when he visits the UK was un-

der review.

A government spokesperson said on Wednesday: "The UK government's protective security system is rigorous and proportionate."

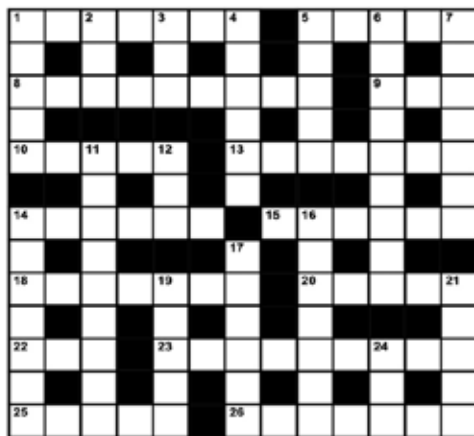
"It is our long-standing policy not to provide detailed information on those arrangements, as doing so could compromise their integrity and affect individuals' security."

The prince founded the Invictus Games in London in 2014. Next year's competition will be held in Birmingham.

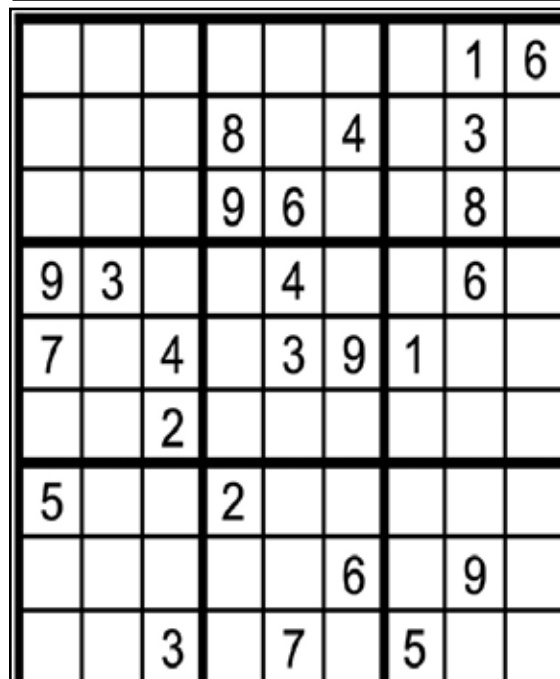

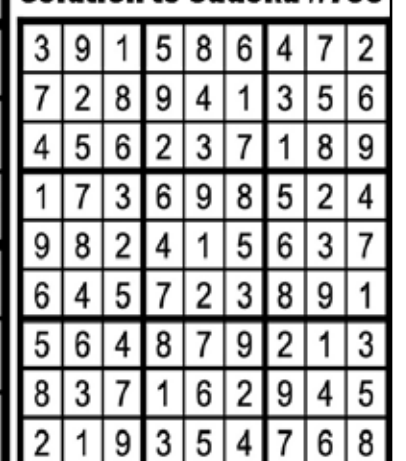

# Boots, Brisket and the Three Lions

■ England fans go “Full Texas” ahead of Croatia World Cup opener

FORT WORTH, Texas: England football fans are famous - and often infamous - for traveling across the globe to support their national teams, but the opening week of the World Cup in North Texas has seen them trading their traditional terrace chants for something entirely unexpected: cowboy boots, slow-smoked brisket, and coordinated line dancing.

With Dallas Stadium serving as a major hub for the tournament, thousands of supporters descended upon the Lone Star State ahead of Wednesday's vital opening match with Croatia. Following England's thrilling 4-2 victory, the initial wave of football-induced euphoria quickly morphed into a full-scale embrace of Texan culture.

## Boot Scootin'

The epicenter of this cross-cultural phenomenon has been the historic Fort Worth Stockyards. Ahead of the group-stage fixtures, dozens of England supporters clad in white-and-red shirts were spotted turning heads at local honky-tonks. Rather than pacing the streets singing standard football anthems, the traveling contingent has been adapting to local rhythms.

At Billy Bob's Texas, billed as the world's largest honky-tonk, a viral scene captured the imagination of social media. An instructor patiently guided a sea of British fans through a daytime line dancing lesson.

“We are used to jumping up and down in a crowd, but this requires actual footwork,” laughed Thomas Evans, a fan from Manchester who made the trip to Dallas. “You have to count the steps. Back home,

our only dance moves involve spilling a pint when a goal goes in. Out here, we're actually trying not to step on each other's toes.”

## A Baptism Barbecue

The sight of die-hard football fans carefully mastering a grapevine step while wearing replica kits has become a defining image of the tournament's first week. Local Texans have welcomed the spectacle with open arms, frequently stepping in to offer tips on how to properly tip a Stetson or nail the timing of a coun-

try music shuffle.

When they aren't on the dance floor, England fans supporters are undergoing a culinary awakening. For many, there's no better stomach liner for a night of drinking ahead than authentic Texas barbecue.

“I've heard about the food for months, but nothing prepares you for the real deal,” said Andy Milne, a well-known England superfan who made headlines after selling a second home to fund his World Cup journey. After trying a combination of

slow-smoked brisket, ribs, and frozen margaritas, Milne and his fellow travelers admitted they were hooked.

Local barbecue joints from Fort Worth to Dallas have reported record-breaking weeks, with queues snaking around blocks as fans wait to try Texas Wagyu brisket and jalapeño sausage. Restaurant owners have expressed delight at the visitors' enthusiasm.

“They come in asking for ‘sauce,’ and we tell them the meat doesn't even need it,” joked a pitmaster at a prominent Fort Worth establishment. “They take that first bite of brisket, and their eyes just light up. It's a beautiful thing to watch.”

The sheer volume of fans has occasionally overwhelmed local venues. In Dallas, the popular Londoner Pub became the unofficial headquarters

for the British contingent, reportedly selling more than 5,000 beers ahead of the Croatia match. The post-game celebration grew so massive that local authorities and the fire marshal had to step in to briefly close the doors due to overcrowding.

Yet, despite the high energy and minor logistical headaches, the atmosphere across the Dallas-Fort Worth metro-

Clarke said pre-match that the selection of Aston Villa captain McGinn instead of Ryan Christie was "probably the hardest decision I've ever had to make" and challenged the 31-year-old to prove him right.

# Lineker: Kane is 'greatest English striker'

Gary Lineker thinks Harry Kane is "the greatest English striker we've ever had" after the England captain equalled his record of 10 World Cup goals on Wednesday.

Kane, 32, scored twice as England opened their tournament campaign in Dallas with a 4-2 victory against Croatia in Group L.

Former Three Lions striker Lineker, 65, reached his tally between the 1986 World Cup in Mexico and Italia 90, while Kane is playing

at his third tournament after featuring in Russia in 2018 and Qatar four years ago.

"Welcome to the double-figures club. It's great. I mean, it may have taken him a World Cup more," ex-Match of the Day presenter Lineker joked on The Rest is Football podcast.

"In all seriousness, Harry Kane is, I think, the greatest English striker we've ever had. I genuinely think that now."

Kane now has 81 goals in 115 international appearances and leads the

list of England's record goalscorers.

England face Ghana in their second group game on 23 June at 21:00 BST.

Bayern Munich's Kane gave England the lead with a retaken penalty early in the first half, before scoring a powerful header to restore his side's lead three minutes before the break.

"I'm absolutely delighted that Kane equalled my record," Lineker continued. "His all-round game is, for me, what separates him from all the others."

Kane's standout per-

formance comes after Lionel Messi scored a hat-trick for Argentina against Algeria, Kylian Mbappe opened his account for France with two goals in the win over Senegal and Manchester City's Erling Haaland also scored a brace in Norway's victory against Iran.

Lineker's co-host Alan Shearer, who scored 30 goals for England including two at the 1998 World Cup, said: "Harry Kane has seen Messi, Mbappe and Haaland all come on straight away

and get the goals.

"It's only a matter of time before he breaks your record."

Manchester United defender Harry Maguire, who was left out of England boss Thomas Tuchel's squad for this summer's tournament, said Kane is not just the Three Lions' best player, he's "one of the best players in the world".

He added: "You can't speak highly enough of him. On the pitch, he's unbelievable, but, off the pitch, he's a massive leader."

Declan Rice is expected to be available for England's World Cup match against Ghana after suffering from lower back pain during the win over Croatia.

The midfielder was substituted midway through the second half, raising concerns about his fitness.

But it is understood the back issue is unlikely to prevent Rice from playing against Ghana in Boston on Tuesday.

The complaint is one that the Arsenal midfielder, 27, has been carrying for a while.

Ivan Toney and Morgan Rogers were among the scorers as England recorded a comprehensive 5-1 victory over Major League Soccer side Sporting Kansas City in a practice match on Thursday.

The game, played behind closed doors at England's Swope Soccer Village training facility, featured the players not used in Wednesday's World Cup win over Croatia and the squad

members who did not play significant minutes in Dallas.

Toney scored a hat-trick while Aston Villa duo Morgan Rogers and Ollie Watkins were also on target as England ran out comfortable winners.

Jordan Henderson, Eberechi Eze, Marc Guehi, Dan Burn, Kobbie Mainoo, Djed Spence and Jarell Quansah were among the players also involved in the training game.

The game was broken up into two halves of around 25 minutes each.

Football Association arranged the friendly to get minutes into certain players' legs.

Having arrived back from Dallas at around 10.30pm local time on Wednesday, England players were afforded most of Thursday off.

■ Tucher's men overcome defensive jitters to run out 4-2 winners against canny Croatia side

England made a winning start to their World Cup campaign as they overpowered Croatia in a thriller in Dallas on Wednesday.

Thomas Tuchel's side demonstrated strength in attack and frailty in defence, but possessed the firepower to finally overcome Croatia and set the platform for progress in Group L.

Harry Kane put England ahead on 12 minutes with a twice taken spot-kick after Luka Modric fouled Noni Madueke, Croatia keeper Dominik Livakovic saving his first attempt but penalised for encroaching off his goalline.

Croatia, always dangerous opponents, were level after 36 minutes when Martin Baturina sent a powerful drive high past Jordan Pickford, who got a touch but could not keep the ball out.

Kane, inevitably, restored England's lead three minutes before the break with a powerful header from Declan Rice's corner, bringing him level with Gary Lineker on 10 World Cup goals, his 81st in 115 England appearances.

England, however, never looked at ease defensively, Croatia equalising again with a well-worked goal seconds before half-time, Petar Musa steering Ivan Perisic's header beyond Pickford.

Jude Bellingham showed exactly why Tuchel selected him ahead of Morgan Rogers with a powerful run and finish moments after the break as the Three Lions established control once more.

Marcus Rashford, on as a substitute, ended any lingering concerns with a composed finish five minutes from time as England

move on to face Ghana in Boston.

Tuchel will be delighted at starting the World Cup with a victory, so vital for confidence at any major tournament.

He will, however, know there is work to do despite an impressive win and a scoreline that was a fair reflection of their superiority, especially in the second half.

England were potent in attack, particularly for a spell after the break when Bellingham scored and Croatia somehow held out during a period of intense pressure.

Kane joined Lionel Messi, Kylian Mbappe and Erling Haaland in making an early pitch for the Golden Boot, while Bellingham gave a powerhouse display he embellished with a fine goal.

It was in defence, how-

ever, where Tuchel will feel there must be improvements as Croatia scored two goals that could have been avoided.

In the end, though, it was the three points that mattered and England fully merited their win.

Modric has decorated so many World Cups for Croatia, reaching the final in Russia in 2018 then the semi-final in Qatar four years later.

This was not, however, one of the great 40-year-old's better days as he gave away the early penalty with a mistimed tackle on Madueke and was then substituted after 58 minutes as England started to take control.

Modric, however, will still be the fulcrum of Croatia's effort to once again make progress at the World Cup – something they manage to do
